The only **REAL** solution is to *close your eyes* and remember the **GOOD** times *IN PERFECT RECALL* and *total accuracy*!



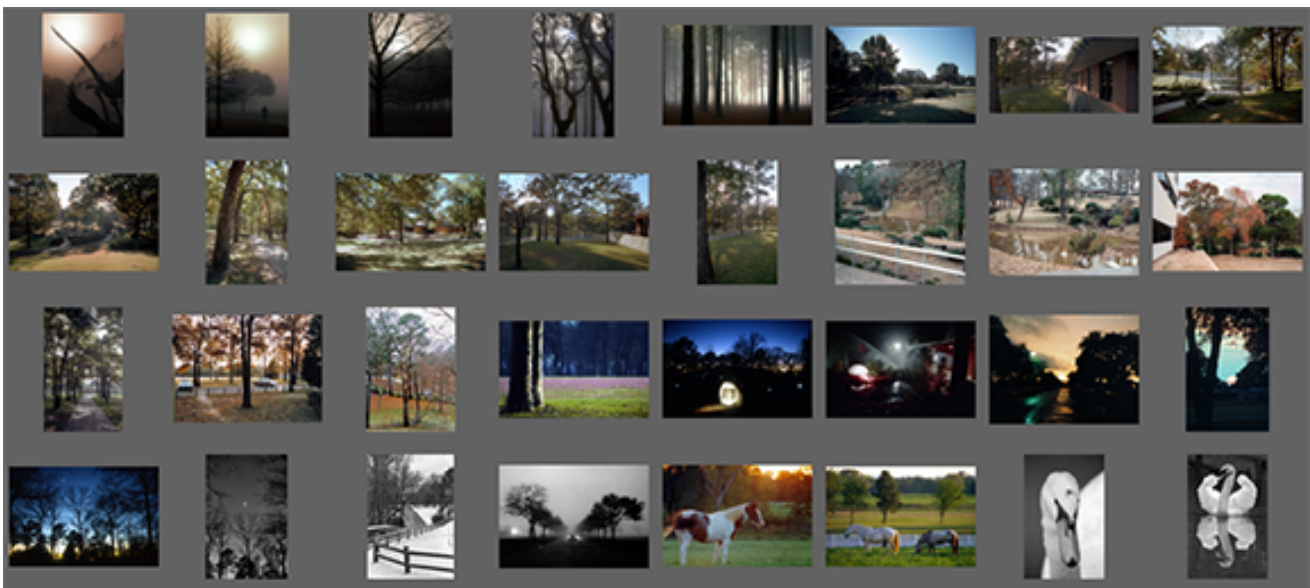
But if your memory is a LITTLE OFF or even *missing entirely*, then there's *this*: **The Ambassador Archives**.

The Archives is an organized collection of mostly high-resolution images representing both the Pasadena and Big Sandy campuses as seen through the lens and scrapbooks of photographer Mike Bedford. The period of 1982-1996 is heavily represented, with subsequent visits to the Pasadena campus grounds in the 2000s. In addition, audio and PDF documents are included, plus a video of the 1990 Pasadena graduation (its last).

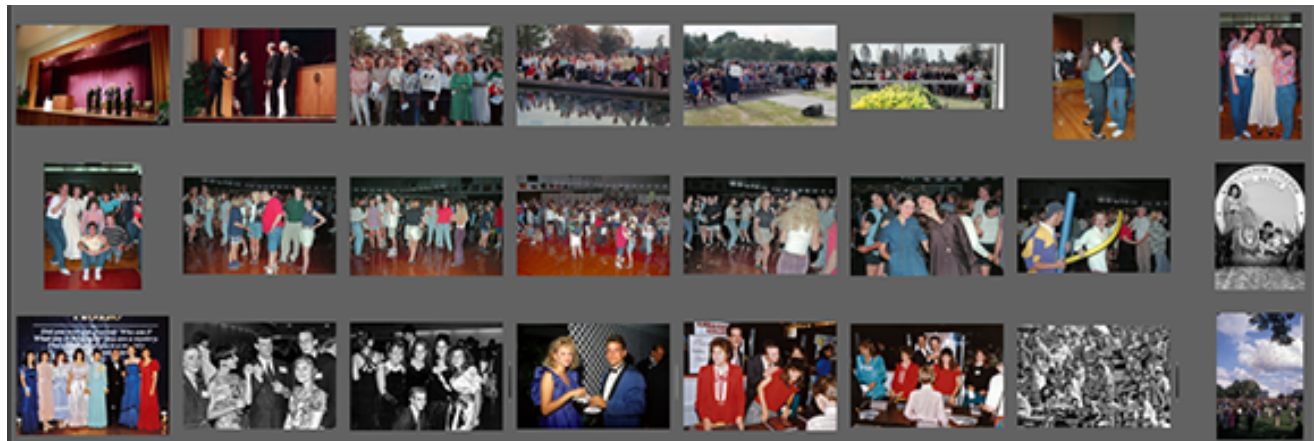
Here are a few samples of what you'll find in the various folders, beginning with the Ambassador Auditorium over the years:
