
# Faculty Runs Over Seniors 107-84

## Mr. Armstrong scores 33 points in best game of the season


The class of '69 made its next to the last adjustment on the basketball court Wednesday night — and lost. What a night! Here it is, your next to the last game at Ambassador College, and you face the dynamic Faculty at their best. Somehow second semester always seems to be a losing season — at least on the basketball court — for the Seniors. As hard as the Seniors tried, few teams could have matched

the red hot Faculty the way they were hitting. Mr. Armstrong was the pace setter for the Faculty as he led the team with a season high of 33 points—followed by Messrs. Norman and Petty with 25 and 24 respectively.

In the opening minutes the Faculty shot 100% and built up a sizable lead as the Seniors struggled for survival. The Seniors were doing fine on rebounding, but couldn't put a shot




Ben Whitfield rises above the opposition for a shot.




Ben pulls a rebound away from Mr. Wilkinson.

Mr. Armstrong and Mr. Petty were on the beam from outside and Eric Williams was soaking up rebounds to promote the Faculty running game. The Faculty utilized brilliant passing to overload the Seniors and run away with the game. Still in the opening minutes, the Faculty had amassed a 24 to 8 lead which grew to a 37 to 10 lead as the Faculty machine kept turning out baskets. At this point the Faculty mercifully subbed




