Russian Work **Leaps Ahead**

In April, 1959 the World Tomorrow began in the Russian language. Mail came in on the average of TEN LETTERS PER MONTH for the next eighteen months.

Then, during the next four months -- THE MAIL DOUBLED to twenty letters per month.

- A. No, sexual crimes didn't occur in the last year although there had been some previously.
- Q. Shoplifting?
- A. None.

There are no women among the top eleven who rule the Soviet Union. And the wives of these men do not appear at the lavish diplomatic banquets.

Russians are descendents of Meshech and Tubal.

The prince of Meshech, and Tubal is mentioned in Ezekiel 38. The ancient Assyrian name for Meshech was Muska. This is the derivation of Moscow.

Tubal has given his name to the Tobol river and the city of Tobolsk. Both are in Siberia.

Ivan the Great enlarged and established the Empire by driving the Mongols out of Siberia.

Later, Ivan the Terrible established a despotic state. His government contained all the basic elements and characteristics of present-day Communism.

COMMENTS OF EYE WITNESSES

Party allows no free elections, no opinion of the people is ever tolerated.

The aim? One--Conquest of the world. Means? ANY IN HAND!!

And here are some of the means:

"...there were about ELEVEN million people in the...prisons and concentration CAMPS in the years 1936-1939."

"Individual cells designed for one person there were 25 - 30 who were keptthere in this way for ten months and longer "under investigation" as they called it. These people were slowly DYING. In addition, each of them was TORTURED during investigation."

The Soviet philosophy is this. A woman's place is anywhere where there's work to be done. Otherwise, silence is the watchword.




BOOKLETS TRANSLATED
