IV EXPOUND ON BACKGROUND TO "CHRISTIANITY"

- A Contrast true and false doctrines
 - 1. God's ways bring life. World's ways bring death!
 - 2. God's ways are orderly - world's ways are confusing!
- B Explain origin of world's religions
 - 1. Satan's Fall
 - a. Ez. 28:12-16
 - b. Isa. 14:12
 - c. II Cor. 4:4 - Satan the God of this world

2. Satan's Fate
 - a. II Cor. 4:18 - spiritual things eternal
 - b. Rev. 20:10 - tormented forever
 - c. Jude 6:13 - Satan's fate

 3. Satan is IMMORTAL, man is MORTAL!
Satan has applied his fate to men!
Show how immortality of soul gives rise to belief in heaven and hell
- C Discuss the effect of doctrine of IMMORTAL soul
1. Underlying doctrine of all false teachings
 2. Assign articles on "Immortality of Soul"
- D Show how all Satan's doctrines are false (I Tim. 4:1-3)
1. Law and Grace: disobedience brings eternal death
 2. Trinity: closed Godhead - no room to enlarge family
 3. Everburning hell: based on fear -- makes God seem unfair
