The Auditorium takes its place in the center of a three-building complex, flanked by the Hall of Administration to the left and our Student Center on the right.

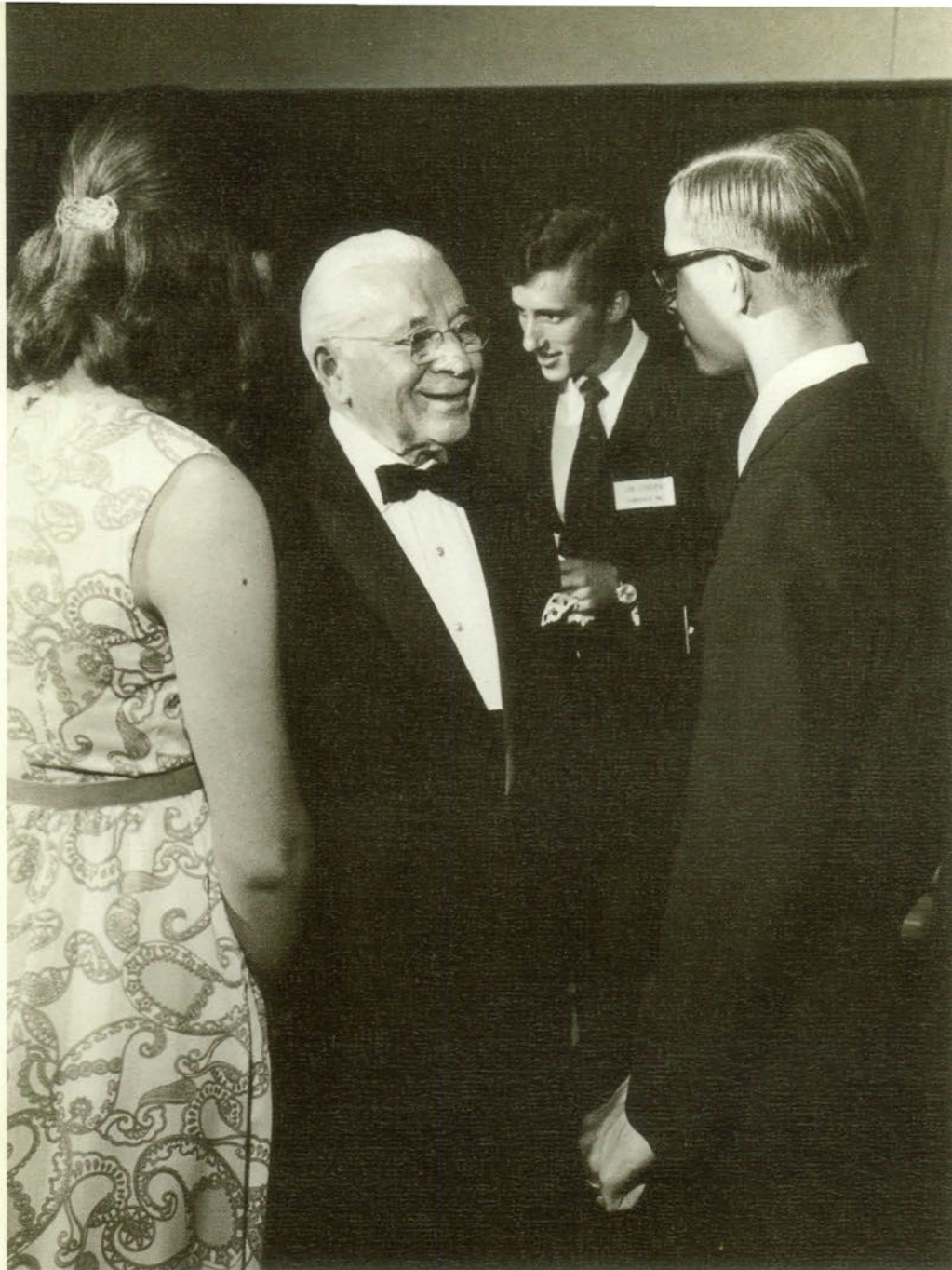




The Ambassador College Auditorium



With anticipated completion and opening scheduled for early 1974, the Auditorium-Concert Hall will be a crowning jewel in the master plan of the Pasadena Campus. The multi-use Auditorium will accommodate 1250 people in mainfloor and balcony seating for programs ranging from lectures and meetings to all types of musical and dramatic presentations. Total area of the Auditorium will be 52,000 square feet, including a full working stage, orchestra pit, elevator, demountable orchestra shell, rehearsal rooms, dressing room and green room to be used for live performances. A fully equipped projection room, sound and light control facilities, along with conduits for closed-circuit TV complete the mechanical installation and auxiliary facilities. Ranking in quality of materials, completeness of stage rigging, lighting and performance facilities with the most advanced concert halls built in the U.S. during the last decade, the new Auditorium will be one of the most elegant formal public buildings of its type ever constructed in Southern California.

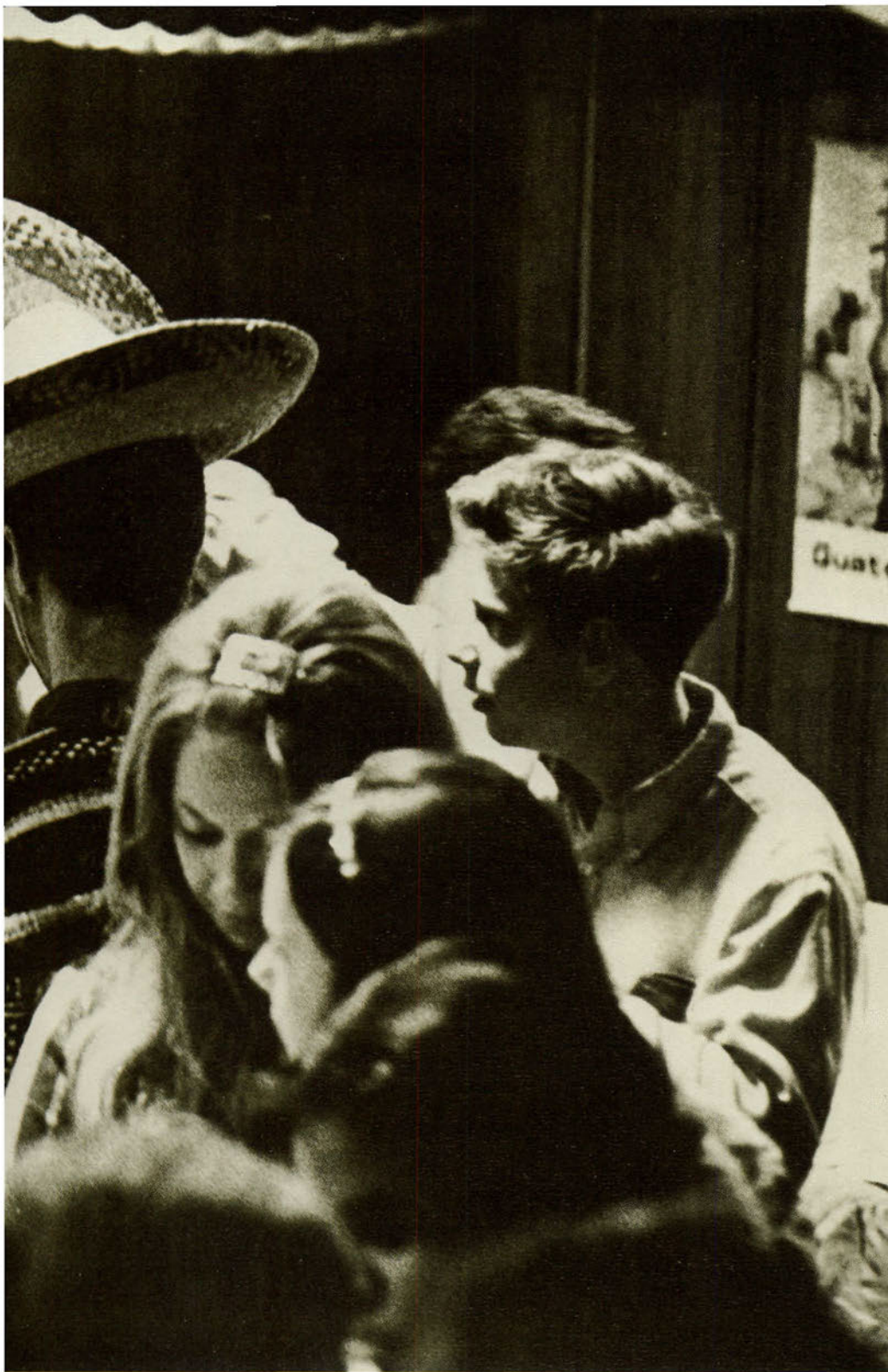

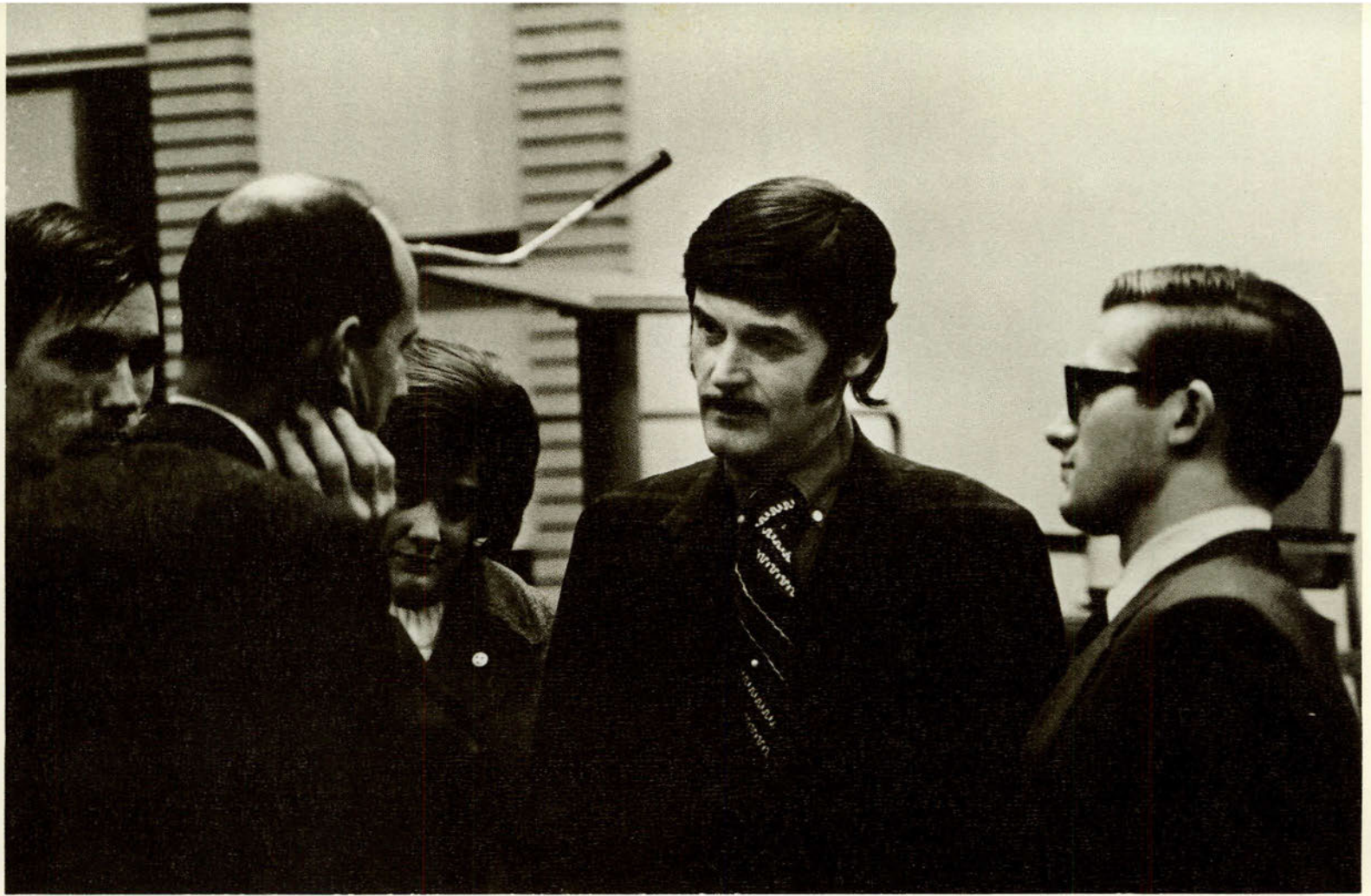

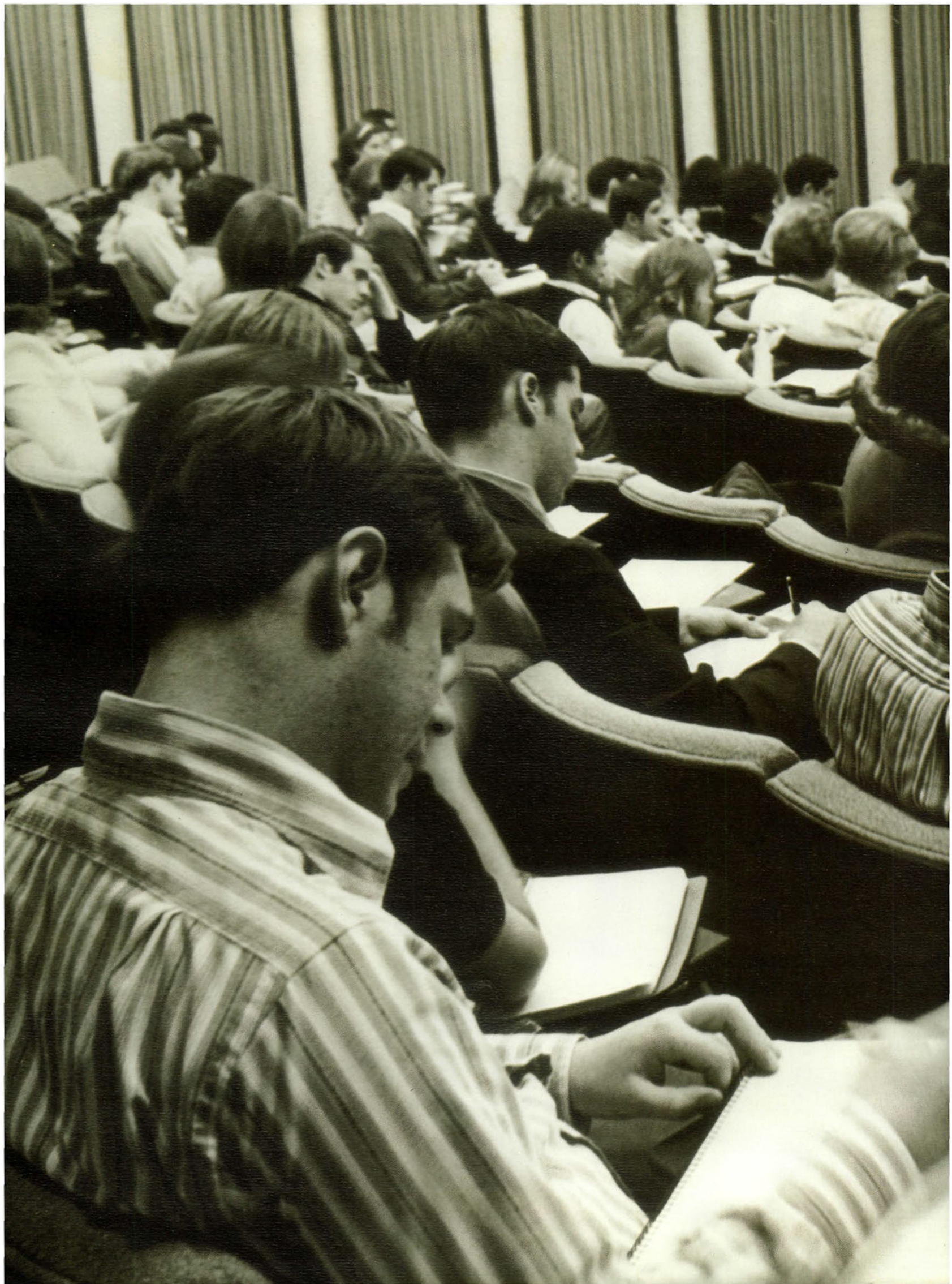

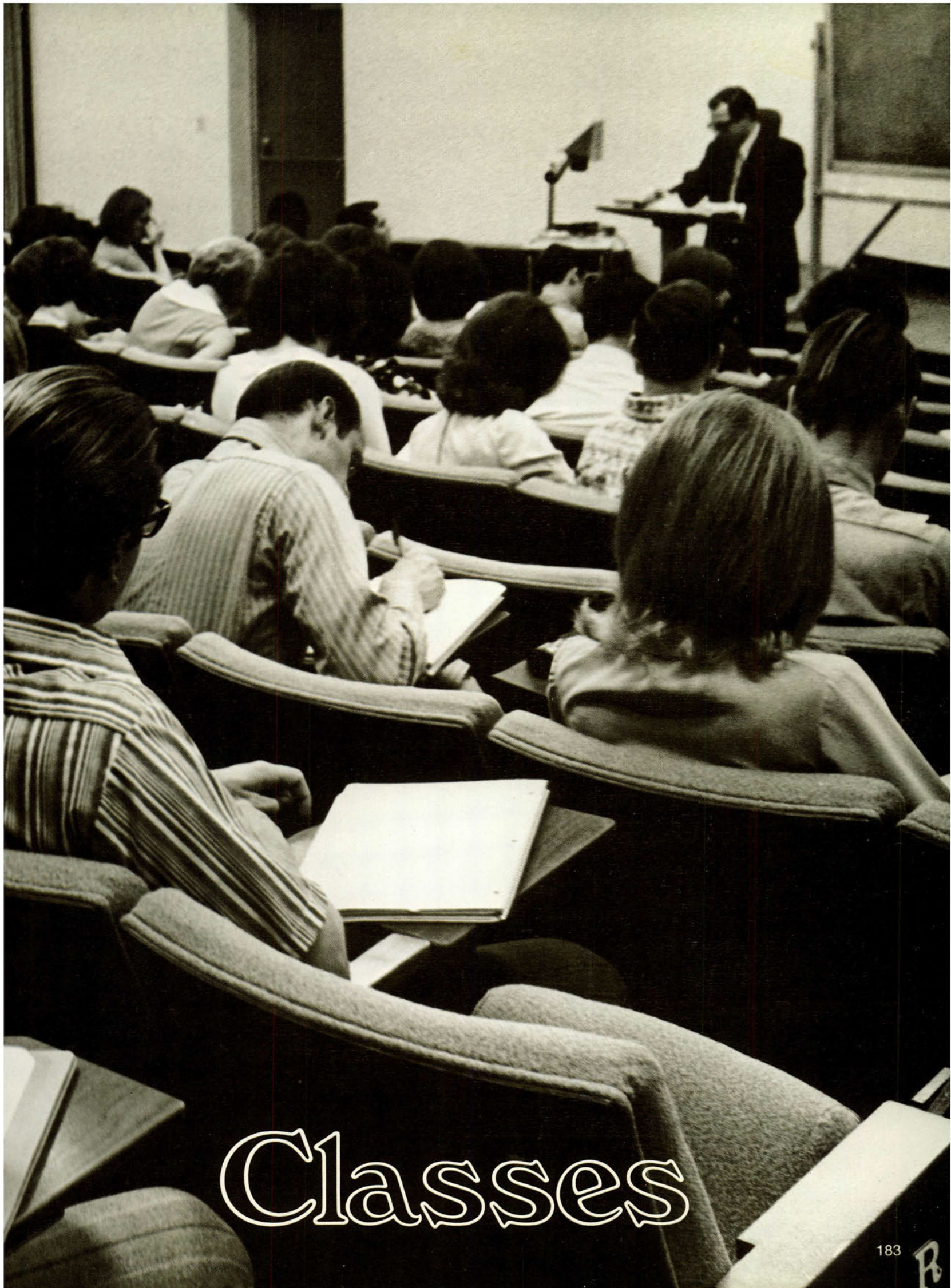

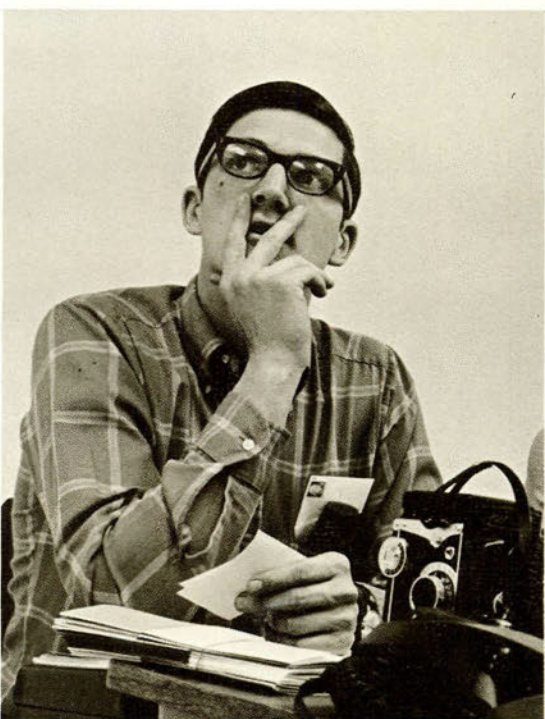
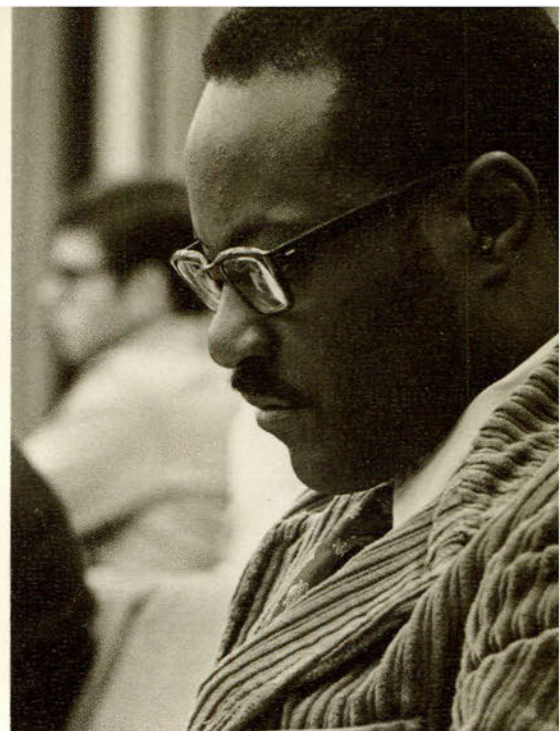


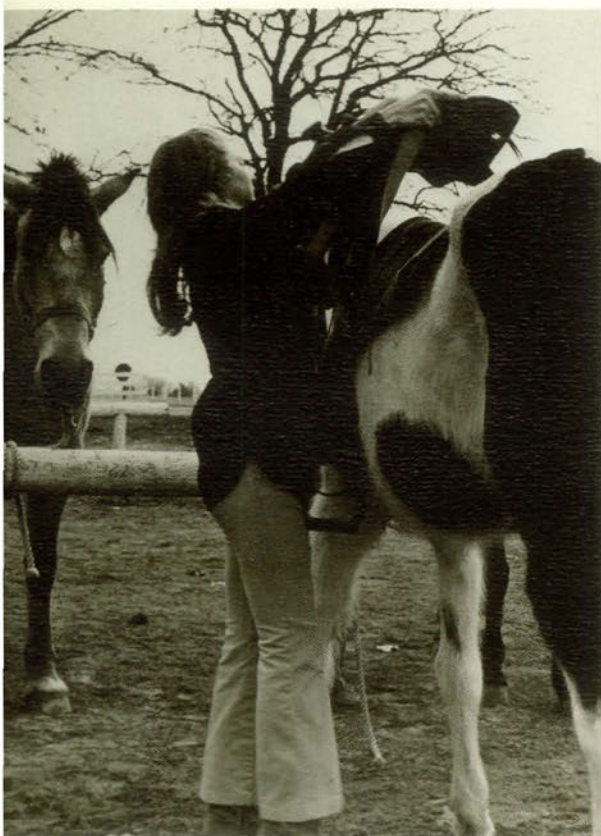
Classes

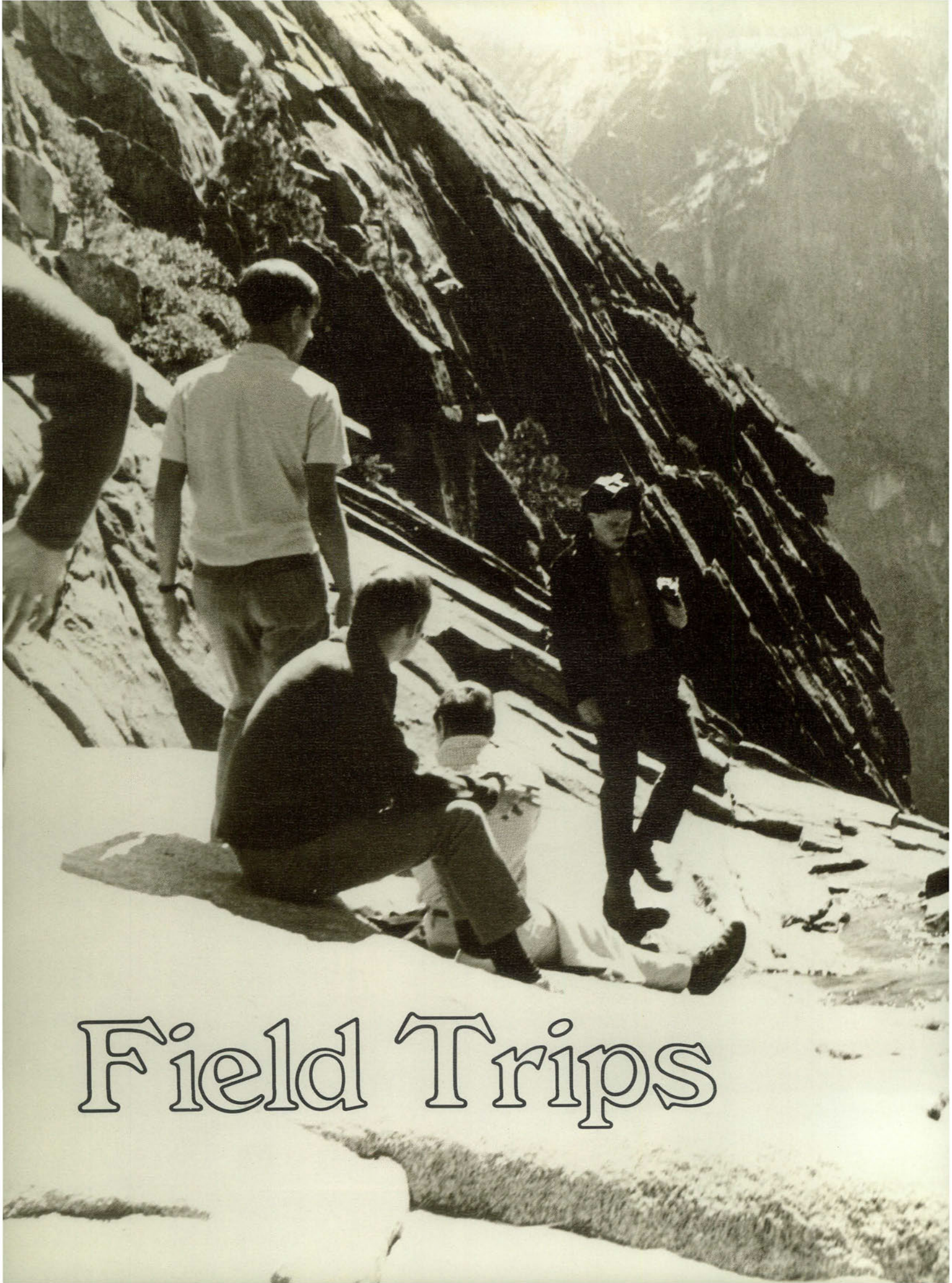

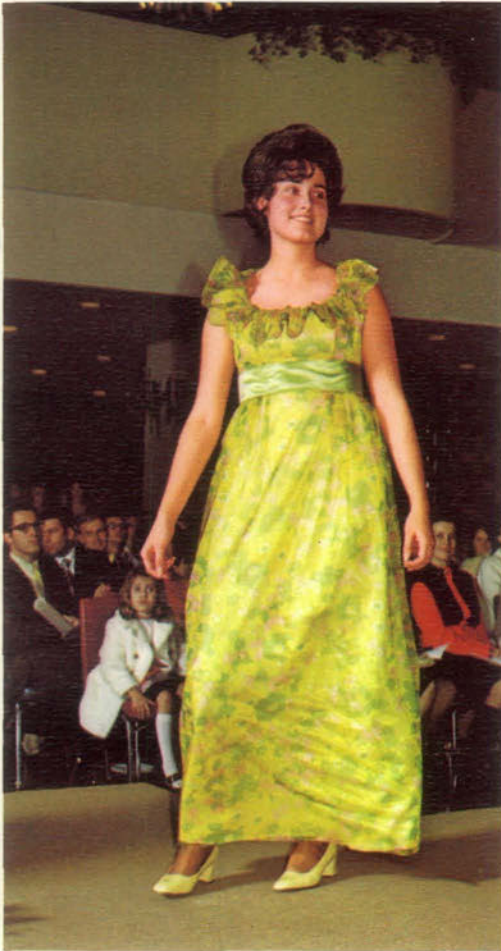

Archaeological “Dig”

Students from all three Ambassador College campuses have participated each summer for the past three years in an archaeological “dig” in the city of Jerusalem. Working in full collaboration with Hebrew University and the Department of Antiquities, Ambassador College began providing financial assistance to the archaeological project in 1968, and in 1969 began to provide summertime student manpower. The “dig” is located on the central part of a ridge stretching from the Temple Mount—Mount Moriah of the Bible—southward to the Pool of Siloam. In its present state it occupies a full five acres of land and in many places has been excavated to a depth of more than fifty feet. The direction and extent of future excavations depends largely on discoveries made day by day. Whatever its future course, the “Big Dig” certainly rates a place in archaeological annals as one of the most impressive and interesting excavations of all time.



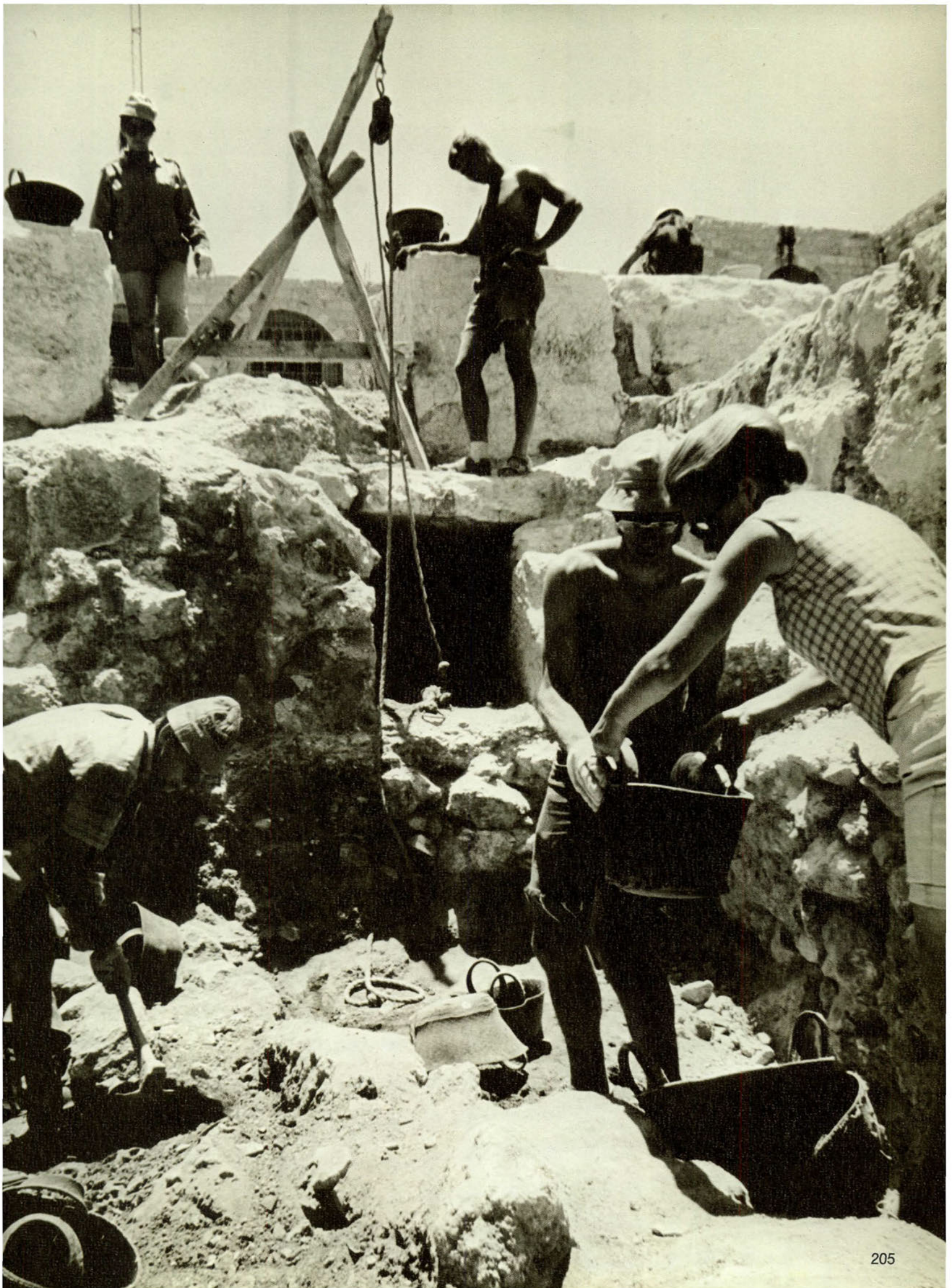

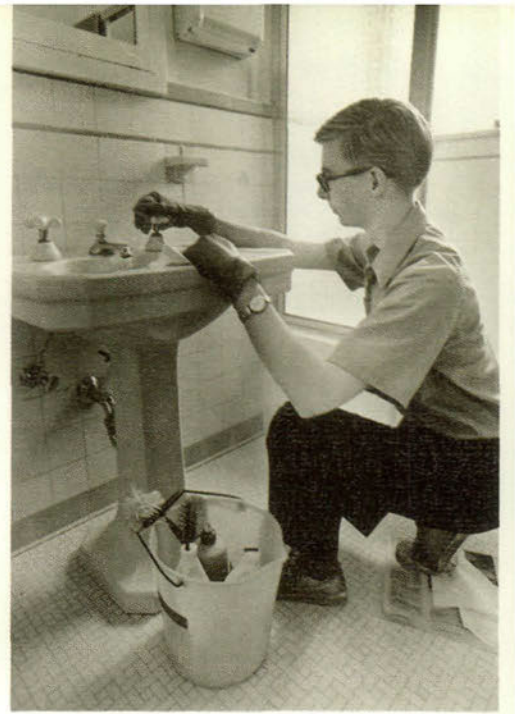

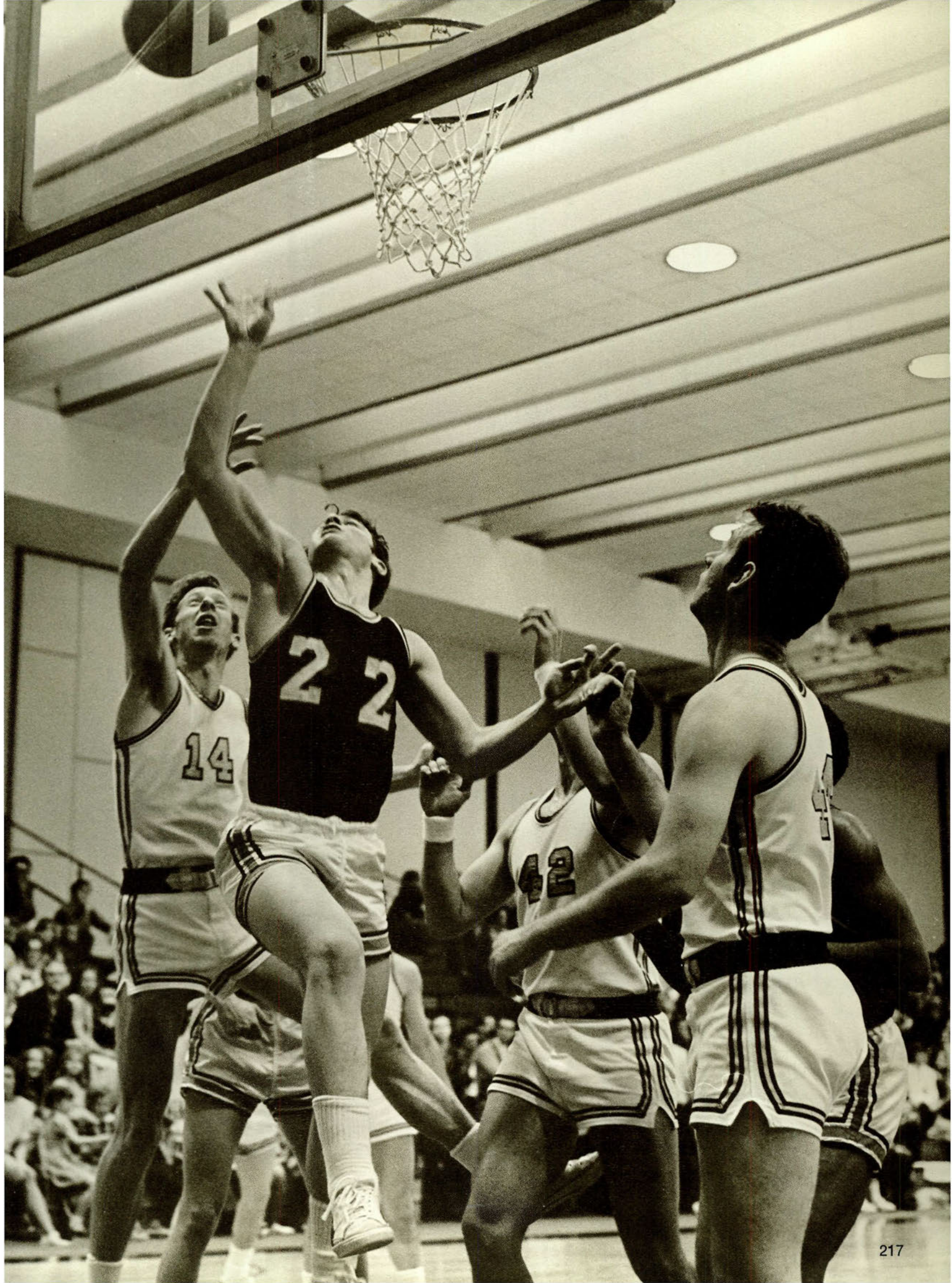

The Portfolio

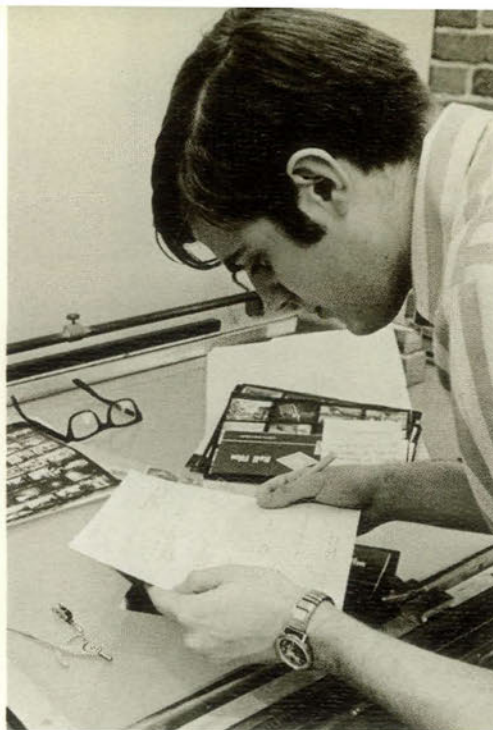
