Matt. 24;30 reads, "Then shall appear the sign of the Son

of man in heaven". Early SDA's and many other Sabbath keepers overlooked this statement when they taught that the generation that saw the stars fall would see the coming of Christ. We are not told just what this sign is, and this is the only place we find this statement in the Bible. However, many other significant statements are found only once in the Bible. Only once does the book of Jonah recite that Jonah was three days and three night in the great fish. Only once does the New Testament specify specifically that the only sign of Christ Messiahship was burial "three days and three night". Matt. 12;40. Only once does the Word tell us the exact time of Christ's resurrection. Matt. 28 chap. Only once does it recite the vision of Christ's transfiguration and the glimpse of the three apostles into the Kingdom of God. Matt. 16;28 and Matt. 17: 1-9. Only once does it describe minutely his ascension. Acts. 1; 7--11. Only once does it say, "When the Lord shall build up Zion, He shall appear in His Glory". Ps. 102; 16.

As you say in your recent issue "All the World has Tuned in on Palestine". The events are significant and certainly must be fulfilling ancient predictions of the re-establishment of literal Israel prior to Shrist's advent. The Lord wants us to watch these events as they unfold before us and be alert that we may not be asleep when he comes. Fersonally, I would rather be alert and overzealous in my predictions and be mistaken,

than to be asleep and inert, when he comes.
