Dear Brother Mote:

Yours of recent date came safely to hand, and it is with pleasure and grateful thanks that I acknowledge the same. We all appreciate this loving co-operation on your part, and we are so glad that there are even a few like you who are following the Master as faithful stewards in His vineyard. You will be blessed according to the promise of the Word, as well as others to whom the message of salvation will be given.

We are glad to report that Israel has been blessed with abundance of rain ever since two days were set apart for prayer for rain, as it had been unusually dry for the winter season. The last two weeks in February it rained or snowed some every day. There was snow in the high elevation like Jerusalem more than they have had here for many years, but it never stayed on the ground only a few hours. There has been more rain now in the far south of Israel, and around Bersheba that there was all last year. They have also opened up another oil and gas field, and have one gas well that registers 500,000 cubic meters of gas daily, and most of the oil wells in Israel flow and do not have to be pumped.

There are around two thousand immigrants pouring in daily. They come by ship and by plane, and are distributed mostly in the farming districts. It is all very wonderful, as we see the announcements of Israel's ancient prophets being fulfilled, while Gentile nations Russia and the Arabs threaten Israel's destruction, but at the same time they prepare war to destroy one another. The Arab countries bordering on Israel are increasing their attacks and it seems that possibly a show down may come this summer, but it all speaks plainly of the very near return of our Saviour and deliverer. We must all pray much for victory over the enemy as he makes war on the REMNANT people, that we may have strength and power to resist every temptation, and remain obedient and profitable servants, worthy of the deliverance promised us. Deut. - 12:1, and Luke 21:36. We are nearer to that time than many think.

My family, and the Reporter staff join me in sending greetings, best wishes and thanks to you and yours, and may the heavenly Father always protect you guide lead and prosper you in our prayer.
