## Dear Brother Wagenleitner;

Herewith are the forms for execution by the various trustees in order that we may record the ownership under a fictistious name, that is the GATHERING CALL. You will notice I have left off the street address on account of the fact that the address is to be changed. I have executed the original copy and it will be necessary for each trustee to sign and have his signature notarized and then attached to the regular form. I consulted and attorney this morning and he assured me that this would be a legal proceedure and that each notarized signature can be attached to the form in any convenient location.

Brother Mote has written me that he has difficulty in cashing checks and executing business and that his bank in Riverside advises him that the recording of these papers will make it possible to transact business much easier than is the case now. It seems that Brother Ballenger never did make any such recording and it is my belief that we should. As soon as the Board of Trustees executes this document we should expedite it as speedily as possible. I am also afraid that if we do not do this the administrators of Brother Ballenger's estate might cause us trouble.

Will you kindly get your signature notarized and then forward the papers to Brother R. B. Tower, P. O. Box 332, Woodlake, Calif. I am writing to Brother Tower about this matter and then Brother Tower should send the papers to Sister Grace Pirtle, 2166 Ashby Ave., Berkeley, Calif, and then Miss Pirtle should send it to Forbes Davidson, Kt. 2, Box 18E, Placerville, Calif., and Brother Davidson send it back to me. I am attaching a copy of this letter to the form so that it will be an instruction for each trustee.

I wish you would write me with reference to your opinion as to what we should do about the duplex that is in Brother Ballenger's estate, and about which Brother Mote writes as follows: "I have been thinking about the old duplex that belonged to Brother Ballenger up on N. Vine. In as much as the estate is bound by law to pay the GATHERING CALL the sum of \$3,000 in due course, it might be that arrangements could be made to exchange our claim on that \$3,000 that we will eventually get for that much equity in the duplex and go on paying for It from there. That would solve the old matter of a place to live and store the CALL and it would give one rental on the other side that would help support the work."
