I have just finished reading brother Frank Walker's final installment of Armageddon in the April issue of The Acts, and I liked it very much. His views and mine on prophecy for the last days seem to parallel pretty closely.

I notice also, that The Acts is now being printed by the photo-offset method of some kind. Apparently it is done with something like a Verityper, image burner and Multilith press. Am I right? It looks fine, and for some time I have been toying with the idea of using some similar method with The Gathering Call.


I have had an awful lot of trouble with two old Linotype machines, to the extent that I am about ready to sell the Linotype machine and the letter press and produce the magazine the way you do The Acts, or by some similar method.

At the time we acquired the printing equipment, I chose the only process that I knew anything about at the time. Since then, I have come to the conclusion that a Verityper and Multilith would probably give me much less trouble than an old, obsolete Linotype machine.

I know you are probably a busy man, but if you have the time and inclination, I would appreciate it if you would describe in more or less detail the printing process you use, and the approximate cost of the equipment. I fervently wish I could pay you a visit and observe firsthand, but that is impossible at this time.

Any help or advice you can give me in the matter will be most appreciated.
