Dear Mr. Mote,

Your letter of April 18th received and I was very glad to hear from you. I am not located at Los Angeles now, as my work as District Overseer requires quite a bit of traveling around. Elder Clayton Faubion is the new Pastor at Los Angeles, and I am sure that he will be happy to welcome you in their church there, located at 425 Laconia Boulevard, Los Angeles.

Your best route would be to take Highway #91 out of Riverside to Highway #101 until you come to "Imperial Highway" (name of a street). Take "Imperial Highway" to Figueroa street, and turn south on it until you reach Labonia Boulevard (about  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile), turning then left about  $\frac{1}{2}$  block east. It (Laconia) is also the same as 124th street.

Riverside is a very nice place and we hope that you will like your new home. The climate is very fine there the year around and we hope that you will find it also conducive to your health.

There are quite a few important differences between the Church of God and Seventh Day Adventists. I do not believe that we need go anywhere but to the Bible for God's revelations to His people and the true gospel.
