We live on a ranch, but not doing much now. We are both getting up in years. I am 72 and wife is 71. Wife has not been well for three yrs. She has Paralysis Agatare. Gets around and does some of her work.

When we were in Kansas 35 years ago I was Educational Secretary for the Kansas Conference. I got a little too wise and saw that I could not teach the truth as I see it, so just stepped out and came
