## GOD AND HUMANITY PART IT

(Editors Note Concerning J. Q.A.) We dreamed that John Quincy Adams and his son John Quincy Adams Jr. Made the 1st Grade in Heaven and God was kind enough to say it was because of my nursing. These were both seen in their beautiful glorified bodies after the Resurrection in 1953 oct 11--Three of us in Adam's flock saw this one manifestd in his glorified form but as is ever the case SOME DOUBT.)

In these BRIEF STUDIES We are concerned with TWO THINGS FIRST, Is God real; Second, if He is, then what is the proper relationship of Humanity to Him:more particularily, What is your proper relationship to Him?

In our First St udy, we said there are Three Sciences, each of whichactually proves the Reality of God and into one we looked: The accurate fulfillment, even to the last detail, of things definitely foretold "Deity" thousands of years before their coming to pass, and their coming to pass at exactly the time foretold, by centuries or millennia, ahead of time. Such can not be by chance; it proves definitely God is what He claims to be. He not only exists but He is the most REAL of all realities!

CAUSALITY 6

Now to prove the reality and existance of God from another Science, -- Caus-

There's a wedding cake, in the dining-room and sparkling glasses, silver-

ware, dishes and napkins. What caused it ? A Cook! As the old axiom is, nothing exists without a cause". ----

No matter what happens, what begins to exist, it has a cause , things them-selves, the cake, a hair-pin, snow falling, rain coming-down, wind blowing, flowers blooming, vegetables and grass es growing, --- all things are CAUSED.

And the things that are caused, is the effect. You cause clean clothes by washing them. So whatever begins to exist at all before it started to exist, MUST have a cause. The thing that -exists must have a reason for its existance outside itself.

That is the principle of Causality.

Now let's look at the principle of Causality.

If a thing exists, it did'nt exist at all before it started to exist. And now we are ready to state TWO TREMENDOUS FUNDAMENTALS: First, No thing can exist w ithout a cause which makes it esist; and Secondly, The cause of a things existance must be outside o f itself---for it did not exist before it started to exist.

Let's take some examples. There is the wedding cake, it now exists. Butit did not exist at all before the cook began to mix the ingredients. So the cake began to exist and the cause of its existance can't be the cake itself, but something outs ide of itself is the Cause, in this case the cook.... ast week my little daughter, Mary found eight new puppies feeding on her dog, Lacy. Did these new puppies cause themselves, or, did something outs ide of (cont.on the next page)

ciple of Camsality. We see its truth and universality. First a thing cannot come into existance without a cause Second the cause is never in the thing itself, for the thing itself did not exist: therefore every time the cause of anything's existance is wholly outside itself. Do get these two points down clerely. Read them over and over again until they are clear and the Truth of each statement is realized. Here we go once more for the sake of clarity and emphasis, the cause is every time wholly outside of the thing itself, for the thing itself did not at first exist.

Now we are going to disclose a Third Fundamental Truth. Note it carefully 1) The Nature of a thing; 2) The surrounding essentials to a thing, help to discover the nature of its cause (or Ceator ). But just this is going to prove the existance and reality of God. This proof is genuine. No one can disprove it. No one has. A few absolute atheists have refused to discuss it, but that is is all they can do.

And so now we come to a fourth great Truth, Self evident from what has

been already established. Here it is.

Since the First Cause is the First Cause it naturally follows that it couldn't have been Caused by any thing else, or it would not be the First Cause. Therefore the real and sure enough First Cause had to exist forever. OH, DO get that "Had To Exist Forever"!

Everything that exists; had to have a cause for its existance outside of isself EXCEPT the First Cause, or the First Cause would not be the First Cause/. Therefore the actural First Cause had to exist forever.

Now let's review these four great Truths simply by restating them. Here

First, Everything that exists has to have a caused that caused it to exist: Second. The cause of a things existance every time lies wholly outside itaself, for it did not exist to begin with, so it could not Cause itself, but is everytime Caused by something wholly outside of itself; Third. The nature and character of a thing helps us to learn the nature and character of the thing that caused or created it and. Fourth. The Cause of everything lies wholly outside of itself. EXCEPT the First Cause, or else it would not be the First Cause. Therefore the First Cause had to exist forever.

Go over these four Truths until each is clear in your understanding. Now let's diagram it. The First Cause either had a beginning or did not have a beginning.

FIRST CAWSE Had either

A Beginning no beginning or If it had no beginning . Now if it had a beginning; A. It was caused by something else;

C. It is eternal. 5. It caused itself.

Now consider all three possibilities.

A. It was caused by something else -- then it could not be the First Cause. B. It Caused itself, which would mean before it was, it was nothing. But nothing cannot cause something. Nothing cannot Cause a stick of Spearmint gum He Sathering Could by 2 adams or a stick of dynamite, a T-bone stak, or a T-shirt.

C. This leaves "C" the only remaining posibility hence, it is noternal. And this means that the First Cause had no beginning. There is no escaping this conclusion—or it would not be the First Cause. Dosen't it give us dring-beings a feeling of littleness? No beginning.

Now for one other point concerning the eternal aspect. If the First Cause exists of its elf, in virture of its own power, then it follows logically that it will never cease existing. It always had its own power, then it follows logically thatit needs nothing more to continue its existance. So the First Cause will never stop being. Therefore it is both without beginning and without end.

Number 2 -- - read it again, please -- means the First Cause (which Biblically is said to be without beginning and without End, is called in the New Testament(1) The Word, and it is declaired to be that which is called in the Old Testament, second(2) God or Jehovah. Thus we learn the Bible name for The Eternal, First Cause, is the Word (in New Testament), or Jehovah God(in the Old Testament) "All things were made by Him" means He was The First Cause And this Scripture also means He is without End ("And without Him was not anythingmade that hath been made . "John1:1-2, .....

Number 3 -- - look back and read it again, please -- - meansthis factor or Cause is the First Cause:"I Am the First" that is no other Cause existed prior to Him, hence He is the First Cause! And this Scripture also means He is withoutEnd:"I Am the Last" -- there will not arise later another Cause which out of nothing creates all things. Therefore there are not TWO ,or Three , or more co-eternal and co-existing First Causes or Creators. DO GET THIS FUNDIMENTAL which comes to light;

The number of the verb of which the word is subject, shows for sure whether the word is singular or plural.
