

## EVERYBODY GOES TO HELL

Yes, friend; everybody goes to hell, whether good or bad. Even beasts go to the same place.

Eccles 3:19, 20. For that which be-falleth the sons of men befalleth beasts; as the one dieth, so do the other; so that a man has no preeminence over a beast. All go to one place: all are of dust, and all turn to dust again. Job 14:10. But man dieth—and lieth down, and riseth not: till the heavens be no more.

If I wait, the grave (hell) is mine house. Job 14:12, 13, 17-18.

The term "Hell" in the Bible is from the Hebrew, and Greek words "Sheol" and "Hades" which mean the grave; and not a place of fire with anything alive in it.

False teachers assert hell is a place of fire and torment, which is not truth, but a lie.

1 Cor. 15:55 reads: O death, where is thy sting? O grave, (margin, hell) where is thy victory?

Here it is seen that "hell" and the "grave" mean the same thing; and it is from the grave (hell, Hades) that the righteous are raised at the sound of the trumpet of God, when Jesus comes. They are not in heaven, but in the grave, as Job says, Job 14:12, 13, 17-18. Eccles. 9:10. There is no work, nor device, nor knowledge, nor wisdom, in the grave, whither thou goest.

God said: "Dust thou art; and unto dust shalt thou return. Gen. 2:7, 3:17." When the breath leaves the body, man is dead, and is buried in the grave, or hell, and turns to dust, and knows nothing. When Jesus comes; the same body will be restored, and given immortal life; raised up from the grave (hell). John 6:40. Rom. 8:11. 1 Cor. 15:51-55.

The breath in man, is the spirit, and was put in man's nostrils when God made man. Gen. 2:7. The breath is not an immortal soul, or spirit; as many inflexible teachers declare. It has no intelligence apart from the body, and man dies when the breath (spirit) leaves the body.

Rev. 20:13. And death and "hell" (margin, grave) were cast into the lake of fire.

Here it is seen that "hell" and "grave" are the same place. You will go to hell (the grave) at death. Will you come out at the resurrection when Jesus comes soon?

If wicked, or in sin. You will not be raised. Isa. 26:14. It is a lie to promise life to the wicked. Ezek. 13:22.

But if in Christ, you will be raised. John 6:40. 1 Thess. 4:14, 16. 1 Cor. 15:

Are you in Christ? or wicked and not in him? John 5:40. 6:40, 53. 3:36.

Better make sure before too late or you will stay in the grave (hell) and perish; not live forever.

## THE REASON MAN SINS

The law of God is the Ten Commandments, spoken and written by God personally. Exodus 20:1-17. Dent. 4:12, 13. It is a perfect, righteous law, and is not sin. Psa. 19:7, 119:172. Rom. 7:7, 12.

To keep it is man's whole duty, and the way to have blessings, mercy, and eternal life. Rev. 22:14. Isa. 56:2.

Psalms 103:17, 18. Matt. 19:17. By keeping all of the law, love to God is proved, and righteousness done. 1 John 5:1-13. 1 John 3:7, 8.

To break any of the Ten Commands is to sin, and be a sinner. 1 John 3:4.

Why do so many professed Christians and churches reject the law of God, and violate it?

The Baptist Church manual says "we believe that the law of God is the eternal and unchangeable rule of His moral government; that it is holy, just and good; and the inability which the scriptures ascribe to fallen men to fulfill its precepts, arises entirely from the love to sin."—pp 52, 42. Art. 12.

God commands to love Him; not sin. Sin separates from God, so multitudes are not keeping the great commandment "Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart" but choose the way of sin and death. 1 John 3:4. James 2:10. Rom. 6:23.

Are you loving sin more than God and His righteous law? Examine yourself and see. Sin will destroy you; only righteousness will gain mercy and eternal life. John 8:11. Psa. 37:29. Matt. 19:17. Psalms 103:17, 18. Matt. 23:46. Rev. 22:14.

Does your pastor love sin, more than God? Ask him, why?

Follow Jesus and cast away sin.

He that turneth his ear from hearing the law, even his prayer shall be abomination. Prov. 28:7.

Your iniquities (sin) have separated between you and your God; and your sins have hid His face from you, that He will not hear. Isa. 59:1, 2.

God heareth not sinners. John 9:31. Psa. 18:41, 34, 16, 66:18. Prov. 1:28.

The Lord is far from the wicked, but He heareth the prayer of the righteous. Prov. 15:29. Breaking the law of God is sin. 1 John 3:4. Jas. 2:10. Exodus 20:1-17.

## THUS SAITH THE LORD

Exodus 20:1-17. Thou shalt not and remember. Even Ten Commandments, which are the foundation of the Government of God.

To break any law is to be a law-breaker; so it is with God's law. Sin is breaking any command of the law. 1 John 3:4. Jas. 2:10. Exodus 20:1-17.

Thus saith the Lord—The seventh day is the sabbath of the Lord, thy God; remember to keep it holy. In it thou shalt not do any work. Exodus 20:8-11. No other day is the sabbath of God; and can be kept in place of the seventh day.

Thus saith the Lord—God made man out of the dust of the ground; breathed into his nostrils breath of life; and man became a living soul. Gen. 2:7.

Dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return. Gen. 3:19.

So man has not an immortal soul or spirit as so many assert.

The body of dust without breath is a dead soul, but with breath is a living soul. Man is the soul.

Thus saith the Lord—The soul that sins, it shall die. Ezek. 18:4. The whole world is guilty before God. Rom. 3:19. Rom 5:12. Death has passed upon all men, for all have sinned.

The cemeteries bear witness to the truth that all souls die; and the body (dead soul) returns to dust; does not go to heaven as many teach. The breath (spirit) is not a separate person from the body.

Thus saith the Lord—All the wicked will God destroy. Psa. 145:20. They shall consume into smoke. Psa. 37:20. Become ashes. Mal. 4:1-3. Be punished with everlasting destruction. 2 Thess. 1:8, 9.

So another popular lie about a place of eternal torment and living wicked souls in it, is swept away.

The word of God is truth.

It is sin to break anyone of the Ten Commandments. Jas. 2:10.

So it is sin to break the fourth command and work on the Seventh day. Exodus 20:8-11.

## THIS IS THE LOVE OF GOD

1 John 5:3. For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments and His commandments are not grievous.

What is the desire of God that man should do?  
Duets. 5:29. O that there were such a heart in them, that they would fear me, and keep all my commandments always; that it might be well with them, and with their children forever.

What are the commandments of God? Deut. 4:12, 13. And He declared unto you His covenant, which He commanded you to perform even Ten Commandments; and He (God) wrote them upon two tablets of stone.  
Exodus 20:1-17. And God spoke the Ten Commandments.

What is man's whole duty?  
Eccles. 12:13. Fear God and keep His commandments. This is the whole duty of man.

The commandments of God are the commandments that Jesus, the son of God, kept and taught to keep. John 15:10. Matt. 19:17. He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me. John 14:21.

1 John 2:4. He that saith I know Him; and keepeth not His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.

Reader, how about you? Do you love God, and prove it by your actions or just say and do not?

God demands obedience, and not mouth service. The marks of being a saint; and child of God is keeping His holy law. Rev. 12:17. 14:12. 1 John 3:7-10. Eek. 20:12-20.

To break the law is to be a sinner. 1 John 3:4, 9, 12.

## WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

Truth alone is important to know what is right. God's word is Truth. John 17:17. His law and seventh day Sabbath is Truth. Psalms 119:151. Exodus 20:8-11. Gen. 2:1-3.

Believing and doing truth, is the way of mercy, blessings, and eternal life. Psa. 103: 17, 18. Isa. 56:2. Matt. 19:17. Rev. 22:14.

Lies are the opposite of truth, and the way of sin and death. Isa. 8:20. 1 John 3:4. Jas. 2:10. Romans 6:23.

All liars; and those who love a lie; and make a lie; and believe a lie, shall have their part in the lake of fire. Rev. 21:8, 27, 22:15.

The Sunday Sabbath; and Sunday resurrection day is not Truth.  
Lookout Preachers what you teach.

## Big Noises on the Air

Over the radio and in the pulpit, a big noise is filling the air.

It declares God, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit are one person. God the Father, and the Holy Spirit, is inside of the Son, Jesus Christ like a telescope. It asserts that Jesus, the son of God, created all things, spoke the law on Mt. Sinai; made himself into a little baby; was born, grew up to be a man, and died on the cross, and came to life again, calling all the world to believe as above, or be lost.

The noise asserts that any seventh day is the sabbath. Though the law distinctly says "The Seventh Day" (Saturday) is the Holy Sabbath of God. Exodus 20:8-11.

The noise ignores facts and truth, and plain words making Jesus Christ to be a big deceiver; making his hearers to believe he was praying to himself, was going away, yet there he was all the time seen of all about him.

That the noise is foolishness, is seen by the facts that a father is not his own son; and the son not his own father. God is a real person with all wisdom and power, and created all things. Gen. 1:1. Exodus 20:11. Isa. 45:12. 46:9.

Jesus Christ is the son of God, and was born 4,000 years after creation (B. C. 4) his mother was Mary. Matt. 1:20-25. Died A. D. 31.

God only is immortal, and cannot die. 1 Tim. 1:16, 17, 6:16. But Jesus died, and was buried for three days and three nights. Matt. 27:50-60 and Jesus (not God) rose again, and lives forever. Was 30 years old in A. D. 27.

The big noise is only a wind, twisting Bible truths and soon blows away leaving nothing behind but wreckage. Stick to your Bible for it is truth and remains forever. As it says "God is the Father of Jesus Christ, Jesus is the Son, and the Holy Spirit is a third person."

## IN THE STEPS OF JESUS

Jesus said "my sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me. John 10:27."

1 Peter 2:21, 22. "For Christ suffered for us, leaving us an example, that we should follow in his steps, who did no sin."

1 John 2:6. "He that saith he abideth in him ought also to walk, even as he walked."

Jesus said "I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in His love. John 15:10.

Are you following in the steps of Jesus, keeping the law of God; and abiding in God's love and Jesus?

Are you hearing his voice. "If thou would enter into life eternal, keep the commandments. Matt. 19:17. Go sin no more. John 8:11? If not, why not?"

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## SEVEN MINDS

Mind your tongue! Do not let it speak hasty, cruel, unkind or wicked words.

Mind your eyes! Do not permit them to look on wicked books, pictures or objects.

Mind your ears! Do not suffer them to listen to wicked speeches, songs or words.

Mind your lips! Do not let tobacco foul them; do not let strong drink pass them.

Mind your hands! Do not let them steal, or fight, or write any evil words.

Mind your feet! Do not let them walk in the steps of sin, and evil ways.

Mind your heart! Do not let the love of sin dwell in it. Do not give it to the Devil; but love the Lord thy God, and ask Jesus Christ, the beloved Son of God, and your Redeemer, to make your heart his throne.

Your whole duty is to love God and keep His commandments. Eccles. 12:13. Blessed are they that do. Isa. 56:2, 3. Rev. 22:14.

Sunday keepers are following the Church of Rome; instead of God and the Bible.

No one can count three days and three nights from Friday eve at sunset, to Sunday morn before sunrise.

Anyone who insists they can, had better go back to school, and learn arithmetic. This means all Preachers, and religious teachers in all churches, who keep Sunday as the resurrection day.

When you repent, do you think you can keep on breaking God's law?

Grace, on mercy is granted on repentance on condition that "Continue not in Sin. Rom. 6:1-2." Go Sin no more. John 8:11. Isa. 55:7.

Don't let preachers fool you into losing life. "The soul that sins, it shall die. Ezek. 18:4."

Jesus said to his followers. He that receiveth whomsoever I send receiveth me; and he that receiveth me receiveth him that sent me. John 13:20.

He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him; the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day. John 12:48.

Go and sin, no more. John 8:11. If thou would enter into life eternal, keep the commandments. (Law of God) Matt. 19:17.

## Heretics and Heresy

What is a heretic and who is guilty? A little earnest consideration will give the answer.

Heresy—A departure from the established faith of a religious body. Heretics—One who departs from the faith, and teaches heresy.

It seems heaps of pastors and religious teachers are guilty from their actions. For they have departed from the faith of Jesus and of their own church manuals.

Proof as follows—The faith and doctrine of Jesus was to obey God's law. John 15:10. Matt. 19:17. Rev. 14:12. Exodus 20:1-17.

The Methodist Church Discipline says "No christian whatsoever is free from the obedience of the commandments which are called moral." (The Ten Commandments) p. 4, 5, article 6, edition 1911.

Constitution of the Presbyterian Church. Chapter 19. Sect. 5, pp 88, 89, 1910 edition.—"The moral law doth forever bind all, as well justified persons as others, to the obedience thereof."

The Baptist Church manual, p 55, edition 1903. "We believe the law of God is the eternal and unchangeable rule of His moral government to that it is holy, just and good—and to restore man through a mediator to unfeigned obedience to the Holy Law, is the one great end of the Gospel."

Yet in the face of these plain declarations, the Churches mentioned, with many others; neither obey the Holy Law of God; nor teach obedience to it. Ex. 20:8-11.

It is clear that they have departed from the established faith of God; and are teaching heresy; and are heretics. Why not return to God, and keep and teach His law as God and Jesus commands? Why depart from their own declarations of "We Believe" and teach sin?

Don't be a Heretic. Exodus 20:1-17.

## Cheap Salvation

Just join a church and you are saved. Believe Jesus is the son of God, and you are saved and under grace, is the popular teaching in Churches.

But God says different. If you are sinning, (breaking the law) you are not saved, nor under grace. Rom. 6:1-3. John 8:11. 1 John 3:8-10. Matt. 25:46. Ezek. 18:20, 24:5. All the sinners will God destroy. Psa. 145:20. Devil's believe and are not saved. Turn from sin and believe, then salvation is yours. Matt. 19:17.

# OF COURSE IT WAS WEDNESDAY

John 12:1. Then Jesus six days before the Passover came to Bethany. What day was the sixth day before the Passover?

The following statements by prominent religious writers answer the question.

"Jesus had arrived at Bethany six days before the Passover—that is on Friday."—Eidersheim, Vol. 2 p. 376. Life and Times of Jesus.

It was on Friday, six days before the Passover, that Jesus arrived at Bethany, Desire of Ages, Chapt. 62, paragraph 3, by Mrs. E. G. White.

Signs of Times: April 2, 1929.—in Question Corner; "It Was on Friday."

Beginning at Friday the sixth day before the Passover, we count "Saturday, the fifth day before: Sunday, the fourth day before: Monday, the third day before; Tuesday, the second day before; Wednesday, the first day before; Thursday, the Passover day."

The Passover day was a high day: a Sabbath; the day before (Wednesday) was the preparation day of the Passover. John 19:14, 31, and the day when the passover lamb must be slain.

Jesus, in order to be the Lamb of God must die at the same time. He did; therefore the crucifixion day is proved to have been on Wednesday; and not on Friday as many wrongly assert.

Wednesday, March 28th A. D. 31; is the day of the crucifixion; and exactly, three days and three nights later; in the End of the Sabbath. (Saturday at Sunset) Jesus arose from the tomb, as He predicted. Matt. 12:40.

A Friday crucifixion; and a Sunday resurrection is a fable, and not Truth. Believe your Bible and know.

The truth is clearly seen; the thief did not go to paradise the day Jesus died; he is still in his grave, but will come out when Jesus comes soon.

Have you the promise of Jesus? Will you be with Jesus when he comes into His kingdom. Will you believe and live again? The thief believed. Why not you? This is truth, not a fable.

## THE LORD'S DAY

Many churches claim that Sunday is the Lord's day. But that is not true. God calls the seventh day the Sabbath of God. Exodus 20:8-11.

Jesus said he was Lord of the Sabbath. Mark 2:28. As the Sabbath is the Seventh day, (Saturday) it is the Lord's day, and not Sunday.

Nowhere in the Bible is the name Lord's day applied to Sunday.

The first time the Lord's day was applied to Sunday, was by Tertullian, a Roman Bishop, about A. D. 260, long after all the Apostles were dead.

The Church of Rome liked the idea so much, it adopted the name and decreed it should be applied to the pagan day of worship, (Sunday) and decreed in A. D. 364 at the Council of Laodicea, that Christians should rest that day, instead of the Sabbath of God.

Christians are not obeying God; nor keeping the Lord's day, when they honor Sunday.

Why not keep the Bible Lord's day, (Saturday) Exodus 20:8-11, instead of Rome's heathen day?

Sunday is not the resurrection day; but the Sabbath is. Matt. 28:1-6.

## WHAT IS THE SOUL?

Much perplexity exists in the religious world over the terms "Soul" and "Spirit," in the Bible. It is asserted the Soul and Spirit, are a conscious being within man, which is immortal, and cannot die.

As God, only is immortal. I Tim. 1:17, and only "hath" immortality. I Tim. 6:15, 16, then man has no immortal part "Soul, or Spirit" as claimed.

God says: "Gen: 2:7. And God formed man out of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils breath of life, and man became a living soul."

Gen. 3:19.—"For dust thou art; and unto dust shalt thou return."

Without breath, man is a dead soul, but with breath man is a living soul. Psa. 146:4. His breath (spirit) goeth forth, he (the soul) returneth to his earth; in that very day his thoughts perish.

The spirit in man, is the breath, and without breath (spirit) man is a dead soul.

James 4:14. What is your life? (spirit breath.) It is even a vapour, that appeareth for a little time; and then vanisheth away. Ezek. 37:9, 10, shows breath and wind mean the same thing in the body, (soul) man is alive: out of the body (soul) man is dead.

Job 17:1. Breath and spirit are the same thing (see margin) Job 7:7. My life is wind, (breath, or spirit.)

God put breath, into the body made of dust, Gen. 2:7. He did not put an immortal life, or so called spirit in man.

The spirit, (wind, breath) leaves the body, and the soul (body) returns to dust. That is the truth as God declares it.

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## A BIBLE TRUTH PROVED

Jesus spoke the truth: False teachers are wrong.

A controversy rages as to the day Christ was crucified; and the day of His resurrection.

Many assert Jesus was crucified on Friday and arose Sunday morning before daybreak.

Others say no, Wednesday was the day of crucifixion, and Saturday evening the time of resurrection. Which of these views is right?

As the Bible is truth; by it will the question be settled, as we now examine.

Jesus said, "Matt. 12:40. For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the Whale's belly; so shall the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth."

Are there three days and three nights from Friday evening at sunset, to Sunday morning at daybreak?

Any school boy who can count, will say, no! Let us count, Friday night—1 night. Saturday—1 day, 1 night.

Resurrection claimed to be Sunday morning. Only 2 nights and one day from Friday evening to Sunday morning.

Where is the second and third day, and third night? Not there. Christ would have to rise Monday evening to tell the truth, as He said.

The record of the resurrection is found in Matt. 28:1. Mark 16:1-6. Luke 24:1-7. John 20:1-1-12.

Matt. 28:1. Records the first visit to the tomb as being "In the End of the Sabbath." (at sunset of Saturday.) But Jesus was not there, "He had Risen" before they arrived.

Mark, Luke and John, record other visits, twelve hours later, on Sunday morn; but in none of them was Jesus in the tomb, for "He had Risen."

The following translations of the Bible, prove the visit of Matt. 28:1, was not on any part of Sunday; but was at sunset of Saturday. (the Seventh Day Sabbath.)

Matt. 28:1. Authorized version.—"In the end of the Sabbath as it began to dawn toward the first day of the week." Revised version—"Now late on the Sabbath."

American Bible Union, N. T.—"And in the close of the Sabbath:." "And Late In The Sabbath."

Tischendorf New Testament.—"Now Late In The Sabbath."

Dean Alford—"Now In The End of The Sabbath."

Rotherham—"And late in the week when it was on the point of dawning into the first of the week."

The New Testament.—"Now Late on The Sabbath as it was getting Dark Toward (the) First (Day) (The) week."

The Sabbath is the Seventh day, (or Saturday) God declares, Exodus 20:8-11.

Sunday is called the first day of the week, and is after the Sabbath had ended, or past, Mark 28:1. "Now when the Sabbath was past.—Very early in the morning of the First day of the week, they came at the rising of the sun."

The visit in Matt. 28:1. was twelve hours before the visits in Mark, Luke and John: and was "In The End of the Sabbath." Just before Sunday began.

Jesus had already risen before the Marys got there; the angel told them. Matt. 28:5-6.

Sunday is not the resurrection day. As Jesus spoke the truth and was three days and three nights in the tomb; counting back from the end of the Sabbath; (sunset of Saturday) we find that Wednesday was the crucifixion day.

Sunset Wednesday eve to Thursday sunset, one night, one day.

Sunset Thursday eve to sunset Friday eve, two nights and two days.

Sunset Friday eve to sunset Saturday eve (the Sabbath.) exactly three nights and three days.

Matthew bears witness, that it was at that time that Jesus "had risen," and was not in the tomb, Matt. 28:1-6.

Only blind people can ignore the facts, and wrongly claim a Sunday resurrection; either in the evening, or morning. Additional evidence to what is stated, is found in the day and time of the crucifixion.

Mal. 3:9. 10. Ye are cursed with a curse, for ye have robbed me. Haggai 1:5, 6.

If anyone walks in sin; breaking the law, and lamp of God; they walk in darkness, and have no fellowship with Jesus. I John 1:6. Eph. 5:11. Jesus sits with God on His throne; not with Satan. Rev. 3:21. Exodus 20:1-17.

Take this lamp God provides, and walk safely in its light. Don't throw it away as multitudes and fable preachers do; but know sin, and shun it. Do righteousness and live. Psa. 37:20, 29. Matt. 19:17. Rev. 22:14.

Now let us look at the other light of God; which shows the future of this earth, and the final destination of the earth and man.

Says Peter—"We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place. I Peter 1:17."

The special lights concerning this earth and its final condition are found in Daniel 2:7. Matt. 24. Revelation in all its 22 chapters. 2 Peter 3:1-13.

They reveal a day of judgment is appointed; and this heaven and earth, will be replaced by a new heaven and new earth that day. Rev. 21:1-4. 2 Peter 3:13.

Mortal life, sin death, and all evil will forever end that day. Matt. 24:29, 30; 13:39-41. John 6:40. I Cor. 15:51-55. Rev. 20:14-15. Mal. 4:1-3.

A. D. 31. was the crucifixion year.

The Jews Passover was on Thursday, March 29th that year.

The Passover lamb had to be killed the day before; Exodus 12:6. Which was the preparation day of the Passover?

Jesus, in order to fulfill the sacrifice as the Lamb of God; had to die, at the same time the passover lamb must be slain. This He did; so on Wednesday eve, the preparation day of the Passover; March 28th, A. D. 31, Jesus was crucified.

The Passover day was a Sabbath; as was also the weekly seventh day Sabbath.

It was on the preparation day of the Passover Sabbath (Wednesday) that Jesus died. John 19:14. Not on Friday, the preparation day of the seventh day Sabbath.

There are not three days and three nights from Friday eve to Sunday morn; but there are three days and three nights from Wednesday eve sunset to Saturday eve sunset.

Jesus could not arise at any time Sunday morn or night.

Those who claim to honor Sunday as the resurrection day, instead of the Sabbath of God; (the seventh day) have no authority for so doing.

There is no command, nor example in all the Bible to honor Sunday; and the facts show it is not the resurrection day.

Sunday, as a rest day; or Sabbath, is a fable and invention of man.

It is best to hear and obey God, if mercy and eternal life is desired. Matt. 20 19:17, Psalms 103:17-18, Exodus 20:1-17, Isa. 55:7, Eccles. 12, 13, Rev. 22:14.

Jesus says, "To Sin no more: John 8:11. Why not heed His advice?"

## THEY KNEW NOT

Jesus warns the world of its great danger, saying: "But as the days of Noah were, so also shall the coming of the son of man be."

For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and given in marriage,
