Dear Brother, and Sister In The Faith:-

Greetings from Jerusalem the Holy City, Nehemiah 11:1, Matt. 4:5, etc.--"The Lord shall bless thee out of Zion, and thou shalt see the good of Jerusalem all the days of thy life". Psalms 128:5.

I hope this letter will find you and your loved ones all well, as it leaves us, and all rejoicing in the precious promises. We are still having trouble along Israel's borders, but may expect such to continue more or less to the end. We have no fears however. His will be done. Luke 12:32. We like it in Israel. The people are more Bible minded than anywhere we have ever lived. It seems the spirit of the country. This is not only confined to the returning exiles however, for example our daughter Naomi Faith recently told her little boy Jonathan that they were going to Joppa that day. Although only two and a half years of age he quickly responded with the question,--"Will Jonah be there"?

They visited a family of our brethren living near Joppa, and brought the little sea shell inclosed from the sea shore where Jonah had his experience with the whale. The postal card is a colored film photograph under the water at the bottom of the Red Sea near Elath the southern point of Israel. We thought you would like these unusual souvenirs.

I shall be glad to send you more of these cards free in case you are situated so you could hand them to your friends, and to the business men where you do your trading, and ask them for an offering for the good work in Israel. It would not be necessary for you to go into detail to explain to them the nature of this call, but I will explain it to you so you will understand.

We have purchased a typesetting machine (Linotype), at a real bargain, and have it paid for. It is of no benefit however without our printing press, which is just what we need and as good as new. They have held it now for us quite a while, but say they will not be able to hold it much longer, and we do not have the money yet to make the down payment which is about three thousand dollars, before they will bring it to our place. Then besides this we must have a folding machine to fold the papers and tracts, a great saving in labor and time, also a wire stitcher and paper cutter.

"The Lord (Elohim) gave the Word. Great was the company of those that published it"-Psalms 68:11. Preaching and publishing the Word are so closely associated that the tithe may be used for either one. Those dear ones who have ALREADY, and others who WILL place a portion of his or her life over here, represented in tithes or offerings, will in this way live on and be constantly preaching the gospel through this machinery till the Master comes in His kingdom. It is to be used strictly for religious printing and nothing else, and affords a great opportunity for investment for spiritual returns according to Matt. 6:19, 20.

We need this equipment badly and need it immediately. If you have been blessed so you can, and the Father lays this work upon your heart, we will sure appreciate whatever you can send of your surplus, or your tithes, or what you can raise with these cards from your friends, and you will be blessed according to Genesis 12:3. This is an unusual and special call and I wanted to let you know all about it. Please also pray with us that these needs will be quickly met.
