Dear Brother in The Faith:-

Greetings again from Jerusalem. We hope this will find you and your loved ones well, and we are sure that you find joy and interest watching the unfolding of Bible prophecy in these troublesome days of crisis, when perplexity and distress of nations so apparent on every side, as our Saviour said it would be at this time. Luke 21: 24, 25 etc. Also men's hearts failing them for fear.

There is great tension around here now since the ten nobles with the prime minister of Jordan were killed last week. It is believed here with strong evidence that it was Nasser of Egypt back of the plot. Jordan is the Arab nation holding the Old City, and all to the east of Jerusalem. Last week a man was killed about a block from our house in the night. We heard the shooting. We live only a few blocks from the Jordan line, and it is said that he was an infiltrator from there.

We are unusually busy since our son-in-law, Gordon went to the U.S. for a while, as his father was not expected to live but a few months. He plans to return after looking after some business there. He had funds laid away ever since he came over to use for returning later for a while as planned. He had given up going, however, after our son and family came.

Our machinery is all working fine, and we are not having any trouble with it. Our son is getting to be a good printer too. We are having fine weather, everything growing good. We have two big gardens in Jerusalem on vacant land, and it helps us very much when vegetables are so high priced. Then we have them fresh grown without poison fertilizer.

How are you folks, and how is everything with you? I want to thank you again for your interest and help in the work over here. I know it is registered, like that of Cornelius in heaven (Acts 10:1-4), as a memorial to you, and also here at Jerusalem. The hearts of the Jews here are truly being changed as the prophet Ezekiel said they would at this time. Ezek. 36:24 to 28. Romans 10:12 to 15 is also true and must be carried out for them.

Hoping all is well with you, and with greetings and good wishes, from all here, I will close for this time, hoping to hear from you as the Spirit leads. Please remember us in prayer.
