Not as trying before to get my husband to go to dancing, I began to ask him to stay at home, so we could read the gospel together. One night after returning from a session of the Bible Circle study, during the whole night I was very much troubled, and was measuring the length and breadth of our bedroom till almost dawn. The question, how could a jewess like me become enthusiastic about the teachings of Jesus. This restlesness increased until three nights later I was playing with suicide thoughts, but that very night Jesus worked on my heart in such a miraculous way that all of my fears and doubts suddenly disappeared. I felt suddenly such an overflowing warmth, and such a wonderful peace in my soul. Now after having this wonderful experience I told my husband that I have fully realized that Jesus (The hour) is the LIVING messiah of Israel, and that I have accepted Him as my personal Saviour and redeemer.

I expected a strong reaction on the part of my husband, but to my greatest surprise he told me that the same change had occurred in him almost a fortnight before, but that he did not dare to tell me, having seen my troubled heart and anxiety state. Now since that preat day our whole way of life has been changed. Now our greatest delight is to pray to God together in the name of Jesus His son whom we have thus discovered to be the real Messiah of Israel. He is abiding in our hearts, and is always present in our new home here". Leah
