

DISCOVERY OF NOAH'S ARK

INTERVIEW WITH JAMES M. LEE, SECRETARY OF THE SEARCH FOUNDATION FOR NOAH'S ARK, INC., WASHINGTON, D.C. 20012

I.D., Ph.D.

Lee. - Doctor Liedmann, we first met at ie Hilton Hotel in Chicago at the Internaonal Convention of the FGBMFI. Demos Shaarian, the International President, had asked e to attend the convention and show the eces of wood found on Mount Ararat in 1969 the SEARCH Foundation Team, and the ovie film of the expedition. You will recall at I was standing at a table showing interted persons the print of an original painting the mountain, when you walked up to the ble, pointed to the picture and said. "The k is there!" You seemed to be so positive in our remark that we entered into a discussion the subject and then learned that you had d a very remarkable experience which you rtially revealed to those standing there. Docr Liedmann, will you please tell us about me of the background of your family, your periences in Sweden, and how it is that you e so confident in your own mind that Noah's k still remains high up on the upper slopes Mount Ararat? iedmann. - Yes, I will be happy to do so.

Mr. Lee. I was, born in Sweden of Orthodox Jewish parents who had migrated from the Russian Ukraine. From them I learned the Russian language. As a Jew I also learned the Hebrew and Aramaic languages. I have been interested in many different archeological discoveries around the world — especially those connected with Old Testament history. My exexperience concerning Mount Ararat was a remarkable experience in itself, as you will see, and I still marvel at it myself. I have never related this story of my experience to anyone since it happened in 1947 and 1948.

I received my medical degree in Upsula, Sweden, where I also studied and received my specialty in neurosurgery. I should mention here that I had been studying medicine for approximately five years when I quit my studies and volunteered for the R.A.F. for a six-month tour of active duty. I fought against the Germans, and was shot down twice by them and was included.

injured in my back.

After my recovery I went back to medical school again and began studying hemotalogy down in Heidelberg. It was on one of my trips down there that I became acquainted with a Russian Air Force major. This was in Ham-

burg. As everyone knows, the Russians, the English and the Americans were all fighting together as the common enemies of Germany. This Air For to major and I found that we had many thing: Scommon: we were both squadron leaders aring the last portion of World manhood; we both spoke the same Russian dialect; and he was born in Ukraine and my ancestors came from there.

Thus we had many common interests to discuss socially. On several occasions when we met by appointment I would invite him for dinners and social entertainments. It was on these occasions that he described to me different happenings, which, naturally, no one in his position should have mentioned to anyone in the Western world.

Lee. — What was the nature of the happenings which he revealed to you?

Liedmann. — This Air Force major had been a squadron leader in the Russian Air Force and was in command of a group of three planes which had taken part in a number of special missions over Mount Ararat. To my understanding, they were going there at very specific times each year, because, as this major explained to me, there are only 30 to 38 days during the year that the glaciers in that area are melted enough to make it favourable for taking pictures. Which day of the month it was I canont recall, but nevertheless, the first time I met him in 1947 he showed me at that time three distinct pictures taken on Mount Ararat. They are marked at the 13-14,000 foot elevation, or 4,500 meters approximately.

These pictures also showed a Russian aircraft with their insignia on the wings. Each of these pictures showed a boat-like structure which he pointed out to me to be what is mentioned in the Bible as Noah's Ark, I asked him a number of times why they were so interested in taking those pictures. He just laughed a little and did not answer my question.

One of those pictures showed the ship protruding out of the ice approximately 80 or 90 feet and it was tilted slightly downwards. War II; we had both been flying since early &In the bottom of that area was a little melted pond or lake. The glacier was shown with the mountain summit in the upper right of that picture and the other pictures were taken at a similar angle. To me it appeared that they were taken on the north side. He would not give too many of his own explanations of this, because, as he pointed out time and again, those photographs were the property of the U.S.S.R.

Lee. - Were any photographs taken other than in 1938? Liedmann. — Yes. I met the same man a year later, in 1948, also in Hamburg, Germany. At that time he showed me another set of pictures. Let me mention this. Those first pictures which I mentioned before were taken in 1938 at approximately the 14,000-foot elevation. Those other pictures which were shown me in 1948 were taken more recently. Just how recently I don't know. He only mentioned that "these have been taken since I saw you.'

How this happened I can't explain. To me it had no significance at the time for the simple reason that I was not a Christian, but a Jew. I did not pay too much attention, other than that I believed absolutely that Noah's Ark was there. I know the Old Testament very well, and so knew the Ark must still be there."

Lee. - How much of the Ark was exposed to view? Liedmann. - This is what can be explained about those pictures that were taken the last time. On this occasion he showed me almost a dozen pictures. The Ark was covered up much more than the first time with maybe only 12 or 15 feet of the vessel showing. Only

a tip of it was showing. Some sections could be seen through the glassy clear ice. These were the pictures that were shown me on those

two different occasions.

The first one was shown to me in 1947, and the second one in 1948. All of these photographs were concerning Noah's Ark on Mt. Ararat, and there always appeared a Russian aircraft in the picture. I asked him for a copy of these pictures, and he said: "These are the property of the Russian government and I cannot give them out, nor give any more information regarding these pictures."

Regarding the mountain — he described it as a high, rocky, volcanic mountain and that since it belonged to Turkey they could not do any research on it. This I could understand.

Lee. — Did you met this Air Force major

other than on these two occasions?

Liedmann. — The third time I met that same major he was with a number of his companions and when I asked him about his expedition he would not talk or mention anything about them. He completely ignored the subject. In fact, he told me, "I don't know what you are talking about." That was on the third occasion that I met this same Russian Air Force major.

Lee. — How did you happen to met him in

Hamburg?

Liedmann. — Why did we meet in Hamburg? As you know, they occupied a portion of Germany. Just about 50 to 60 miles from Hamburg is the city of Lubeck on the border of the Russian occupied area of East Germany. So it was very easy to understand why one or several of the officers were going into the Western world for some private reasons. All of these conversations were made in the Russian language. I am not as good in that language now, but I can still read and understand it.

Lee. - How many planes were involved in

the flights over Ararat?

Liedmann. — I should mention that each time they made a mission, or flight, for taking these pictures, there were always three different planes involved.

Lee. — Did he tell you anything else of in-

terest?

Liedmann. — Another interesting point maybe could be that we were talking about ancient times and he said: "Have you seen the mamoth that we found in Siberia in 1901 by some sled-dog party, and the dogs started eating the flesh of that mammoth which had green grass in its mouth. If you would like to see it, come with me to Stalingrad." I went with him and saw in that museum the mammoth which was largely preserved.

THE BUILDING OF THE TEMPLE IEWISH VIEWS

The taking of the Old City of Jerusalem by the Israel Defence Forces in the Six Day War was an event of tremendous import for Jews the world over. It was the fulfilment of a millennial dream, restoring the site of the Hely Temple to the jurisdiction of a sovereign lewish State. Ever since 70 CE, Jews have praved for the day when they might return to Jerusalem and rebuild its ruins. The liberation of 1967 at last afforded them the opportunity. It also raised an overriding question: Will the Temple be soon rebuilt? To answer it, one must understand the place of the Temple in the lewish tradition, and examine the halachic - Jewish legal — literature on its reconstruction.

The Temple Mount in Jerusalem has ever been the holiest of holy places for Jewry. Its holiness, intrinsic and eternal, was bestowed upon it by God at the Creation. Tradition has it that this was where Cain and Abel made their offerings, where Noah thanked God for his deliverance, where Abraham prepared to sacrifice Isaac. The Temple, which stood upon its divinely elected site, was regarded by the Jewish nation as its most treasured guerdon, its inner heart. Twice each day, the "Kohanim" (priests), the people's spokesmen to God, brought sacrifices on behalf of Israel, and for all the nations of the world. Thrice each year, on the festivals of Passover, Pentecost and Tabernacles, Jews were enjoined to make pilgrimage to the holy place and be spiritually uplifted by its sanctity. The prophets were inspired by the Temple, and many delivered their prophecies nearby. The 'Sanhedrion' (Supreme Court - Sanhedrin) was in permanent session in the "Office of Gain the Temple Court, interpreting the "Torah" for all Israelites.

But everything came to a halt with the destruction of the Temple by the Romans and the ensuing dispersion of so many Jews. Yet the Temple was never forgotten in the Diaspora. Not for a moment did Jews, wherever they dwelt, abandon hope and prayer for its restoration and the revival of the sacred liturgy. This is visible in many aspects of Jewish life. For striking example, certain Jewish prayers were formulated in replacement of the Temple's sacrifices. The order of the three daily services of prayer represents a spiritual re-enactment of the daily sacrificial worship of Temple times, and especial festival prayers correspond to the special sacrifices offered on the several occasions. The wording of the prayers, especially on Sabbaths and holydays, reflects the Jews' pas-

sionate wish for the re-establishment of the Temple. In the additional service — the "Musaph" - for holidays, God is besought thus:

"Rebuild Thine house as at the beginning, and establish Thy sanctuary upon its site; show us its rebuilding and let us rejoice in its restoration.

And there are other manifestations of such pleas in Jewish ritual. Jews pray facing towards Jerusauem and the Holy of Holies. Parts of every synagogue are designated by the names of the corresponding parts of the Temple . Synagogal appurienances and furnishings resemble those used in the Temple: the "Aron Hago-(Holy Ark), recepacle of Scrolls of the "Torah"; the "Parokhet", or decorative curtain, hanging over the Ark as did the ""Kaporet" in the Sanctuary, the "Ner Tamid" perpetual light - placed near the Ark as was the "Menorah" or candelabrum in the Temple.

Reminders of the destruction of the Temple abound in Jewish customs. A small section of each home is left unpainted, women may not wear all their jewellery at once, the wedding ceremony includes a gesture of mourning, usually the breaking of a glass by the bridegroom under the canopy. Four fast days of remembrance are observed each year: the most important one, the ninth day of the month of Av, is preceded by a spell of twenty days in the habits of lamentation. To this day, at every midnight save on the Sabbath, certain groups of Jews are wont to bewail the calamity.

One may, then, easily comprehend the intensity and magnitude of the emotion which seized world Jewry when the Temple Mount, accessible again, was once more in devout Jewish hands. But the area was not set aside as the place of a Third Temple. Except for the Western Wall, it was declared out of bounds

by the Chief Rabbinate to any Jew.

This injunction was based on the extreme veneration of the Mount. Only Jews who were free of all impurity could enter the Temple, and long and detailed instructions as to purification are given in the Bible. Nowadays, the exact laws of ritual contamination are virtually void, and almost everyone is considered to be ritually tainted. So much for entry to the area.

With respect to the reconstruction of the Temple and the resumption of the sacrificial services, the Chief Rabbinate has chosen to forbid all action, on the grounds that halachic literature furnishes no unequivocal answer to those questions. In fact, seven different approaches may be discerned among halachists.

The first is that of the "Temple of Fire", namely, that mortal men cannot rebuild the Temple. Talmudic sources declare that at some point of future time God will send down a per-

ect Temple of Fire from heaven, accomplishig the verse, "the sanctuary, O Lord, which hine hands have established". This notion, thoed in many prayers, rests on the belief at the first and second Sanctuaries were desoyed because they were man-made, and, ence, not eternal. The Third Temple, built by od Himself, will last forever.

A second approach, also well-founded in the ources, holds that the Messiah will miraculousrebuild the Temple. With his advent, the ws of nature will be changed and universal

eace reign, as it is written:

and the wolf shall dwell with the lamb, and e tiger shall lie down with the kid, and the alf and the young lion and the fatling together, nd a little child shall lead them..." — Isaiah

The Messiah also figures prominently in the aird approach that of Maimonides, who, in his

Code of Law", writes:
"The Messiah, the King, is destined to reign nd renew the Kingdom of David as in days of d, to build the Temple, and gather the dis-

ersed of Israel."

But Maimonides, in referring to a Messiah, eans a king of Israel who will not come miculously, but prove himself by his compence in the Law and his devotion to it hich make him a potential Messiah, and by is success in rebuilding the Temple where it iginally stood, and his ingathering of the riles.

An opinion along slightly different lines connds that the sacrifices must be renewed, and at the coming of the Messiah will thereby be stened. But Jewish leaders have traditionally posed this as imprudent. In any event, with cess to the Temple Mount barred by rabbinic

lict, it is not feasible.

Somewhat similar to the "messianic advent" eories is a fifth one - that the Temple will rebuilt by a prophet of God. Its advocates aintain that Jewish law does not permit its building or the resumption of sacrifices unss explicit prophetic behests are issued and beyed, because the criteria needed to underke either task become known only through e divine inspiration that is vouchsafed to pronets. As Rabbi Kook, Chief Rabbi of Israel generation ago, written in his book "Mishpat a-Cohen (Laws of the Priest):

'The arrangements pertaining to the building the Temple and the Altar are dependent upon

ophecy and divine inspiration." Other limiting factors, in this approach, are at, before the Temple may be rebuilt, peace ust prevail and the majority of the Jewish ople dwell permanently in Israel, two condions not yet near to realization.

ceed gradually, so also the rebuilding of the Temple. They list four stages in the process. The first is a sacrifice offered on the site of the Altar, after the location is determined by the most searching scrutiny. Next, the Temple will be rebuilt to the specification in the Book of Ezekiel and their talmydic interpretations. Then the Messiah will appear, and correct and embelish the structure and instruct as to the offering of sacrifices.

And, finally, the Almighty will lower a cellestial Temple of Fire, which will stand within the man-made Temple. All the laws of Nature will be transformed, all creatures find perfec-

tion and'be fulfilled.

The last opinion embodies elements of other approaches. Its proponents believe that prayer services should be organized on the site of the Temple. They argue that all agree that certain sections of the Temple Mount may be visited in accord with "halacha". They adduce historic-

al precedents as well.

Between 636 and 1,000 Jews worshipped regularly in a synagogue which stood on the site of the Temple. Moreover, during a given period, supervision of the buildings on the Temple Mount was entrusted to Jews. — (See Dr. B. Dinier, "A House of Prayer" and "Study on the Temple Mount During the Arab Era", "Zion", volume 3, pages 54-67; also Dr. S. Schwab, "After the Conquest of Jerusalem by Omar", ibid., volume 20, pages 91-116 et al.) The hope is entertained, then, that the conduct of worship on this hallowed spot will conduce to wider world peace and herald the redemption of Israel and of all mankind, as predicted by Isaiah (LVI, 7).

There is, we see, a plethora of approaches. But one thing emerges unmistakeably Although there are Jews who favour the rebuilding of the Temple and the resumption of the sacrifices at once, that is not likely to be the course of any Jewish action in the foreseeable future,

MEMORIES OF PAST EXPERIENCES IN THE GOSPEL WORK

FINDING "THE CHURCH OF GOD" AT EUREKA, SOUTH DAKOTA, 1923

As Eureka is on a branch railway line, and there was no bus service in those days, I was advised ahead of time, to buy my ticket to Roscoe. Arriving there in the early afternoon, I was met by a number of the older brethren, and escorted in their car to Eureka. The Eureka Church of God at that time was out in the country, a few miles north of town. Arriving there that afternoon, although a working day, I found the church surrounded by cars. It was quite a surprise indeed to find those people so deeply interested in religious matters to pack that church in the mid afternoon, to meet a man they had learned was also of the Church of God faith, similar to themselves.

It was indeed to me, a very happy occasion, Old Brother Brennise, the father of John Brennise; Old Brother Straub, the father of Elder E. A. Straub; Old Brother Dais, the father of the Elder Dais brethren now at Eureka and Lodi, and also Old Brother Kiesz, the father of Elder Chris Kiesz, all noble pius men, pio-neers of the Eureka Church of God, but outside of a few scattered friends and relatives, they knew nothing of the world-wide movement of

a people of their same faith.

Like the other groups previously mentioned these dear brethren had alho been led into deeper truth, and clearer light by the Blessed Hely Spirit, through the WORD. That precious afternoon meeting I shall never forget. There was Brother Chris Kiesz at the organ and such singing you seldom hear. They asked me to tell them about the Church of God. I took the floor and commenced. For nearly three hours they kept me there behind the pulpit answering their questions and giving them the scriptures why?

They had the advantage for I did not know what they believed on this or that, but every question put to me that day was answered by the Bible which required some time. When I finished each question they gave their heads

an affirmative nod, or said Amen.

It was indeed a wonderful meeting, and proved the working power of the blessed Holy Spirit, to bring people into unity of the faith when

studying the same precious Bible.

There was not a single point upon which they disagreed with the main body of the church scattered over the world. It was a repeated confirmation of the fact that the Spirit through the Lord, will lead people into all truth, when given the right of way, as had been in their

Hundreds of such instances are on record, where similar groups have been found, and are still being located all over the world. ,

Brother Jacob Dais dreamed of being out in a big body of water with a number of the other leading brethren of the Eureka church in a

small boat. Several of them had hold of the oars, but for some reason they were just going around and around, in a circle and were not getting anywhere. They all understood their plight, and did not know what to do.

Then he looked away and saw a big ship coming toward them. The ship kept coming right along until it came right to where they were. Then someone on the ship threw out 'a big chain, and they fastened the little boat to the big ship, and took us along with them. He

told the people the interpretation.

He said: We have been here all alone and have never gotten anywhere, but have been going around and around. "Now this man has come and informed us about the people all over the world of the same faith. We never knew about the Church of God before he came, and this church is the big ship that is going to take us right along with it.'

The following summer the Eureka brethren purchased a big tent for camp-meetings. Their first camp-meeting was held on the church grounds there, and it was a wonderful meeting. Many came from other places and several of our ministers were there. This was the beginning of their camp-meetings, and they have not missed one season since, but have held these big meetings every summer with an increasing interest and attendance. These brethren have come to other camp-meetings and added interest as well as financial help.

Elder Kiesz diceased, who played the organ at the first meeting where we met them (this I told you about in the previous issue), has served on the board of 12 for a number of years, and carried on evengelistic meetings in

many states.

Elder E. A. Straub, who was converted and baptized following the time of our first meeting them, has also held important positions and is a man of influence and ability, having traveled in most of the states in evangelistic work. Elder John Kiesz is another among them who has also held important positions with the church served also at the head of the school Stanberry, Missouri, and is Pastor at St. Louis.

Many of the Eureka people moved to Lodi, California, among these we find Brother Jacob Dais and family. His dream surely came true, and this church group has been affiliated with, and has helped much in sending forth the light and shown people the way, not just around Eureka as in former days, but its beams have reached to all parts of the earth.

While they do not all affiliate with one particular group with which they at first became connected, because various groups have been formed and are issuing different publications from different parts of the world, people.

Like the various different groups among the Jews in Israel, all of which fellowship together and are Jews. So it is with these various groups, while there are slight differences, yet they are "the Church of God", and must fellowship as such, for they are ONE according to the Saviour's prayer of St. John 17th chapter.

Leaving Eureka, South Dakota, we went south to Bassett, Nebr., where during the previous fall we had laboured with another minister by the name of Milton Grotz, and a large church had been set in order, of over one hundred

members.

Plans were well under way for the building of their new church house, and they were all encouraged and made to rejoice over the good news we were able to give them concerning all of these different groups of the same faith we had been able to locate by the guiding hand of Him who has promised to be with his children, "Lo even to the end of the World."

SHAMEFUL DEFAMATION ON **JUDAISM**

ABRAHAM, MOSES WERE "MYTHS"

LONDON (AP). — John Allegro, the Dead Sea Scrolls scholar who stirred a controversy by claiming Christianity had been founded by a mushroom-worshipping cult, struck at the foundations of the Jewish religion.

The 49-year-old university lecturer on the Old Testament contends that the Patriarchs including Abraham and Moses — were myths. This is the theory he put forward in a new book, "The Chosen People".

Jewish history between 587 B.C.E. and 70 C.E. when the Romans destroyed Jerusalem is described as a constant conflict between "moderates" who wished to mingle and merge with other races and cultures, and religious fanatics. The fanatics often acted under the influence of the mushroom drug and saw themselves as "the chosen ones", he says.

The barriers that had been erected to safeguard the purity of Judaism have served ever since to provoke the envy, distrust and hatred

of the Gentile world."

In the meantime Israel continues friendly relations with the African nations as usual, hoping to keep the Africans from taking a stand

The school year started on the 2nd of September. Our son's children go to the English school now. He started his older children in the Hebrew school when he first came here. They soon preferred to speak in Hebrew all the time. It was a little odd to have their children speaking a language that the parents did not know so he wants the younger ones to learn English first. In the Hebrew schools they begin to teach the children English in the 5th

We have been especially busy keeping up with

our work. The printing of the books of Daniel and Revelation has taken up a good deal of our attention. It took one week to assemble the English book, here in our living room. Perhaps you can imagine how the papers and boxes were stacked around for a week. Now

they are being bound at a shop down town. Another problem will be to find a storage place for them and the ten thousand Bible Home In-

structors.

My own problem has been difficult to surmount. It was all concerning the new addresses. About six weeks ago the old typewriter which made the stencils refused to work. We bought another one and it would jump and make spaces .1 Wa got another are and it messed

up several dozen of adddresses. Then we ran out of stencils and had to wait a month for some from Germany. By the time they came, and we got another typewriter there were several hundred addresses to take care of. We get as many as fifty or sixty new names often in one mail now besides the changes of addresses. But now I can be thankful that by tomorrow we will have the ones on hand taken care of. Perhaps I should be thankful that my problems help to stimulate my endeavours.

There has been several guest speakers at the Meeting House during the last month: Elder Orville Wallace, Elder Moshe Ben Shmuel of Israel, Elder Stoneman of Australia, Dr. Liedmann of the U.S., and Elder Aaron Levy. Elder and Sister Wallace expect to be with us during the Feast of Tabernacles with a group

Brother and Sister Levy have returned after a long visit in the U.S. We were glad to hear their report on their efforts to interest people in a settlement in Israel. We are confident that they have been blest and will be blest in their efforts to bring people together spiritually. We hope they will prepare a report which we can publish too.

Elder Shoemaker is in New Mexico at the present time, and Brother and Sister Schlenker are still in the U.S. but will be back right away to put the children in school. We surely miss them in the work here, but some of the young ones among us are helping with the correspondence course. There are more than three hundred taking the Rumanian lessons, besides those in Hebrew, French and English, and there are many calls for the lessons in Russian by the incoming immigrants. It is so wonderful to see how different ones are called to help in the

Many of our readers have read the little free tract "What Started Us to Israel", which I cannot repeat here, but after that miraculous healing of my wife following my repeated promise to the Almighty if He would heal her that night, we would leave our children and grand-child-

ren and go to Israel.

We could not find a room only in the hotel. Had to hire our paper printed 2,000 copies which we sent free to our friends. Soon our money was consumed, room rent, postage, living expenses, printing, etc. Our daughter Marry suggested we go to Galilee and fish for a living. A man here had a house there furnished and vacant. He offered us the key to use it free of charge. We got a license to fish, built a fish trap, but came to Jerusalem monthly to get the papers from the printer, stamp and mail them out.

I taught my children to pay tithes when they were small, and this is what really gave the work a start here. We landed here with only one thousand dollars from the equity on our

little home in Oregon.

Our son Andy we left in U.S., was married with two children, living in a house he had just built. He sent us five or ten dollars a month tithes, for a year or so. Also my Sister Mrs. Ora Carpenter and her children sent us their tithes. It was not long, however, until the Almighty laid it upon the hearts of others to support the work here.

One day in Galilee, we received a letter from him with seven hundred dollars. We were greatly surprised how he could do so. He told people in Oregon, he never made any money in his life till he began sending his tithes to

daddy

During the next three years, he sent us three thousand dollars in tithes. This is what gave us a start here. Then he came over, and bought three dunams of land, a little less than an acre, down where some friends live near the sea. This may be the story that is going around that we are buying land here, and piling up money.

After receiving the big draft from our son for seven hundred dollars, we stopped fishing and returned to Jerusalem to our appartment which we had rented for only six months while the owner had left for the summer with his

family to Borneo.

Soon after returning we had to move, as we had contracted with him to move at the end of the six months, but we could not find any room. The city was filled full, with many immigrants coming in from mostly the Arab countries.

We prayed and trusted the Heavenly Father in undoubting faith that He would help us. One night, while sleeping, I saw a sign about a foot long and four inches wide come down from the seiling and hang about the center of the room half way up, with big black letters P.O.B.—
I knew this surely meant something good. I never went to sleep afterwards, but in the morning sent one of the "Mt. Zion Reproter" to this P.O.B. number. In about ten days, a Jewish believer who often came to see us, called in the afternoon. As we sat together talking, he said: "Elder Dugger, I found a group of people in south Jerusalem holding meetings on the Sabbath, and there were a number of Jews present."

I said: "That is very interesting, I would like

to get their address.'

Taking a small card from his vest pocket, and handing it to me, he said: "Here is their card."

To my surprise their P.O.B. number was just what the Almgihty had shown me in the dream. I said: "This is the very P.O.B. number I saw in dream a few nights ago."

I showed it to my wife, and we walked to the south part of the city that same afternoon

to locate them.

Upon meeting the man at the door, and being courteously invited in, I showed him a copy of "The Reporter", and asked him if he received one of these magazines. He said: "Yes, we received one, and we enoyed it very much." Then I explained how I got his Post Office Box number. This was a good introduction, as they are very spiritual people, Elder and Sister M. A. Kaarby still working with us here.

As my wife Effie was talking to Sister Kaarby in another room, she asked Effie where we lived. In reply she was told that we lived in the west part of Jerusalem, but had to move in a few days and could not find any place to go. Sister Kaarby said: "I met a woman a few days ago who told me she had a place she would rent if she could find someone she knew was all right to rent it to. Elder Kaarby volunteered to take us over and see the place.

We met the lady, a school teacher and a believer, living all alone as her father and mother had both pased away, and it was their old home where she was born and raised. She said soon after meeting us: "You folks remind me of my father and mother." We were received warmly with outstretched arms, and she wanted us to move right in. She went into one room by herself and turned the whole place fully furnished over to us, and would not even receive any rent for six months.

This is now our publishing house and where we have lived ever since, with nine rooms on two floors, and all furnished. This was sixteen years ago.

Now, thanks to the Almighty, we own the place, all paid for, with the papers fixed so it remains property of "The Family of Elohim", to be used for religious work continually

Lawyer-author Earle Stanley Gardner says: "The average parent today is absolutely ignorant of the type of pornography that is being liberally pushed into the hands of his children. High school kids hang around the book racks where smut is sold like flies around a decaying carcas."

The Supreme Court opened the flood gates by ruling in 1964 that the vile book "Tropic of Cancer" was not obscene. The Court also gave the green light to "Fanny Hill", long-banned intimate play-by-play of the sexual experiences

of a prostitute.

Both the Old and the New Testaments repeatedly condemn adultry and homosexuality, but

not many modern church leaders do.

At Vanderbilt University this year Elder R. T. McIvenna, director of young adult work for the Methodist Board of Education, spoke on "The Homosexual in Open Society." He declared that homosexuality is a valid way for 2 people to relate to each other that the homosexual has a place and a right to — a place of dignity — in Society. This is a big lie, and the devil's trap.

HAIFA PLANS FOR 4,200 HOMES IN FIVE YEARS

HAIFA. — THIS city will have to provide during the next five years, beginning 1972, over 4,200 homes, about 800 each year, to rehouse large families, replace condemned homes, and for similar urgent needs, but not including young couples, Mayor Moshe Flie-

The programme includes 300 homes for Arab families (the city has an Arab population of about 7,000). He made it clear that the figures did not include the 230 homes which are needed immediately and belonged to this year's

housing programme.

As for young couples, the estimated need was 1,200 during the next five years. Haifa was now "fashionable" as a place where new immigrants want to settle, and an estimated 10 per cent of them were expected to come here. This meant an annual increase of well over 4,000, and if that of the birth rate was added (1:5 per cent a year, or 3,800 births), the combined growth rate was about 8,500 every year.

OVER 100,000 ARABS, DRUSE GOING ACRE. The number of Arab and Druse

pupils will for the first time top the 100,000 mark, with 20,000 new pupils starting school this week. They include 3,500 in state high schools.

Five new schools and 150 additional classrooms are being opened, and the Education Minister has appointed 200 new teachers to cope with the larger number of pupils.

This brings the number of non-Jewish teach-

ers up to 3,300.

A FIFTH-CENTURY SYNAGOGUE IN BEISAN

Three hundred teenagers from Reform synagogues in the U.S. have just completed a dig at a fifth-century synagogue in Beisan. They found a fine coloured mosaic floor with representations of animals, inscriptions and a candelabrum with the word "shalom" below.

A HUNDRED THOUSAND ISRAEL VISITORS =

More than one hundred thousand Arab visitors were permitted by Israel to come over from Jordan as visitors during the summer. Most of them have returned home. Many stayed several months. They were amazed at the development of Israel and surprised at the good friendly treatment given them by Israel people. They went back with good reports. _

BUILDING IN ISPACI.

There is not another city in the world with so many buildings going up as in Jerusalem. Big tall eighteen and twenty story hotels, etc. are seen rising above the city, in different quarters. AMMAN (Reuter). - Saudi Arabia has announced a new budget providing for £66 m. in financial aid to Egypt and Jordan, it was announced.

Egypt and Jordan received a total of £125 m. in annual subsides from Saudi Arabia, Kuwait and Libya, under decisions of the fourth Arab summit held in Khartoum, Sudan, follow-

ing the Six Day War.

Saudi Arabi continued to pay its share, but Kuwait and Libya geased their aid to Jordan as a sign of protest against King Hussein's re-

MIZRAHI BODY TO RE-EXAMINE

"WHC IS A JEW"
A change in the "Who is a Jew" rule for purposes of population registratry will be one of the topics on the agenda of the annual meeting of the World Council of the Mizrahi-Hapoel Hamizrahi's "Mishmeret Hatzeira" ("Young People's Division"), opening in Jerusalem last week.

About 60 delegates — from the U.S., Europe and Israel - are expected to call for a change in the law's wording, to include explicitly that conversion must be in accordance with "ha-

lacha" to be recognized.

BIG HAILSTONE INJURES GIRL

BRIVE, France (Reuter). A hailstone as big as a grapefruit seriously injured an 18year-old girl when it fell on her head during a storm near here, police said.

Other huge hailstones, some weighing almost 1.5 kilos, crashed through tile roofs of homes during the storm and destroyed tobacco and other crops in the Varetz region, near this town in south central France.

VISITORS FROM ARAB COUNTRIES CROSS THE JORDAN

A big surprise was in store this week for the 100,000th summer visitor from the Arab countries to cross the Jordan. Mrs. Aline Andoni Berbourt, from Amman, coming with her two children (aged two and four) to visit her sister in Israel, was whisked through controls. and presented with a bouquet for herself and sweets for the tots, by the local military commander.

Some 30,000 of this year's visitors from Arab lands have already completed their six weeks' visit and returned home. Last summer, the total number of visitors was 53,000.

> 31 COWS KILLED BY MINES IN GOLAN HEIGHTS

KIRYAT SHMONA. — Kibbptz Snir lost 31 cows on Friday last week when its herd went grazing in an old minefield in the Golan Heigths. The loss is estimated at IL40,000.

MORE SOVIET JEWISH IMMIGRANTS ARRIVE

LOD AIRPORT. - A group of Soviet Jewish immigrants arrived here on Friday last week aboard an El Al flight from Vienna. The immigrants include two dentists, radio technicians, an historian and a driver.

CAIRO CHARGES REBUTTED

UNITED NATIONS (Reuter). — U:N: Ambassador Yosef Tekoah on Friday last week wrote to U.N. Secretary-General N Thant stating that Egypt and other Arab states had "instigated and supported a campaign of indiscriminate terror in the Gaza area.

LOANS FOR BEDS

Loans and infrastructure grants will also be made available in an effort to add another 2,000 beds to the 3,000 already existing in camping sites throughout the country. Loans have also been made available to the Youth Hostel Association to help it expand its network by another 750 beds in time for the coming season.

700-800 JEWS LEFT RUSSIA IN JULY MOSCOW (UPI). — Between 700 and 800 exit visas for Israel have been issued to Jews last month, authoritative sources reported.

An earlier estimate (published in "The Jerusalem Post" recently) of 500 visas in July was based on estimates of Jews flying from here to a gathering point in Vienna, from where they travel to Israel. The sources said that this figure did not take into consideration emigrants from southern Soviet cities, who leave from Black Sea ports.

The sources also denied reports that Jews who have a university education are required to repay the cost of their schooling, about 4,000 rubles (\$4,400). They said that the only cost of an emigration visa is 900 rubles (\$990), of which 500 rubles is for the renunciation of Soviet ciizenship and 400 rubles for the visa.

> CAPITAL SABBATH CLASHES IN "LOWER KEY"

Parts of Jerusalem had a tense and noisy Sabbath afternoon as ultra-orthodox zeolots and secularists confronted each other, jostling and jeering in Davidka Square Tempers relaxed somewhat after nightfall however, and although trouble was expected in the Mea Shearim quarter it did not reach serious proportions.

Police detained five persons in Davidka Square

around five o'clock.

Earlier , around 4.15 p.m., a few hundred Mea Shearim residents gathered in the square in response to posters calling for a demonstration against Sabbath traffic, which had been plastered around the Capital a few days before. They started spitting and shouting "Shabbes, Shabbes" at passing vehicles, especially Egged excursions buses.

Last clashes were in a lower key than the pre-

vious Saturday.

Record exports of \$115m. in 1970-71, from an unprecedented 1.5 m.-ton crop, raised Israel's share of citrus experts by four per cent to 27.4 per cent of the region's exports.

The Board anticipated a crop of about 50 m. cartons in 1971-72, with five to 10 per cent

more Shamuti oranges than last year.

1,400 ARRIVE ON FOUR SHIPS

HAIFA. — Four Greek passenger ships brought 1,400 passengers, most of them tourists, to the port on Friday morning last week.

The ships included the s.s. Fiorita, which arrived from Beirut with 400 European touritsts, who came for a day as part of a Mediterranean and Galilee.

The other ships, Apollonia, Hermes and Lindos, brought several hundred young persons, with only a rucksack and a sleeping bag, who came to spend the summer touring Israel. Many of them want to join archaeological digs.

The Hermes also brought 270 round-trip tourists, who are visiting the country for three days

and will re-embark this evening.

JEWISH IMMIGRANTS FROM SOVIET

Soviet Jewish immigrants, who arrived at Lod Airport early on Friday, included "olim" from the Baltic States, Odessa, Tashkent, Baku and Samarkand. Two families also came from Poland.

"POOR" U.S. TOURISTS PLAGUE **EMBASSIES**

Pleading poverty or poor planning, more than 450 young Americans a week are swarming to U.S. embassies in Europe asking for money.

Mostly students between 18 and 24, they came to Europe on a cheap youth-fare ticket, underestimated their expenses and ran out of

They come hoping to exist on a dollar a day," said Eugene Rosenfeld, a public affairs officer at the Embasy in London. :: Often they run out of cash in the middle of the summer so they cash in the return half of their air ticket. Then they're stuck and they come to us for help.

All they usually get is an offer of the phone

to call their parents — collect.

About 25 or 30 kids a day come in saying: 'I have no money so what are you going to do about taking care of me'?'

SOLOMON MINES PROGRESSING TOWARD SELF-SUFFICIENCY

EILAT. - Timna Copper Mines' annual balance sheet presented this month shows a profit before taxes of IL4.2 m., the company's Managing Director, Mr. Uri Wurzburger, announced In spite of a smaller profit than the preceding year, due to low prices for copper in the world market, the output of ore once again passed the million ton mark, resulting in the export of just under 11,000 tons of pure copper cement.

Progress on the shaft of the new Timna 2 underground mine is now proceeding satisfactorily, Mr. Wurzburger said, and the German company carrying out the project should be able to complete the work on schedule in 1973.

> 7 HURT, 64 ARRESTED, IN MEA SHEARIM RIOT

In the worst night of rioting in the current anti-bus campaign in the Mea Shearim Quarter, 64 persons were arrested last night and

seven injured.

Helmeted police carrying shields broke up turbulent crowds of ultra-Orthodox demonstrators on Mea Shearim Street after Egged buses were stoned. The windsheild of one bus was shattered and a 21-year-old woman passenger, cruise. Most of them left for visit to Jerusalem ka Carmela Levi, cut in the face. She was taken to Hadassa Hospital.

> Another woman passenger was also injured as were three policemen, a journalist and one of the demonstrators who, police said, was hit by a stone thrown by a man as he was being

taken into custody.

Earlier in the day, some 500 religious demonstrators from Mea Shearim gathered at the Egged garage near the entrance to town to ensure that no bus left before the end of Sabbath. The demonstrators shouted "shabbes" at passing vehicles. When they interfered with traffic, police said, the crowd was dispersed.

WASHINGTON (INA). — Rep. Benjamin Rosenthal, Democrat of New York, has told Secretary of State William Rogers that he fears the U.S. is bearing down on Israel to obtain one-sided concessions" from her in the American efforts to achieve a settlement in the Mid-

In a letter to Mr. Rogers made public by the Congressman's office, Mr. Rosenthal wrote: "The quest for peace must not be made blindly, overlooking the importance of maintaining the power balance among the nations involved.

Ahmed Hassan Zomorrod, a 37-year-old painter from East Jerusalem, was one of the two Fatah members who bought a used Morris commercial van, filled it with explosive and petrol, and parked it in Mahane Yehuda on November 22, 1968, a Friday. The car blew up at 10 a.m., killing a dozen persons and injuring 53 others. Of the casualties 19 remained permanent invalids.

The blast also caused serious damage to shops

along Rehov Agrippas.

One woman's head was blown off, and went through the roof, and out into the alley.

SOVIET JEWS TELL THANT: "ISRAEL OR DEATH"

UNITED NATIONS (Reuter). — Israeli Ambassador Yosef Tekoah on Wednesday last week handed U.N. Secretary-General U. It is indeed marvelous how the Heavenly Father has led us and directed His work here.

Besides our regular printing work of "The Reporter" monthly, the "Messenger", "Children Friend", Lesson Quarterlies", and tracts to keep the ministers supplied over the world, we have just hired ten thousand Bible Home Instructors printed half in Hebrew and half in English. The English book has about 200 pictures to illustrate the subject, and over 500 hundred pages. Then we have printed twentyfour thousand of the book of Daniel and Revelation, half in Hebrew. They cost us one Israel pound twenty, for binding alone, besides paper and printing. Also we owe ten thousand pounds yet to the binding and printing of the Instructors. We have not been able to get our offset press yet, because we lack considerable to make before taking it from where it is. This

is the way we are piling up money.

We have the Bible Correspondence Course of 44 lessons going in four languages. As it is free this is a big expense yet. Some are beginning to send in a little as they finish the course. Urgent calls come in from Israel for the course in Russian for the Russian immigrants. Also in German and Spanish, but we do not have the money to start it. We have to hire the lessons printed outside because our printing presses are for large sheets. The new machine we need money to get, is for this work, and for printing colors. It is a rapid running press that will handle small size like we have in the Bible
