Our Dearly Beloved Brother Mika;

AND the other dated April 25th. so I shall go through them, answering the first one of course, Always so happy to hear from you loved ones and to know that you are bravely fighting the good fight of faith in and through our Lord and Saviour Jesus, We keep well for which we praise and thank the good Lord, of course we are busy, but that is when we feel the best, for we do want to work for the Lord as long as He giveth me breathe, praise Him, We returned from a trip away up into Canada late last night so you can see we are always on the go.

Now to your letters. Question No. #1. Deut. 23;12-14. How long was this to remain in effect?, This of course was still what was commanded unto Moses, it was good hygienic law, I suppose that there were flies in that day just as we have flies nowadays, and they love to sit and feed upon what cometh from man, and then of course they will sit upon others foods etc, so this was good hygienic law, and it is no longer in effect, But surely we will take care and allow anything which cometh forth from our body's to remain uncovered, some one might step in it, or flies will eat at it, So while this law of Moses is not in effect at this present time, yet we ought to follow cleanliness and good hygienic practices in order to keep diseases down.

Question No. #2, St. Matthew 26;23; St. John 13;26. Now please notice that in Matt. 26; 23, Jesus was telling them that one of them would betray Him, and they began to be very sorrowful, I suppose that they all wondered who would do this, and He said unto them he that dippeth his hand in the dish with me, He told here it would be one of them, Please notice that here Jesus didn't identify who it would be, But He told them that it would be one of them who was eating with him, Notice they were dipping their hands into a dish, this must of been while they were eating the Passover, for in eating the Passover they would dip their hands into the dish picking up pieces of the Lamb and the bread could of been in a dish also. Now to St. John 13;26. See John gives us a very good account in the sequence as everything took place. Now John is silent about what Matt. tells us about them dipping their hands into the dish, But after they had partaken of the Passover and the Lord's Supper had instituted, and Jesus had washed their feet. (St. John 13th Chapter) after having washed their feet Jesus made the statement, or it could of been of been just before Jesus said that they were not all clean, Verse 10-11. on down to the 18th. verse, He that eateth bread with me hath lifted up his heel against me. (Please check Psa. 41.9. Here it says he that eateth my bread, this then would be of course be the Lord's Supper, For the Passover is not the Lord's Bread, but He took the bread and brake it and said take eat this is my Body, so the bread which is eaten at the time of the Lord's Supper, is His bread. So here in St. John he also said that one who eat's along with Him will betray Him. then after they had eaten the Passover and the Lord's Supper, and Jesus had washed their feet they sat down again, or rather Jesus sat down again and talked to some length along with them, then Jesus wished to point out who would betray Him. so He took a morsel, This would be a small piece of bread which was left over, and He took the morsel, or sop, which means the same, and dipped it into the fruit
