We have mailed the literature  
that you requested. Hope it reaches you  
OK. As you will see in the study on the  
U.S. in Bible Prophecy, the Ten Tribes of Israel, etc,  
I did some intensive historical research  
for some 4 years to glean the bits of history  
used there. I was teaching in our Bible  
School for 4 years and had time and access  
to some historical accounts. Since these  
tribes were supposedly (lost to history), I  
had to trace them starting from the Bible  
account, little by little.

I am sorry that I can not help you  
find copies of G. H. Nuperts' books, "The  
Statutes of God", and "Bible Atlas". Both are  
listed in my "Yellow Pages" of 10 l. v. to have



the one "Bible Atlas. It might help us in our study of the races of Gen. 10. What little information that I have on those ancient races has come bit by bit - here a little and there a little. I did have a chart that some one gave me, but in moving last fall, it was misplaced so that I can't give you the source of the map.

Thank you for the address of where I can get the 3 reprinted books on Races of Britain - "Origin of the English Nation" and "The Anthropological History of Europe". I shall contact them. I am much interested in such historical data.

As you perhaps already know, the Bible itself indentifies "The land of Ham" as Egypt, and his older son Cush was the father of the Ethiopian (Black) peoples. David calls Egypt "the land of Ham".

I have three of them as follows-- "The THEOCRACY OF ISRAEL, A Divine Form of Government," 2:- "The GATHERING OF THE NATIONS to ARMAGEDDON- A WORLD'S FEDERATION," 3:- "The YELLOW PERIL."

Two of these books have over 400 pages and The Yellow Peril has over 500 pages. Rupert's picture is in each book. If you want a copy of the "Preface" and "Contents" of any or all of these, I can make Photo copies and send to you, with his picture on one if you desire it that way. Let me know how I can help you.

Now for a bit of history. When I was a boy 10-12 years old, I saw Elder G.G. Rupert at a camp Meeting and conference in Oklahoma. Lee Eylor and Jess Rich had started "The Gathering Call" after being cast OUT of the S.D.A. Church. Two years in succession they held a summer Camp Meeting in eastern Okla. and my Father and Mother attended. Ex-S.D.A. Ministers came from east and west. G.G. Rupert was there, A.F. Ballender and A.T. Jones, etc. My folks had "The Yellow Peril" book, but I did not see Elder Rupert after that. I was born in 1902. I heard enough about him to be interested in his Books, and when visiting Brother I.C. Sultz, he gave me the books I now have.
