# Our Bible in Danger

The following quotation is taken from a recent issue of the "LOOK MAGAZINE" in an article entitled, "The Truth About Our Bible". The sub-head to the article accompanied by a very large picture of an open Bible, reads, "Students of the scripture say the New Testament we read today may have 50,000 errors". A lengthy article follows, of which this is an extract. It reads,—"To correct them 125 of the world's foremost christian theologians have pooled their brains and their manuscripts, in the first comprehensive effort to find out what is original, and what is afterthought. All branches of the christian church, Protestant, Catholic, and Eastern Orthodox, have teamed up to assist the project."

Space in this paper forbids our quoting more from this article the entire substance of which casts a dark cloud of mistrust and doubt over the WORD OF GOD given to us by holy inspiration, wherein we are told that it "Came not by the will of man, but Holy Men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Spirit" 2 Peter 1:21. Also that "All scripture is given by the inspiration of God", etc., 1 Tim. 3:15, 16. During the dark ages when the beast was enthroned with power, the Bible, the WORD OF GOD together with those who defended it, were the chief objects of attack. In those days, the first step was to destroy faith in these divine oracles given to us from heaven. Then swiftly following wholesale Bible burnings, with laws forbidding the reading or concealing of any portion of the scriptures under penalty of death. Now the beast is coming back into power. The deadly wound is being healed, and God's Holy Word is again the object of his attack, just exactly like it was during the career of his previous reign. Dear reader, you will see that these so-called foremost christian leaders will follow the very same course as that pursued by most all of the world's leaders, during the dark ages, when "The whole world wandering after the beast." Rev. 13th chapter.

The prophet Isaiah speaks of the D.D.s.—Doctors of Divinity. He calls them Dumb Dogs. Isaiah 56:10, and says they are shepherds who cannot understand. Greedy Dogs that cannot get enough, and that they refuse to bark "sleeping, lying down, and loving to slumber". They came with the understanding that if any one of them made a translation wrong according to their particular religious belief, he was to lose his head. Only 48 came. Three years was spent in the Jerusalem chamber of the Westminster Abbey, and the work was done.

Now we have men popping up here and there claiming that all of these men were wrong, but he is right. Also groups of men, who have an axe to grind, come along proclaiming the discovery of great truth through an error of the translation by these 48 renowned scholars. I place such men in the same category with the boy who, after working his problem in Arithmetic, declares the answer in the book is wrong, and angrily throws his book away. Dear reader, do not be deceived by those who find fault with our Bible. Neither lost faith, by their false declarations such as appear in this article in question.

# **Questions and Answers**

#### Question:

I have found out that the leaders, printing what they call, "The Advocate of Truth", in West Virginia, are teaching that Jesus was not a Jew. What are the most convincing texts in proof that he was? I have always understood that he was a Jew.

#### Answer:

We have learned definitely that this is their teaching, but it is a false teaching, which the following scriptures will prove. The prophet Isaiah announced the birth of the Messiah in the following words,—"There shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots. And the Spirit of the Lord shall be upon him . . . with righteousness shall he judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth . . . with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked". Isiaha 11:1-4.

This is proof that he came from the root of Jesse, or from the line of David, which he would have to do in order to succeed David and sit a king on David's throne. The angel said to Mary. "The Lord God shall give unto him the throns of his father, David, and he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever". Luke 1:32, 33. This is proof of his royal decent, and qualifica tions for king. But here is still more proof, "Behold the LION of the TRIBE OF JUDAH, the root of David hath prevailed to open the book". Rev. 5:5. This would certainly make him a Jew. He is either a Jew, or he is NOT a Jew, and there is no use trying to juggle the issue as these men do.

Here is more proof, "For it is evident that our Lord sprang from the tribe of Judah". Hebrews 7:14. This is why we are told that,—"Salvation is of the Jews", John 4:22. Also it was said of him at the time of his birth,—"Where is he that was born to be king of the Jews". Matt. 2:2.

### Question:

What does the scripture mean where it says that some say they are Jews and are not, but are of the synagogue of Satan? Rev. 2: 9. Who does this refer to?

### Answer:

All hypocrits, and sinners, who might say they were Jews, are of the synagogue of Satan. There are many ungodly Jews now of this class spiritually speaking, and there are also Gentiles who claim to be Jews and are not, but are self-righteous, unconverted and uncircumscised of heart. Therefore they are not Jews, or do not belong to the family of Israel.

Paul says,—"He is not a Jew which is one outwardly, but he is a Jew which is one inwardly, and circumcision is that of the heart".

Romans 2:28, 29. Paul is here speaking of both Jew and Gentile, because he says there is no difference. Romans 3:22, and 10:12. Both Jew and Gentile must be circumcised by the circumsision of Christ. Paul says,—"Ye are circumcised by the circumcision of Christ. Paul says,—"Ye are circumcised by the circumcision of Christ... Burried with him in baptism".

Col. 2:11-13. He says further,—"Circumcision is nothing . . . but the keeping of the commandments of God". 1 Cor. 7:19.

This applies to both Jew and Gentile, and Paul says it makes one a Jew. That is spirtually, he is a changed creature, and adopted into the family of Israel, he says further,—"Salvation is of the Jews". John 4:22. All promises were made to Israel, Abraham's see a See. Gal. 3:16. The only way Gentiles have a right to these promises is by adoption, or as Paul illustrates it, by being grafted into the family. See Romans chapters 9 to 11. Also Galations 3:27 to 29. Then they are adopted children, into the israelite family, and become Jewsinwardly, circumcised of heart.

Note this scripture carefully, Rom. 4:13,-"The promise that he should be heir of the world was not to Abraham and to his seed through the law, but through the righteousness of faith". It is not through the sacrifical law that we obtain this righteousness but thruogh the acceptance of Jesus by faith. Hear what Paul says again, -"They which are of faith the same are the children of Abraham". Gal. 3:7. It is just as reasonable to argue that black is white. as it is to argue that Abraham's seed, are not Israel, and are not called Israel in the scriptures.

Question:
What is the Bible teaching on Church organization?

### Answer:

The scriptures clearly teach only one form of church organization, and that is with the 12, the 7, and the 70. This was the instructions of God to Moses, and he appointed 12, and then 70, and later the business stewards. Our Saviour did the same when he came. See Luke 6:13-16 and Luke 10:1, 2, where he appointed other 70 besides the Jewish Sanhedron of 70 which still existed from the days of Moses. Then the 7 were appointed to look after the business, so the 12 could give themselves to "Prayer and the ministering of the Word". Acts 6:4.

Question:

Is the western district following this organization?

### Answer:

Yes absolutely, and the majority of the officers, and members of this organization are standing for the old doctrine of the Church of God, and for the constitution as it was first printed in 1933. New doctrine does not become the teaching of the church until it is adopted according to this constitution. Those who try to abrogate old doctrine and bring in new, without following the constitution, separate themselves from this body.

We have many ministers now, in both the home and foreign lands, protesting against such acts, just as did Elijah, Jeremiah, Isaiah and others, but they never left the body, and those trying to promote false teaching were not able to put them out.

Paul speaks of this in Romans

11:2-5 and compares the days of Elijah to his own time saying, "Even so then at this time there is a remnant according to the election of grace". It is the same way today, brethren, and our Father knoweth those that are His. Seek the Lord for WISDOM to guide, and all will be well.

#### The End of Russia

"The prophecies came not in old times by the will of man, but Holy Men spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit".—2 Peter 1:21.

Many are the prophecies yet unfulfilled concerning this glorious time, and the present attitude of Russia with her growing strength, and threat of world donination, is only one of many conditions proving to us that the pending Messiah reign is eminently near at hand.

### When Russia Attacks Israel

The prophet Ezekiel has given us more than one whole chapter concerning the future fate of Russia. The prophet speaks thus,—"And the word of the Lord came unto me saying, 'Son of man set thy face against GOG the laud of Magog, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal, the prophecy against him".

The word "Gog" is derived from the root word "Rosh", from which the name Russia originated, and the word "Meshech", is the root word from which Moscow is derived. Gog, Magog, Meshech, and Tubal were the grandsons of Noah, (Genesis 10:2), and you will learn by consulting a map in the back of your Bible that they settled in southern Russia after the flood.

The prophet names several nations, Gomer (east Germany), Persia, Ethiopia, and Libya, all of which are yet known by these names, except that Persia is often spoken of as Iran. Their whereabouts are known and all mentioned in this chapter are either Russian satelites now or lean favorably toward her. After the prophet mentions seven different nations, he says of Gog or Russia in verse seven, "Be thou a guard unto them". This is her position today.

In verse eight we are told that, "After many days thou shalt be visited in the latter years thou shalt come into the land that is brought back from the sword, and is gathered out of many nations, against the mountains of Israel". This plainly tells us where her attack will be made, and that it will be after the Israelites or the Jews have been gathered there from

all nations, just as they are now being gathered.

Listen further to what the prophet says, "Therefore son of man prophesy and say unto Gog, thus saith the Lord God, in that day when my people of Israel dwell safely thou shalt know it, and thou shalt come from thy place out of the NORTH PARTS . . . Thou shalt come up against my people of Israel, as a cloud to cover the land (many airplanes), it shall be in the later days that I shall bring thee against MY LAND". WHY? "THAT the heathen (Gentiles), may know me, when I shall be sanctified in thee, O Gog before their eyes". 14-16.

#### The Presence of God Revealed

When Russia attacks Israel in the near future, then EVERY MAN on the face of the earth will shake at the presence of God. Verse 20. There will be such a general earthquake all over the world, as never known before. The mountains will even be thrown down, and the deep gullies and canyons filled up, "The steep places shall fall". Verse 20.

Heaven will take a hand in the affairs of men at that time, with miraclous power and destruction of wickedness. This will be the beginning of the stern intervention of heaven against the powers of wickedness, and ungodliness in this old world. It will be the beginning of the end of a world of sin, and the triumph of truth and righteousness and right.

This chapter concluded with the statement, THUS will I MAGNIFY MYSELF and SANCTIFY MYSELF, and I will be known in the eyes of MANY NATIONS and they shall KNOW that I AM GOD". It will take something like this to shatter this Satanic power of doubt and unbelief in the Bible and in God. that has so universally gripped this world.

#### Only One Sixth Left

Russia proper has a population today of approximately one hundred and fifty million, and the Lord declares, "I will turn thee back and leave but a sixth part of thee". This is when he brings her against Isreal. See chapter 39:2. One sixth part of one hundred and fifty million would be twenty five million left, but it will be the destruction of one hundred and twenty-five million people. The prophet says further, "Thus shalt thou fall upon the mountains of Israel, thou and all thy bands and the many people that is with thee. I will give thee unto the ravenous birds of every sort, and to the beasts of the field to be devoured". Thou shalt fall upon the open field. I HAVE SPOKEN IT SAITH THE LORD". Verses 4, 5. Chapter 39.

One year ago last month I stood at the old battle field of Armageddon, and saw with my own eyes great swarms of buzzards pouring down from the sky in a continuous stream, and flying over the very spot where in the future such ravenous birds are to be filled with human flesh. ### THE HOLY CITY, and the HOLY LAND

Twenty years ago this summer, the writer and his family were living in Jerusalem in a small apartment on the west side of the city known as the Rehavia district. We arrived there in February from Egypt having spent considerable time in Cairo and Alexanderia searching the old records in securing material for the History of The Church of God. We were on the train having crossed the tongue of the Red Sea about ten o'clock at night, and as it grew light the next morning we were impressed with the many orchards all leafed out and in bloom, with their fragrance perfuming the atmosphere reminded us very definitely of Paradise or Eden.

The Church of God work in the Holy Land was not exactly new because others had paved the way before us. Our elderly brother Elder David Nield of New Zealand, about eight years before, had set a church in order there. At the ripe old age of 85 he made a trip around the world alone in the interest of the Church of God missionary work. He was an old time friend of our father Elder A. F. Dugger who corresponded with him for many years, during his active ministry of just fifty years to the time of his death in 1910.

Elder David Nield stopped off at Stanberry, Missouri for several days on this round the world journey, and made his home with my mother, Mrs. F. M. Lippincott, where I was also staying at that time, 1924. Elder Nield was given money while there to have two gospel tracts translated and printed at Jerusalem in the Hebrew language, viz. "The Third Angel's Message", and the "Name Church of God". Upon his arrival in Jerusalem he set about to get this work done, and it was accomplished in good order. and the tracts used in further establishing the old time religion, and true faith in the Promised Land. He spent considerable time in Jerusalem and met for the first time Brother J. H. Volvoitch of Crimea, Russia, who was as reported one of the Kariot Jews, who believed in the Messiah, and had been baptized in his name. With his assistance they set about to gather together a company of believers under the New Testament name the Church of God, with the faith that was once delivered there to the saints.

Before leaving Jerusalem this devout and faithful man of God, set a church in order, with Brother Volcavitch, and David Horwich ordained as local Elders. The membership was small, but they held together, and slowly increased. About a year and a half later I received a letter from Jerusalem written by a

person signing her name Rose Miller. She was a missionary there of the Baptist Faith sent and suported by a woman living in Florida. In this letter she told of having an experience after earnestly praying one night for divine guidance in her missionary work among the Jewish people with whom she had not met with much success in their conversion. She was shown in a dream as she wrote me, an arm and hand, with the finger pointing East toward the Mount of Olives. On this arm was large outstanding letters "THE CHURCH OF GOD". She had never before thought about, or even known that this was the name so often mentioned in the New Testament, but she was puzzied, and prayed to know what it meant. It was either that day or the next, that she happened to find one of the church papers, The Advocate, and upon observing that it was published by the Church of God, and that we were interested in mission work among the Jews, with a lot of news items in it about their returning to Jerusalem, she wrote me, as I was Editor of that paper at the time. She also wrote in the letter that she had been convinced of the Sabbath and would like to become a member of this church for the Lord had definitely lead her in this way when she had so earnestly sought him in prayer. I sent her a membership certificate, which I asked her to sign, and if she had been baptized by immersion, she was worthy of membership on the grounds of the Commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus. She accepted this and has ever since been a faithful member and worker there. She is still living and the good Sister in Florida is still supporting her. We hear from both of them occassionally.

With my family, wife and three small children, Andy, Orabelle and Naomi, we had spent about five months in London, England, during the winter, and while there Sister Miller had written us that they were anxious for me to arrive in Jerusalem because several were awaiting to be baptized upon our arrival there. While in London this letter had gotten misplaced somehow, but I had the name and address of Brother Rosen with whom I had correspondence. While on the train before arriving in Jeursalem I was searching for her misplaced letter, which could not be found, but having the address of the other member there, we thought it would not be difficult to locate the rest. Upon arriving therefore we went direct to the American Express office where Brother Rosan worked, but to our disappointment, he had left there, and they did not have his address, so we were lost in a city of about one hundred and twenty thousand people with no way to locate any of them.

Our next move was to go to the Post Office where some mail was likely waiting our arrival, and while at the General Delivery window, a nice looking man stepped up, and said, " believe you are from America, are you not?" I answered that I was. Then he said I suppose you have friends in the city, to which I replied that we had, but their address was misplaced, and we could not find it. He then invited us to come over to his mission about three blocks, saying that your family look tired, and they can rest up, while you locate your people. We accepted his kind invitation, and as we walked into the mission grounds, about a fourth of a block inclosed by a stone wall, a woman approached from the mission building, and coming to us, this man, Brother Shelton said, "Meet Miss Miller, a missionary from America". This was the very person we were looking for, and her letter had been lost. In answer to our question, if this was where she lived, she said it was not, but she had just come there to see Brother Shelton, and was waiting for his return. Then a man came to us also, and we were introduced to him. His name was Henry Cohen, one who had been waiting for our arrival to be baptized. We thought perhaps he lived there also but in reply he said that he had just come to see Mr. Shelton.

This was a wonderful manifestation of the intervening hand that watches over and directs the course of all those who put their trust in Him. This unusual experience added to our faith that we were being directed in our journey there, and that it was within the will of the Heavenly Father. Question:

It has been reported that the church constitution has been changed so that it requires only eight of the 12 to adopt new doctrine for the church, instead of all 12. Is this true?

Answer:

An effort was made to do this, an attorney was hired and papers drawn up, with other changes. As it requires all of the 12 to make any constitutional change, these measures have failed to pass. For more information should you desire it, write Mrs. Violet Werner-Severson, Mapleton, Oregon, as she was the secretary when this business came up.

Question:

Where in the forty points of doctrine does it state we become a Jew when we accept Christ? Where do we find Israel means an overcomer?

Answer:

The above are not included in the 40 points of doctrine, but they are very positively taught in the Bible Home Instruction and in our literature. Our Constitution (Article 8, section 5) teaches very clearly that our ministers and officers shal respect doctrine taught in our literature and if they teach contrary they are not of good standing. Every Bible student knows that the term "Israel" spiritually speaking refers only to the overcomers. See Page 442, B. H. Instructor.

Question:

Was there not a questionnaire sent out to all the ministers about the church changing their doctrine on adultery and fornication, and did those connected with the "Reporter", sign this paper?

Answer:

The questionnaire sent out, was not to change old doctrine of the church, neither did it suggest any such changes. It was in harmony with the practice of the church, and the teaching of the old ministers on this subject. There was no question in the entire paper relative to persons holding office in the church, or of men being recognized as ministers who were involved in divorce and re-marriage. We have a copy of that paper here on file and can get at least one hundred ministers to sign that this answer is correct. Also that wen they fileld out their paper, they did not think of it as being interpreted to permit any such a practice.

Question: Is it true that the "Church of God" (7th Day) was set up on the west coast and organized the year 1931, Then why was it necessary to set up the organization of the 12 70 and 7 in the year 1933?

The organization of 1931 was on-

ly of a district nature including just the state of Oregon, but they had the lawful right to issue ministerial credentials then, not only for Oregon, but for ministers residing in any other state, or any part of the world. That power still re-

As that organization was not complete according to the scrip-tures, it was decided by the leaders to set up the organization fully in line with the Bible with the 12, the 70 and the 7, and to draft a Constitution appropriate for this New Testament order for church government. The Western district organization has continued from that time, but it has been working hand in hand with the body in general. It still holds to that constitution, and to the forty points of doctrine contained therein. It also stands for article 8 and section 5 of that constitution, upholding the doctrine taught in our literature that the Messiah was a Jew, and that Gentiles become spiritual Israel or Jews inwardly (Rom. 2:28, 29), when baptized. That all constitutional changes and doctrin-al changes shall be according to that constitution.

The western district has the staunch support of far the majority of the above official staff, as well as the membership over the world, in our protest against false doctrine and unconstitutional practices.

Why if there is no Church of God in Israel are we asked to support two men there who have no following, and who are working for other organizations?

Answer:

This question is misleading because it assumes there is no Church of God in Israel, and that the two ministers of the Church of God who have been so recognized for many years, are working with other organizations. Both of these men are Jews, Elders N. Newman and M. I. Ben-Maier, and they both speak the Hebrew language in Israel among their own people. They understand the Hebrew language to be the original tongue given to Israel, and that even the stars of heaven carry the names in Hebrew, which in that language declare unto us, the age in which we live, as we finish the great heavenly circle. The hour hand, in Hebrew has marked off the periods, with startling accuracy, and devine announcement, as it has passed by these stars, all of which in heaven, have been given names in the Hebrew. They tell us, in that language, only, just where we are living now. Note article on "Signs of His Coming in the Stars".

The Lord plainly tells us that in the time when He brings again Zion, and redeems Jerusalem, His

people will know HIS NAME. Read Isaiah 52: 6-9. These two brethren in Israel, believe they should tell people the Hebrew names for the Father and the son. This is why Elder Newman, in a recent visit to Tel Aviv brought this out as a part of his message. They are not trying to tell us here that we must use the Hebrew names, among the English people, every time we refer to the Father and the son. I do not believe these men should be cast away from us, just because they use the sacred Hebrew names for the Father and the son, among the Hebrew people, for these names are just as sacred to them, as the names we use here in the English are known to be sacred to us. They claim, with scriptural proof, that the only name our Saviour was known by while here, was his name in the Hebrew, and quote for proof Acts 26:14-15.

There is ample testimony of the presence of an extended oil field in Palestine. In the opinion of Dr. D. P. Brown of The Oil Trust, Ltd., the whole of the Yarmuk Valley lying southwest of Jerusalem and stretching to the Dead Sea area is one large oil-field.

On January 1, 1952, the Israel population numbered 1,578,000 of whom 1,405,000 were Jews (89 per cent) and 173,000 non-Jews. Jewish males now outnumber females by 26,000. In 1951 natural increase was 34,833 (up about 5000 over 1950). Mortality was 6.4 per 1000.

In the past 30 years the Jewish community of Israel has grown from 84,000 (in 1922) to 1,405,000 by the beginning of January, 1952.

Dear Brother Dugger,

Greetings in the precious name of Jesus to you and to all the saints in America. We spent part of the month of May in evangelical tour in the villages, Jallikomari, Moyyeru, Duvva, Ketali and their surroundings in Tanuku, Taluk, West Godavary district. During our labour, four souls were baptized and added to the church. One at Moyyeru and three at Ketali, viz. 1. Jale Christos Gandhi, 2. Elipe Barnabas, 3. Kamalamma, 4. Vajrapu Annamma. Then I fell sick and was confined to bed for about 10 days.

I have just returned from our campaign visiting and exorting the brethren at China Eggipuram, Bhimadole and Gudivada. In these villages some are waiting for baptism but for lack of water that was postponed for the end of this month.

The money sent by our beloved Brother Strucker was given to Elder T. Moses Dyva Deenam of Hyderabad. His family is ten in total with five sons, three daughters, and wife and himself. All are under his care except the eldest son. He needs Rs. 150/- to Rs. 200/- per month to live in a city like Hyderabad. The church at Hyberabad was able to contribute only between Rs. 25 or 40 for a month for the last few years. Therefore my sincere advice is that he should be paid at least 15 dollars a month from the treasury of the patronizing churches in America. If our beloved Bro. Strucker can do that, the church in India will be much more grateful for him. I asked our Bro. T. Moses Dyvadeenam to write a letter to our beloved Bro. Strucker to convey his thanks and acknowledgements.

Dear Bro., you know that up to the end of 1949, we used to get 100 dollars. But from the 1950, after the disturbance caused by the so called Merger, we have been getting only 50 dollars a month which amount is too small to meet all our expenses, so the church was not able to pay the workers regularly. At the end of the year 1951, there was due the ministers about Rs. 500/-. Our workers are still sticking to their duty with the hopes that all their unpaid allowances will be paid in the near future. I humbly beseech you in the name of the Lord to take immediate steps with the council in the church to increase our allotment to \$150.00 including Brother Struckers, and the other ladies donation so we may be able to meet all of our demands and to withstand the lacrous darts of the Devil. Please remember our churches and workers in your prayers.
