Atlas: Graphic representation of places and routes.

Archaeology: Impact of stratigraphic investigations and artifactual data.

Introduction: Discussion of date, authorship and literary style of each book of the Bible.

Commentary: Verse-by-verse exposition of the Bible.

Concordance: Lists what verses in the Bible use a particular word.

Lexicon: Gives various meanings of Greek (Hebrew, etc.) words

7. Where can I find a bibliography on "sign" in the New Testament?

8. What is the relationship of the Sadducees, Hasidim, and Pharisees?
