Acts	17	<u>Be-re'ans received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the Scriptures daily, whether those things were so</u>
Acts	18	<u>Feast of Tabernacles: Paul sailed from Ephesus to Jerusalem - saying, I MUST BY ALL MEANS KEEP THIS FEAST; Apollos, an eloquent man, and mighty in the Scriptures</u>
Acts	19	<u>Re-baptism; Anointed Cloth</u>
Acts	20	<u>Days of Unleavened Bread kept 29 years after Christ was crucified; Pentecost: Paul hastened, if it were (humanly) possible for him, to be at Jerusalem the day of Pentecost - 30 years after death of Christ</u>
Acts	27	<u>Day of Atonement (At-one-ment)</u>
Acts	28	<u>Paul dwelt two whole years in his own hired house, and received all who came in unto him, PREACHING THE KINGDOM OF GOD</u>
Romans	6	<u>Baptism: About the Flesh</u>
Romans	12	<u>Gifts of the Spirit (Also I Cor. 12)</u>
I Cor.	1	<u>Division in the Church condemned</u>
I Cor.	5	<u>Feast of Unleavened Bread: Therefore let us KEEP the feast; Eat not with a fornicator</u>
I Cor.	6	<u>Going to court (law)</u>
I Cor.	7	<u>Marriage (Also Eph. 5)</u>
I Cor.	8	<u>Meat offered to idols</u>

II Cor.	11	<u>SATAN HIMSELF is transformed into an angel of LIGHT. Therefore it is no great thing if HIS MINISTERS ALSO be transformed as the ministers of righteousness</u>
II Cor.	12	<u>Third heaven mentioned; Paul's thorn in the flesh</u>
Galatians	4	<u>Observing days, months, times, and years</u>
Galatians	5	<u>Two attitudes: WORKS of the flesh and FRUIT of the Spirit</u>
Ephesians	2	<u>Law of commandments (in ordinances of MEN) done away: Has nothing to do with the "ceremonial" law of Moses or the Ten Commandments being annulled</u>
Ephesians	4	<u>Government in the Church (Also I Cor 12)</u>
Colossians	2	<u>Don't let any man judge you for keeping the days God made holy!</u>
I Thess.	4	<u>Resurrection: DEAD in Christ shall rise first</u>
