I. PSYCHOLOGICAL PENALTIES

A. Separation of All Contact With God

For people in or out of God's church, Isaiah 59:2 is equally in effect, since ignorance of the law is no excuse.

"But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid His face from you that He will not hear." 1.

This is especially true for begotten sons of God, for we are without excuse, having known beforehand the Truth. The separation is automatic as an immediate result of breaking any of the points of the Law of God, since breaking one is the infraction of all according to the Apostle James:

"For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one, he is guilty of all." 2.

B. Guilt and Suicidal Tendencies

Whether or not a man, woman, boy or girl is aware of God's spiritual Law, he or she will automatically feel guilty, dirty, filthy, and disgusted after participating in pre-marital sexual relations (fornication) or extramarital sexual intercourse (adultery). The living Law produces this reaction every time: It cannot be escaped or avoided since every action bring a reaction.

The now famous Dr. Alfred C. Kinsey in a series of reports of sexual activity of human males and females uses a strictly carnal view, nevertheless he admits the existence of this guilt reaction, even among the very young:

"Various forms of pre-adolescent sex play in girls, including complete sexual union with older boys or men...cause guilt reactions (which are) traumatic, especially where the children had been discovered by adults."

Incidently Dr. Kinsey cites the so-called "great romances" of history as teen agers. He named Achilles and Deidamia, Acis and Calatia, Helen and Paris, Daphnis and Chlve, Heloise and Abelard, Tristan and Isolede, and of course Romeo and Juliet. 4. In his praise of teen age lust, the esteemed Doctor completely TRAGEDY and DEATH:

Those teen aged fornicators and adulterers seemed right in their actions to Dr. Kinsey, and by the way to most MISeducated people today. Yet God thunders twice:

"There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death."

"There is a way that seemeth right unto a man, but the end there of are the ways of death." 6.

C. DESTRUCTION OF CAPACITY FOR REAL LOVE

Premarital sex ruins a couple psychologically in yet another dreadful way as furthur penalty for breaking the 7th Commandment.

God's modern Apostle, Mr. Herbert W. Armstrong, affirms that: "Fornication before marriage...puts a scar on the future marriage that can never be erased or healed." 7. He later reinforced that statement by specifying any and all uses of sex, including masturbation, dooms the future marriage:

"Any premarital sex...mars the potential marriage happiness...puts irremovable scars on the marriage before it happens..." 8.

Just exactly what effect does pre-marital sex have on a future marriage? Just how is the scarring done? Let Judge Jennie Loitman Barrow of the Supreme Court of Massachusettes answer these questions:

"The sexual answer to loneliness can lead to the loneliest of lives, an almost total ABSENCE of FEELING:" 9.

That almost total lack of feeling is the main reason that hardened prostitutes and often-married "stars" of the Cinema alike experience no satisfaction with their numerous sex partners and are always seeking another, and another: This penalty is no respecter of persons; rich and poor of all social strata reap the same rewards.

We have seen how fornication wrecks a future marriage. Well, how does masturbation, or self gratification, take effect? God's modern Apostle, Mr. Herbert W. Armstrong, thunders the reply:

"Just about every so-called "authority" whose book I have seen, and the medical associations, universally chorus the minor discordant error that masturbation does no harm. I say to you on the authority of Jesus Christ and the Word of God that it does do harm-not only physically (even though temporary), but PSYCHOLOGICALLY, EMOTIONALLY, MENTALLY, and most of all, Morally and spiritually:" 10.

This is just another reason the Apostle Peter inspired by God wrote:

"Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, Abstain from fleshly lusts which war against the soul."

Yes, fleshly lusts war against the body's physical health, this present temporary life, and the chances of future eternal life. Therefore the job of every man, woman, and child too is to:

"Flee also youthful lusts; but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Eternal out of A pure heart." 12.

II. PHYSICAL PENALTIES

A. VENERAL DISEASES

One major physical penalty of indulging in fornication and adultery is the contracting of the most filthy diseases imaginable, the veneral diseases. By definition a veneral disease is a communicable disease spread from person to person by intimate contact. Such intimate contact is usually the sex act, but even a kiss or mouth to mouth resusitation will spread V D if one person has V D sores inside the mouth as is often the case in one stage of syphilis.

Of the five known veneral diseases only two are wide spread here in the United States. These two, syphilis and gonorrhea, will be discussed below.

1. Syphilis

One of the two most uidely spread veneral diseases is syphilis, which is caused by a corkscrew germ called a spirochete. The first sign of the disease may be a pimple, blister, or a sore appearing about 10 days after the contact at the point of contact.

The first sore is called a chancre. It may look like a pimple, a blister, or an open sore. When a person has such a sore, he or she is very dangerous to other persons. The sore is full of germs, and the disease may be passed along very easily...from 3 to 6 weeks later a rash will show up...sores may appear in the mouth. Sore throat, fever, or headache may develop... this is called the secondary stage of syphilis."

These first two blitzkrieg like stages of syphilis always fade away by themselves with or without interference from medical doctors. The victim is lulled into a false security unaware totally that the disease has gone underground to build up its forces for the knockout blow years later.

"After the second stage is passed, the germs of syphilis may remain hidden in the body for as long as 10 or more years before any damage appears. Suddenly the patient may become crippled, develop heart disease, blood vessel disease, blindness, or show mental symptoms. Even death may result from this third, or hidden, stage of syphilis." 14.

Please pardon here an unscholastic personal reference in this thesis, but I myself may attest to the veracity of the above quote. In my sexually promiscious life on university campuses before I married an equally sexually promiscious young lady, a member of the Women's Army Corps, I acquired syphilis. Even though then in 1956 I submitted to a series of penecillin shots, in 1966 I began to experience sight deterioration known as Glaucoma. Back in 1956 I did not know of God's healing, yet if I had not done even that-submitting to shots-I most likely would be totally blind right now.

As furthur proof of the terrible harm the rawages of V D wreak, even innocent babies may be born with congenital syphilis - if they live at all (many are born dead) - due to the mother having infected her own baby with the disease.

2. Gonorrhea

The most widespread of the two main veneral diseases in this nation is gonorrhea, which is caused by a grape-like cluster of round germs called Gonococci. This disease, commonly misnamed "strain", "Clap", "morning drop", or " a dose" by the street people, produces, "an accute inflamation of the genital and urinary tracts with a discharge of pus." 15.

The U. S. Public Health Service and the American Medical Association, under title of the U. S. Dept. of Health, Education, and Welfare, have published a number of booklets describing the cause, course, and prevention of both syphilis and gonorrhea. One states this:

"If a man has sex relations with a woman who has gonorrhea, in a few days or a week he will start to notice a burning pain when he makes water. Then he may notice a discharge or tear drop of pus from his sex organ. On the other hand, a woman almost never notices any pain or other signs when she has gonorrhea...A woman with gonorrhea does not feel sick and there is no sign of the disease until it spreads up through her womb and into her tubes. Then she has great pain...and after that, she may not be able to have any babies."

Like syphilis, gonorrhea too ends in horrible diseases and death.

"This disease may be responsible for arthritis, endocarditis, sterility, and blindness." 17.

3. VENERAL DISEASE STATISTICS

It is easy to claim, "V D does not concern me," yet the U.S. Public Health Service and the American Medical Association disagree and prove that indeed V D is everybody's business:

"More than 1,000,000 persons in the USA have syphilis this very moment, and most of them do not even suspect they are infected... 1 in 15 will become a syphilitic heart victim, 1 in 25 will be crippled or incapacitated, 1 in 50 will develop syphilitic insanity, 1 in 100 will become blind."

The publication of the City of Chicago V D control unit located at 26th Street and Wabash Avenue lists some hair raising and frightening statistics of the epidemic of V D sweeping this nation. The pamphlet states that in 1964 syphilis killed more people than were killed by Poliomyelitis, Diphtheria, Malaria, Typhoid, Whooping Cough, Measles, Scarlet Fever, and Dysentery combined: 19.

Because of the 200% increase in V D in the USA since 1957 in the 15-19 year old age group, the late President John Fitzgerald Kennedy on 14 February 1963 sent to the Congress a message on youth. In it he said:

"The incidence of veneral disease is again on the rapid rise, particularly among teenagers. Acting on the reccommendations of a panel of eminent medical advisors, I reccommended last year, and the Congress endorsed, the initiation of a major 10 year program of Federal grants and direct action aimed at the total eradication in this country of this age old scourge of mankind. This program will continue with intensive effort." 20.

B. PREGNANCIES, USUALLY UNWANTED

Some modern young people who do not fear veneral diseases because of their misplaced trust in the "wonder drugs" of medical men, have a real fear of unwanted pregnancies as a result of their fornication and adultery. Doctors agree that neither the new birth control pills nor the older mechanical devices of birth control are completely safe. Certain religious groups, notably the Catholics, use no birth control techniques at all other than the "rhythm system" based upon a woman's supposed time of fertility.

God's modern Apostle, Mr. Herbert W. Armstrong, makes a few cogent remarks about the alledged effectiveness of that "system".

"Today many doctors admit that this rhythm method is a faulty theory. There is no part of the month during which all women are for certain immune from conception. There may be a decrease in probability - but the matter is only relative. Medical charts show conceptions occuring at any or all times of the month." . 21

"But this so-called method of planned parenthood has in fact produced quite a bumper crop of babies.... I have seen charts in medical books generally available only to doctors - and I have read many statements of experience which do indicate that pregnancy is possible at any time of the mounth! " 22

THE UNITED STATES PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE in a conservative estimate states that there are about 250,000 illegitimate births a year in this nation.

Mr. Kenneth Dorn, a reporter for the National Enquirer interviewed Dr. Jerold Lowenstein, a San Francisco physician on 20 March 1967. The interview was printed in the May 1967 issue of the National Enquirer, a tabloid type of newspaper oriented to escapades of a sexual nature. Here are some of the schocking facts devulged by Dr. Lowenstein:

"One of every six girls in the USA will become pregnant out of wedlock between the ages of 13 and 19... She can marry the boy, but these shotgun marriages usually end disastrously... She may keep the baby, but this is a near impossibility for most teenagers to care for a baby... She may give up the baby for adaption, causing a lasting traumatic psychological scar, or she may have an illegal abortion." 23

Mr. G. C. Hanna, Superintendant of the Institute for the Feeble Minded and Colony for Epilectics in Minnesota gives us some statistics on abortions.

"Health authorities place the number of criminal abortions in the US at from 700,000 to 3,000,000 each year, and the deaths resulting there from at from 4,000 to 10,000...untold numbers of these are girls between the ages of 14 and 20 years."

Several times now I have used the phrase "illegitimate children", so I now think that I should make some clarification of terminology. Parenthood may be illegitimate, but not the children. Mr. G. C. Hamma makes this clear:

"Actually the word 'illegitimate' is not properly applicable to a child. There can be illegitimate parenthood, but not illegitimate children - and a few enlightened states have striken this term from the statute books. 25.

The modern Apostle Mr. H. W. Armstrong strongly concurs:

"There is no taint of sin connected with any birth. Even the birth of the child of unwed parents is not a sin: The fornication that brought about conception was a sin - on the part of the parents - but there is no sin on the part of the child."

Of course many pregnancies cause early or unplanned weddings, as well as a host of other evils too vast in number to be dealt with in this limited paper. But what happens to the vast army of girls who never marry after having become unwed mothers?

"Many of these girls and women become prostitutes thinking that all chance of acceptance is gone forever. Others are shamed for life...some marry worthless characters...still others so broud over their disgrace, and so suffer from the sting of social condemnation and ostrucism, that in their dispair they sink into criminal ways; become alcoholics, drug addicts ...reach hospitals for the insane, or commit suicide."

C. OTHER DISEASES

We are all well aware of the severe strain sex places on the heart. The heart pounds almost uncontrollably: Thus we constantly see persons great and small in worldly esteem fall victim to sex induced heart attacks.

Several years ago Erold Flynn, a middle-aged "he-man" of Hollywood action films died in a Canadian resort hotel room with teen aged blonde Beverly Aadland. Couples are constantly being found dead partially clothed or even nude in carbon monoxide filled parked cars. Even the acclaimed "king" of Hollywood, Clark Gable, died of a heart attack after several sessions with sex queen Marilyn Monroe, who later in remorse killed herself.

The two men named above were both middle aged men or slightly older-suppossedly the prime of life - but they died suddenly. God has so designed the human body that no age group is safe from sudden death when illicit sex is undertaken. This is due to the extra pressures of guilt, fear of apprehension, fear of V D, and fear of unwanted pregnancy in addition to the natural racing and pounding of the heart.

Mr. John Anderson, a reporter for the National Star Chronicle, relates how a 19 year old student nurse died of an unusual type of heart attack - heart arrest - in the arms of her married lover who was convicted for her murder.

"According to medical experts...Peake
was the very cause of the student nurse's
death. Repeated sexual intercourse
within a short time, a doctor stated,
can put a strain on the Vagus Nerve
which leads from the brain to several
of the body's organs. When too much
stimulation is sent along this nerve,
a slowing down or stoppage of other
organs, including the heart, can occur.
The doctor stated that this is precisely
what happened in Victoria's case...Peake
was booked on a charge of murder. At his
trial last April 28th,he was found Guilty
and sentenced to life imprisonment." 28

In conclusion of this section dealing with diseases other than V D which afflict those who break God's 7th Commandment, let us peruse this list of ailments catalogued by Dr. John Duffy MD, Assistant Professor of the History of Public Health at the University of Pittsburgh:

"Many female diseases such as leucorrhoea, uterine hemmorage, falling of the womb, cancer, palpitation, hysteria, convulsions, haggard features, emaciation, debility, and MANIA arose from masturbation...even, if the disease did not originate with it, masturbation would certainly aggravate the condition". 29

Yes indees, in addition to the psychological, mental, emotional, and spiritual penalties for indulging in adultery and fornication, we have found a formidable array of physical penalties: V D, unwanted pregnancies, heart attacks, and the maladies listed above by Dr. Duffy.

With all of these penalties there yet remains another whole family of penalties, the social penalties, to be discussed in the next chapter.

III SOCIAL PENALTIES

A. Taxes for Homes and Institutions

Taxes for the construction, staffing, and maintenance of insane asylums, homes for the blind, and homes for unwed mothers-not to mention the growing cancer of Public Aid - drain the hapless taxpaper dry!

Dr. Fitch of Northwestern University several times has addressed groups of interested persons about the sex plague of V D in America. He shocks his audiences with the facts that the care of the syphilitic insane costs taxpayers more than \$50 million a year, and that aid to the sypilitic blind costs taxpayers \$6 million annually:

B. Family and Home Breakup

So called "Sexual Freedon" - the worst type of slavery, since it is slavery to one's own lust - and moral laxity, even approved by the so called "leaders" of society, are steadily ripping families and family ties to shreds.

"Divorce has ripped asunder nearly every third home in the United States.
Millions of children must grow up with foster parents or no parents. Others are reared in unhappy homes, filled with sour, bitter, constant family strife!" 30

The leaders of society, the judges, doctors, lawyers, ministers, pastors, and priests, actually aid and abet the disintergration of morals and the God ordained institution of the family by praising and glorifying adultery:

"Countless married couples have marital difficulties. They turn to marriage counselors, to their pastors and ministers for advice...Many are being told it is perfectly normal to commit adultery; that sexual deviation, depravity, abnormality, or infidelity is sometimes 'good' for their marriage."

Even families which somehow manage to physically stick together include a vast number of families who do not live as families anymore.

"Family life is being stifled in our modern society - simply because many families have ceased being families—and are becoming public gatherings of casual acquaintances."

The parents do not understand their children because they do not take the time to be with, instruct, and correct the children. The children are lost and confused, unaided by guiding authority they deserve and need from their parents. They therefore tend to draw apart into their own world of gangs, sexual experimentation, and crime:

C. Social Ostralism, Crime & Anti-Social Behavior

We are all well aware of the social ostracism of a community against the "bad boy" or the "girl from across the tracks" because of their sexual looseness, even though many of the ostracizers may themselves be just as guilty covertly rather than openly. Mr. G. C. Hanna really expressed better than anyone else I have yet read the terror, the fear, and the ostracism an unwed mother or mother to be feels.

"Society says that you shall not be a mother unless you are married. Defy this edict and you are condemned for life. A menstrual period is missed, and a girl is panic stricken. For four more weeks she is in a state of anguish, hoping, praying that nothing is wrong-but fearing the worst."

As mentioned earlier, many of these "fallen women" feel so much social shunning that they become prostitutes, criminals, dope addicts, or suicides. Their sons, brothers, and sometimes husbands become muggers, pimps, robbers, and worse. The teen age children of such delinquent parents, having had no discipline, are completely lawless; and any lawless person is a criminal whether or not he or she may be apprehended:

IV STEPS TO REMEDY THE SITUATION

A. Personal Action, Surrender to God

There is not very much that one person is able to do to halt the world wide hostility toward and the deliberate breaking of God's holy, wonderful, and beautifully perfect law: There is, however, much that one person can do - and, after the required steps, much that God Himself will do through that person - to clean up his or her own personal life. Sin, the breaking of God's law, comes about by a person surrendering to his own lust, harbouring evil thoughts which germinate into sin and death.

"But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust and enticed. Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin; and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death."

Thus since sin comes about by surrendering to lust, a personal remedy is to resist sin and surrender, rather, to God, repent, be horribly sorry for having done and BEEN such a criminal, and begin to live in the directly opposite manner. Such a repentant person, after baptism, will be given by God His Spirit to empower that new way of life.

"Then Peter said unto them,
Repent, and be baptized everyone of you in the name of Jesus
Christ for the remission of Sins,
and ye shall receive the gift of
the Holy Spirit."

"And in the days of these Kings shall the God of Heaven set up a kingdom which shall never be destroyed: and the kingdom shall not be left to other people, but it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand forever."

There will be compulsory joy and forced happiness when Jesus Christ and the ressurrected saints, born into the family of God, crush man-made CIVILIZATION and usher in the wonderful world tomorrow ::
