

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS -- PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

1. CHEERFULNESS. Remember, the Feast of Tabernacles pictures the soon-coming 1000 years of peace, joy and happiness supreme -- so try to be thankful and happy at all times during the Festival! Keep smiling and be genuinely FRIENDLY to everyone! Please, let none of us grumble or complain even once! Be considerate of others -- especially those with whom you share a chalet. If something needs attention, don't discuss it with other members but GO IMMEDIATELY TO ONE OF GOD'S MINISTERS. Let your light truly shine (Matt. 5:16)!
2. PUNCTUALITY. Always be on time -- at meals, SERVICES and at all events. God is never late! Follow Him!
3. ATTENTIVENESS. All of us should be very quiet and respectful during services! Be as alert, quiet and attentive as possible during sermons. We urge you to take concise, yet complete notes of all the messages and go over them from time to time.
4. CLEANLINESS & TIDINESS. "God is not the author of CONFUSION" (I Cor. 14:33); therefore God commands, "Let ALL THINGS BE DONE DECENTLY AND IN ORDER" (v. 40). Jesus Christ, our Saviour, wishes us to be neat and tidy in our person (Heb. 10:22), our clothes (Eph. 5:27), in the cottages and in the camp generally. Be sure and take care of the camp property while you are here. Also, please take good care of our SONG BOOKS!
5. CHILD-DISCIPLINE. Parents will be held strictly responsible for the CARE and the BEHAVIOUR of their OWN CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES -- especially during MEALS and at the SERVICES! Younger children in particular need constant supervision by their parents (preferably) or at least by someone mature enough to properly care for them! DO NOT DISCIPLINE YOUR CHILDREN IN PUBLIC!
6. RESPECT FOR ELDERS. Let us all be especially attentive to the needs and comforts of our ELDERLY PEOPLE -- to those crowned with the "hoary head"! See Leviticus 19:32 and Proverbs 16:31.
7. RESPECT FOR AUTHORITY. God commands that we respect and obey those in authority over us -- who ask us to do or not to do something. See Hebrews 3:17; Romans 13:1-8. If you are requested to serve in any capacity, please do so cheerfully!
8. MODERATION. If we are temperate in all things -- in food, drink, exercise and sleep -- while at this Feast, we will avoid a lot of unnecessary illnesses (See I Cor. 9:25). God's Ministers urge all to try and get to bed by 11:00 p.m. if possible -- or by 11:30 p.m. at the latest.
9. COMPLAINTS OR REQUESTS. If you have any complaints or requests, please report it to the Festival Office. Do not ask or inform the camp staff, who are not in authority to grant your request.
10. DON'T "TALK RELIGION" TO CAMP STAFF, or to unbaptized persons who are attending the Feast with their relatives.
11. DON'T LEAVE VALUABLES LYING AROUND CARELESSLY IN YOUR COTTAGE. They may be safely deposited at the reception office, if you wish.
12. PRAYER. Don't neglect your Bible study and PRAYER while at the Festival. If you neglect prayer, you'll miss a great blessing and things just won't go as well for you!
13. GOD'S MINISTERS are here to SERVE you, and will be available for counselling or visiting of the sick at all hours (Jas. 5:14-16)!

KEEP THESE POINTS IN MIND AT ALL TIMES -- and act on them. Then we will all have a joyful, successful and rewarding Festival to remember!

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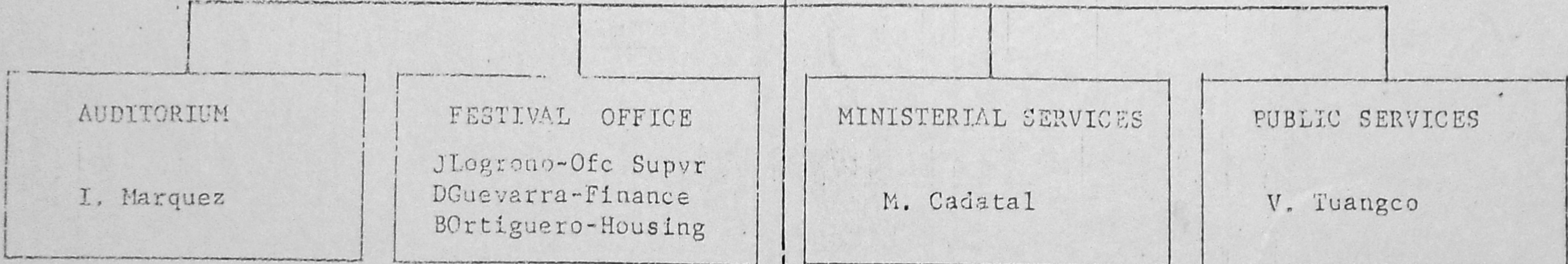

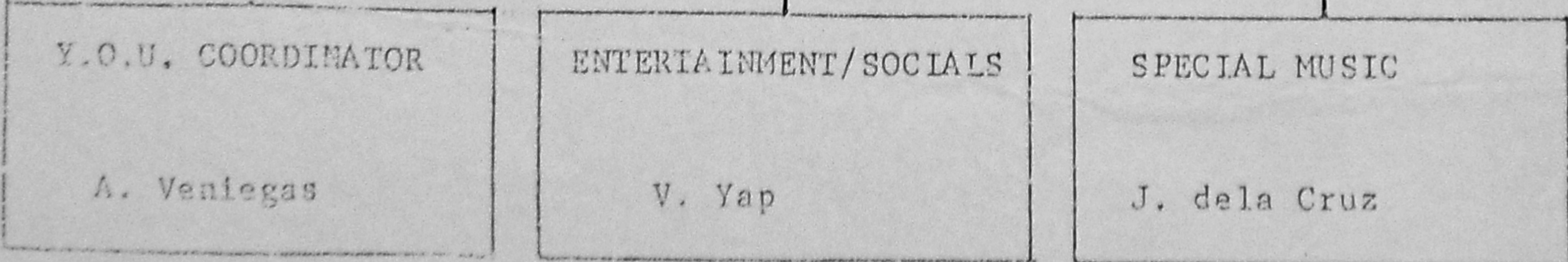
