Greetings and welcome, brethren, to the Feast of Tabernacles. In anticipation of the scores of you who will be here this year, we have realized a definite need for cooperation and organization. Therefore, we have compiled some useful information and listed a few simple rules for you to observe (for your own good) while you are here. We cannot stress too strongly that you do your part by obeying these rules and helping keep the facilities, which God has opened to us, clean and orderly.

We have tried to place responsible men in key positions to guide and help you in every possible way. We must ask you to cooperate by following their instructions to alleviate any possible confusion.

Since we have a tight schedule, we must work together to insure the most from these eight days -- God's Feast of Tabernacles.

MEALS

Midday Meal: 12:30 noon

Evening Meal: 6:00 p.m. (7:00 p.m. when there are afternoon services).

PRICES OF MEALS

4/3 per meal for children five through nine years of age inclusive.

8/6 per meal for all ten years and over.

PAYMENT OF MEALS

Please cooperate with us by paying for your meals before the last annual Sabbath, commencing at sunset October 1st. Payment should be made to Mr. Gene Hughes.

TIME OF SERVICES

Services will begin PROMPTLY as scheduled.

Morning:

10:00 a.m. every morning

Afternoon:

On Sabbath days ONLY, at 2:30 p.m. There will be no preaching services held in the evenings of those particular

days.

Evening:

7:30 p.m. all evenings except those at the close of the Sabbaths. Exceptions to all these schedules will be announced from the pulpit; otherwise they will remain

as you see them here.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Payment for all accommodations must be paid to the Church through Mr. Gene Hughes before sunset October 1st. However, electricity bills and other extra expenses should be paid by the one incurring same -- paid directly to the proprietor of place in which you are staying.

GENERAL RULES

- 1. The STAGE and DRESSING ROOMS are restricted -- only <u>authorized</u> persons permitted backstage.
- 2. NO ONE is allowed in the KITCHEN at any time -- a regular staff is assigned to the kitchen, see Mr. Longuskie or Mrs. Burchill if you have need of anything from the kitchen.
- 3. PARENTS are responsible for THEIR children at ALL TIMES.
- 4. AT NO TIME should children be permitted to go to the swimming pool or into parks and surrounding areas without an adult.
- 5. ALL FACILITIES <u>must</u> BE KEPT CLEAN at all times -- never throw food, paper or debris on the floor or ground.
- 6. CARE must be exercised to insure TOILETS are kept clean and in order -never leave children unattended in toilets.
- 7. SONG BOOKS are church property and should not be taken from auditorium -- keep them clean and off the floor.
