FEAST OF TABERNACLES

GREETINGS BRETHREN! WELCOME to the 1964 Feast of Tabernacles! This year is a special year inasmuch as God has provided us with a fine, inspiring Tabernacle in which to meet for the annual Feast of Tabernacles. May God inspire each of you to truly enjoy the observance of this Festival and the natural beauty of the surroundings in this area.

We expect about 900 to attend the Feast this year which more than ever necessitates organization and <u>definite co-operation</u> from us all.

God is not the <u>author of confusion</u>.... Whatever He does is systematic, orderly and efficient! We are here to observe the Festival which pictures the 1000-year reign of Christ...the time when the world will become orderly and peaceful under Christ's direction. It is <u>imperative</u> that we all show the spirit and character of Christ in our conduct throughout this festival.

We must all be <u>willing</u> and ready to <u>follow instructions</u> and <u>directions</u> of those placed in positions of responsibility. Remember, SUBMISSION TO AUTHORITY is the main evidence and ingredient of true conversion.

This entire festival has been planned to provide a balance of the spiritual meat and fellowship and also social times of enjoyment with our brethren. We trust and pray you shall truly be nourished and blessed by participating in this Feast of Tabernacles.

The following are instructions that MUST be observed to insure harmony during the next eight days.

MEALS:

Breakfast must be provided by each of you as none shall be served in the Tabernacle.

Mid-day Meals: 12:15 P.M. Evening Meals: 5:30 P.M.

PRICE OF MEALS:

£8:0:0 for the entire Festival for all 11 years of age and older. £4:0:0 for the entire Festival for children 4 to 10 years of age. No price for infants up to 4 years of age. (Prepared baby food for infants will be available at cost.)

Note: If you wish children under 11 years to have adult meals then full price will have to be paid.

PAYMENT OF MEALS:

Please co-operate by paying for meals <u>only</u> at a time when the Business Office is open and as early in the Festival as possible. All meals <u>MUST</u> be paid for <u>before the last annual Sabbath begins</u> sunset 27 September. All payments must be made to <u>Mr. Gene R. Hughes</u> or assistants in the Business Office.

TIMES OF SERVICES:

All services will begin PROMPTLY as scheduled.

Morning: 10:00 A.M.

Afternoon: On Sabbath days ONLY at 2:30 P.M. There will be no preaching

services held in the evenings following the Sabbaths.

Evenings: 7:30 P.M. all evenings except at the close of the Sabbaths.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

All of you should be sure to settle your lodging accounts before the beginning of the final Sabbath of this Festival or wait until after the Sabbath...no business should be transacted on God's Sabbath. Remember, you are Ambassadors for Christ. One way you can be a light in setting a fine example to those in this community is in the way you take care of and conduct yourself in your lodging quarters. When you leave the accommodations--try HARD to leave the place in as good a condition if not better than when you found it.

GENERAL RULES:

- 1. The STAGE and CONFERENCE ROOM area is OUT OF BOUNDS to <u>all</u> except those with business or need in the area; general traffic is prohibited. If you have need of anything from these areas please see one of the deacons or ministers.
- 2. NONE, except authorised persons are allowed in the KITCHEN at any time. See one of the ministers or Mr. Higgins if you have need of anything from the kitchen.
- 3. PARENTS are responsible for THEIR children at ALL TIMES. Children should not be allowed to run or play in the hall or passageways, or walk on the flower gardens.
- 4. AT NO TIME should children be permitted to go off grounds or wander into the surrounding bush-land without an adult.
- 5. ALL FACILITIES must BE KEPT CLEAN at all times -- never throw food, paper or debris on the floor or ground.
- 6. TOILETS: Please -- each one make it his responsibility to keep the toilets neat and tidy.
- 7. SONG BOOKS are Church property and should not be taken from the auditorium--keep them clean and off the floor. Do not use them as backing for writing your notes and DO NOT LET CHILDREN PLAY WITH THEM.
- 8. Please CHECK THE OPPORTUNITIES LIST! YOU may have been given the privilege of filling a position of SERVICE during the Festival! If so, please
 report to either Mr. T. M. Higgins or a Section Supervisor AS SOON AS POSSIBLE
 AFTER YOUR ARRIVAL! Remember, your desire to serve and dedication to Christ
 can be determined to a large extent by the ZEAL with which you fulfill your
 assignments!!
- 9. Meals: Please be PROMPT at meal times. <u>Late arrival</u> could mean <u>missing</u> the meal!

10 The cry room is provided as a place for sitting during services for those with small babies who are likely to cause disturbance during the services. Correction should not be given to children in this room but rather children should be taken to the toilets when correction is needed.
