Greetings in the name of Jesus!

And, please accept my apologies for taking so long to reply to your letter. The growth of the ministry (praise The Lord) has kept us hoping!

I am enclosing some background information on the Foundation and its work for The Lord. As you know, I think, and as the material will indicate, our mission lies primarily in the area of Biblical principles of government and America's Christian heritage. I should stress, however, that Biblical principles are Biblical principles the world around and apply to every person and all nations.
