THE CLOSE OF PROBATION AND THE END OF GRACE.

The close of probation and the end of Grace is one and the same thing. There is another thing that means the same, that is the iniquity is full. Abraham was told that his seed could not enter Canaan till the iniquity of the Amorites was full. That meant the time would come when there could be no more done for the Amorites. They had rejected every offer God had for them and the iniquities of the fathers had been visited on the children through inheritance till none of the offspring could be reached with the Gospel: When that point was reached then Grace for the people ended. Note. The people determined the end of grace themselves by the course they pursued. In this man-

ner will the close of probation come to the world. The world determines their own destiny, God seeing from the beginning the whole story of man and the course man would persue saw the end from the beginning and so gave the information to his children through the prophets, when that time would be. Hence when the time comes then the decree is due the world, "he that is filthy let him be filthy still and he that is holy let him be holy still."

Following that decree he says, "behold I come quickly," (not immediately). At that point begins in earnest the events which are to prepare the world for their destruction in the order specified. This destruction of the world is to mark such a time of trouble as never was. Dan. 12:1, 2. The trouble as to what it is, is plainly told, namely: War, Pestilence, and Famine.

The present condition in the world only leads to the final. Whether there will be a period between the present conditions and the final, of peace, we do not know but we can say this, we know of nothing which teaches there will and it seems not probable at all there will be. That there will be a change in the issues between the nations now at war there is no doubt in our mind. The way of "the kings of the east is not yet prepared," but that is being done just as fast as possible by the present war. Every man, and every dollar spent by western nations is preparing that way.

The United States being one of the western nations it must necessarily come into the war. It is both logical and reasonable it should. So when the time comes that the present issues among the western nations is far enough advanced new issues will arise from other sources. We do not hesitate to say the next issue will be between the East and the West, between Christendom and Heathenism, with two thirds the population of the world on the eastern side and one third (and much less counting out their present losses) on the other side. Russia and Japan will be the leading factors on the eastern and England and the United States on the western side.

The present outlook from our standpoint is as stated above. But how is it received? The answer is this: Most every one replies "that will not come in my day," The world will stand a long time yet," "It looks as you say but I think you have some wrong views and interpretations of the Bible." Thus there is shown a lack of faith both in the Bible itself and second in all interpretations placed on it pretaining to the end of the world. Thus business and all things go on the same and no heed is paid to what any one may say. This shows me that the world has closed every

avenue to help them and the world is ripe for the harvest.

The Conditions of the World in Knowledge Of the Bible.

We have noted in all we have read and heard spoken about the war not one word has been said as to the cause from any Bible stand point. Leaders are blamed, and issues are discussed but not a word as to God's cause of war. In this respect they are different from the prophet Daniel, when the great calamity came upon Jerusalem he said it is "because we have sinned," "Therefore the curse is poured upon us which Moses had written." Then with prayer and confession to God Then with prayer and confession to God he prayed most earnestly. Also when Ninevah was to be over thrown the king and all his subjects repented of sin in sack cloth and ashes and God changed the decree. Not so today, no one seems to see the real cause of the present war and the future out look. Not a minister raises his voice to teach the people the truth. All they can see is that "it is the Kaiser," "It is the course the United States is taking," "It is England that is to blame," but as to the moral condition of the world nothing is said. No repentance is advised. No study of the Bibie is refered to. No desire to see what the prophets have spoken in the name of the Lord is looked Everything else is examined, High cost of living, How to make money out of the war, How to avoid All this is considered and noted with deep interest, but how to seek God, how to know his truth, how to break loose from creeds and isms and receive the truth, all this is of no avail and unpopular. "The wise forseeth the evil and hideth himself but the simple pass on and are punished." So the day is near when not a soul will be reached with the Gospel in its purity. Then probation closes and the decree passes. Thus no one is responsible but the people themselves.
They reap just what they sow. They get just what
they have chosen.
They have lived for the world and it is all they can

see in it. They do not realize that "darkness covers the earth and gross darkness the people." They do not realize that ruin is staring them in the face. haven't the faintest idea of the time of trouble before them. We feel some what as Christ did when he saw the fate of Jerusalem by the Roman army. He said, "Oh Jerusalem, Jerusalem, how often would I have gathered you as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings but ye would not." He said "she knew not the time of her visitation." She could have known but light was rejected. How glad would we be could we see on the part of the people a seeking of God and true repentance and desire to know the truth that the people might be saved, but each day seems the people is harder to reach and true repentance is so scarce we no longer see what we call "a godly sorrow for sin." Grave is soon to open. The Throne of Grace will be no more, The Throne of Glory will be set up and Christ will then reign. Who will prepare with us to be His subjects where war will be no more and peace will eternally reign?

CHARLES T. RUSSELL OF MELLENIAL DAWN FAME AND HIS TEACHING AND CHRONOLOGY EXAMINED.

In his book, "Helping Hand," series 2 we find the following statement, recorded in chapter two, Page 33. "In this chapter we present the Bible evidence which indicates that the six thousand years from Adam were completed in 1872, and hence since that A. D.

1872 we are chronologically entered on the seventh

thousand or the millennium—the forepart of which is "the day of the Lord" "the day of trouble is" to witness the breaking into pieces of the kingdoms of this world and the establishment of the Kingdom of God under

the whole heavens."

Question. What does Mr. Russell mean by the forepart of the millennium. "The time of trouble" and "the day of the Lord"? We will let him answer the above questions. On page 76 and 77 of the same book. Here it is: "in this chapter we present the Bible evidence proving that the full end of the times of the Gentiles, i. e. that is the full end of their lease of dominion will be reached in A. D. 1914, and that date will be the fartherest limit of the rule of imperfect men," "that at that date the Kingdom of God for which our Lord taught us to pray saying thy Kingdom come will obtain full universal control and then it will be "set upon," firmly established, on the earth on the ruins of present nations. Secondly. This will prove that he whose right it is will then be present as earth's new ruler and not only so but it will prove that He will be present for a considerable time before that date, because the overthrow of these Gentile governments is caused directly by His dashing them to peices as a potters vessel, Psalms 2:9; Rev. 2:27, and establishing in their stead his own righteous government. Thirdly. It will prove that some time before the end of 1914 A. D. the last member of the divine recognized church of Christ, the Royal Priesthood, the body of Christ, will be glorified with the head because every member is to reign with Christ, being a joint heir with him of the kingdom, and it cannot be fully "set up" without every member. Fourthly. It will prove that Jerusalem will no longer be trodden down of the Gentiles from that time forward because the time of the Gentiles will be fulfilled. Fifthly. It will prove that from that date or sooner Israel's blindness will begin to turn away, because their blindness in part was to continue only till the fullness of the Gentiles come in. Sixthly and seventhly. It is there stated that the spirit of anarchy unsettled conditions of society and distress will then recognize the Kingdom "set up," quietness will then be the order following the upheavel prior to the establishment of the kingdom in 1914."

Note. The period between 1872 and 1914 is forty years. This period is called by Mr. Russell as "the harvest age." "The time for the selection of the special few called the bride." The date 1872 is located by chronology as the end of the first six thousand years from creation and located as the time for the coming of Christ spiritually and invisibly. That date marks also the beginning of the seventh thousandth years or millennium age of the world. The second period is located to end 1914 by a supposed prophetic period found in Leviticus 26th chapter, supposed to begin at the Babylonish captivity 606 B. C. and lasting 2520 years ending 1914. Thus leaving forty years difference in the two endings. This second period is interpreted as being the time when the fullness of the Gentiles will be ended and also blindness of the Jews The Jews will then return to Palestine will be past. and Christ will then set up his visible kingdom manifest to all. Mr. Russell also teaches that at the end of the six thousand years all the righteous dead was then resurrected. He also teaches that all who died were unconscious in death, but since that time those who die of "the special class," the Bride class do not become unconscious at death but they are translated like Elijah and are now with Christ. The above we hold to be an honest representation of the teaching of Mr. Russell's books on the points mentioned.

We might further state that during the thousand years Satan is to be bound. The wicked dead are to be gradually resurrected, and given an opportunity to

gain a true knowledge of God and given an opportunity to be saved. "The Bride class" are then to work especially with Christ to influence them to every thing that is right, as stated by Mr. Russell in our hearing "they on seeing any one inclined to do any thing wrong will take them by the arm and show them the right way." The above is sufficient to cover the main foundation of the teaching of Mr. Russell and his followers. With all respect to both he and his followers we examine these foundation principles of the teaching. We understand that when we place in public print our views they then become public property for any criticism. The good book says, "Every man seemeth right in his own mind but his neighbor cometh along and searcheth him."

Question. Where has one of the predictions come We reply not a single one. Where are those who have seen any of the multitude of righteous who Mr. Russell said would be resurrected in 1872? All that have ever been resurrected such as Moses, Christ, Lazarus, and the many bodies of them that slept who were resurrected when Christ was resurrected were all seen by people by the natural eye. But not even a glimpse of any of the multitude claimed to have been resurrected in 1872 have ever been seen; Second, who has ever seen any of the bride class who have died since 1872? None. Who has ever seen Christ himself? None. Next who believes Satan is bound since 1872? No one. Wno believes that the prediction has been fulfilled that the city of Jerusalem after 1914 would no longer be inhabited by the Gentiles? None. who believes that Christ has been manifest to the world since 1914? None. Who believes the Gentile governments have all been overthrown and the government of Christ set up prior to or in 1914? None. Who believes the fullness of the Gentiles have come in since 1914? None. These predictions were all written years before 1914. Hence all must now admit they were a mistake. But now it is 1917 and not one of them materialized. What must the honest believe? We reply that Mr. Russell was mistaken. We do not mean by this any criticism only he was mistaken. But there is another side to it that we cannot speak favorable of. That is the course taken by his followers. We hold they should acknowledge the mistake if they would carry influence and the power of the Gospel. But contrary to that they said the war beginning in 1914 was the fulfillment. No brother that will not do. If you will read Rr. Russell's statements which we cite you to he plainly says the time of trouble would all be over before 1914 "and then the Kingdom would be 'set up' on the ruins of these governments." The present course is a dodge taken to evade the truth of his teaching which will not stand in the mind of any candid mind, and further it is easy to be seen in reading the teaching Mr. Russell had no idea of any such a war as now exists and it can't be shown. Jeremiah told the people of the destruction of Jerusalem, and who would do it. The Bible in its latter days of war speaks giving the names of nations that will lead the armies and whom against. Did Mr. Russell do this? No. He dwelt more especially on ecclesiastical distress, upheavels of society, anarchy, and so on, none of which described sucn a war as is now raging. twisting will not convince fair minded people of sincerity. But if a confession was made that a mistake was made all would be greatly stirred and led to believe in such sincerity. They also with the Gospel would be exalted.

One of the real causes of Mr. Russell's mistake was the fact his chronology was wrong that the six thousand years ended in 1872. Second, there was no such a period of 2520 years to be found in Leviticus 26th chapter. __nird, the fullness of the Gentiles did

not end in 1914 nor will not till probation closés. Forth, blindness will continue in part with the Jews till probation closes. Fifth. The Jew will not go to Jerusalem in fulfillment of prophecy at all. there is no period of forty years of harvest as taught by Mr. Russell. Seventh, and last the whole fabric of his teaching is a wrong use of Scripture and originated in a visionary mind. It has prospered because the people at large are unacquainted with the Bible and its teaching, and the use he made of Scripture seems plausible to the people who know no better than to accept it as truth. In conclusion we will say it was no dishonor in accepting it for if all the uninformed in Bible ceaching had accepted it, it would have taken most all. Hence it showed this, that the seeker after truth and those who desired truth accepted it more than those who did not. We say in conclusion there is but one way out of the error and that is to still desire truth and with humility confess the mistake and go on again to seek truth and God will lead you on to greater things.

Much has been said about the reformation by Luther and his followers. NOT TO BECOME UNCIRCUMCISED.

Paul says "if any man is called being circumcised let him not become uncircumcised." "If he be called in uncircumcision let him not become circumcised. Circumcision is nothing and uncircumcision is nothing but the keeping of the commandments of God."

First Cor. 7:18-20, verse 20 says "let every man abide in the same calling wherein he is called. He further continues "If thou art called being a servant care not for it. Let every man abide in the same calling wherein he was called."

Question Was Paul ignoring circumcision or any other thing the man was doing that was honorable? No. Circumcision was all right for the purpose it was intended to teach. A servant is an honorable calling. The thought is not to become dissatisfied with your acceptance with God and think you had to work out your salvation by doing some kind of works. Some have supposed Paul condemned circumcision by this text. We say no, no more than he condemned other things people were doing that was right. The thought is that some were teaching salvation by circumcision alone and Paul met the argument. The only way a man could become uncircumcised would be to deny the faith it taught, Paul says don't do that, the lesson is a good one and necessary, don't deny it, but do not trust in the act alone. The same thought is found in Galatians:

"Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.

"Behold, I Paul say unto you, that if ye be circumcised, Christ shall profit you nothing.

"For I testify again to every man that is circum-

cised, that he is a debtor to do the whole law.

"Christ is become of no effect unto you, whosoever of you are justified by the law; ye are fallen from grace. "For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of

righteousness by faith.

"For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love.
"Ye did run well; who did hinder you that ye

should not obey the truth?

"This persuasion cometh not of him that calleth

The above Scripture tells the point, namely, those who were trying to be justified by the law. He says to all such they were duty bound to keep the whole law, and that they could not do in their own strength

without Christ. Any attempt of that kind was salvation by works without faith, something no one can do is to keep the whole law without Christ. The Galatian brethren had been justified by faith and placed where they could keep the law but some teachers had come and taught salvation by circumcision and works of the law. Now says the apostle stand fast in the liberty whereunto ye have been called and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage, (working out your own salvation,) for I testify against you that every one "of you, if we become circumcised Christ will profit you nothing ye have fallen from grace, whosoever is justified by the law. For we through the spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by faith. For in Jesus Christ circumcision nor uncircumcision availeth any Another text thing but faith which worketh by love." says "circumcision nor uncircumcision profiteth nothing but being made a new creature." Now in all these texts does the apostle condemn circumcision? Circumcision teaches a divine lesson the same as baptism teaches a divine lesson and every child of God needs the lesson taught by it, the same as the lesson in baptism but neither alone will save. Obedience to the commanuments of God comes only by faith. hearts are purified by faith, which worketh by love' which love is the keeping of the commandments of God, and by faith we are made a new creature. remember the proof of our acceptance in all cases is the willingness to obey in all things God has commanded us to perform. "He that sayeth he knoweth me and keepeth not my commandments is a liar and the truth is not in him." Obedience is always the test of

The question of salvation by circumcision was the question to be settled at the council at Jerusalem as recorded in Acts 15th chapter. Some said "except ye become circumcised and keep the law of Moses ye cannot be saved." The decision of the council recommended the teachers of the Gentiles to instruct the Gentiles "to abstain from idolatry, things strangled, from fornication and from blood," as new beginners and to hear the law read written by Moses which was read in the synagogue every Sabbath and they could learn the rest. The difference in this instruction of the apostles and the teaching of the Jew who believed in salvation by works was this: The ignorant Jew went out making a hobby of circumcision and getting every one to submit to the act as stated that they might glory in the flesh, by saying so many were circumcised by my labors. The aposite who knew the truth went out preaching salvation by faith in Christ as the only source of strength whereby they could keep the commandments of God and as they grasped by faith the promises of God by faith they then began to teach the duty of obedience so they might bring forth fruit meat for repentance by an amendment of life. Being converts from idolatry they must give that up. Next being fornicators they must quit that. Next having the habbit of eating things strangled which the Lord positively forbids they must cease that habit, and next the eating of blood which God forbids. If true willingness was manifested in these things they could then be baptized and put on Christ and learn further as they heard Moses read every Sabbath in the synagogue on the Sabbath day. And in this way all other duties could be performed as they learned them. some room for growth in divine knowledge how to be and live a Christian life. Now dear reader do for the sake of your own soul try and see that no apostle ever condemned any thing taught by Moses but condemned the teaching of the ignorant Jew as many of them were in the days when Christ was here.

We are today just in the same condition unless it be that the professed people of God know less today than the ignorant Jew did when Christ came to his own and they received him not. People through pure ignorance today condemn the true teacher now just as they condemned the true teacher then. Let the readers of this paper go forward in Bible knowledge and learn the truth so we can believe and speak the same thing.

"I WILL TURN THEE BACK."

Twice is it spoken of Gog the prince of the land of Magog, he would be turned back. One in Exekiel 38: 4. The other time in 39:2. By learning the teaching of the two chapters it will be seen there are two turnings back and two bringings forth. It is also seen that prior to Gog leading the host against Israel when he will be joined by the kings of the east. The first coming he will be turned back. Then he will come fourth with his army and destroy all with whom he comes in contact. His second coming fourth he is destroyed and left a defeated man on the mountains of Israel. Eze. 39. Let the reader get these points clear.

Thus we see that before he fulfills the prophecy in either chapter he is in war some where else or is not in the right place and must be turned back from that war and when once done then God will put hooks in his jaws and bring him fourth to fulfill the thirty-eight chapter. The question is at what point shall we expect to see him turned back. We reply it looks now very much like Russia was in the act of fulfilling the turn-

ing back prediction.

Russia said when the present war began they were right for once in taking part in this war. The hopes of Russia has for almost centuries been to gain the control of the Dardaneles and become the ruler of the The Allies were defeated in getting this control and now for some cause Russia is practically out of the war, and it is also to be seen clearly that if she drops out she will be promised the outlet she has desired, namely, through the Dardaneles. It would seem that she has been turned back any way either by divine providence or some other cause. We have said from the beginning Russia was not in the place prophecy put her and if the war was to continue and the Allies become victorious then Russia and England would have a settlement on the division of the spoil. For prophecy plainly teaches that England and Russia will yet come to that point of war from some stand point. So it now looks like she was turned back in the fulfillment of prophecy. If this is the cause or if it is not the time will soon come when the vellow peril will be a reality when Russia will lead the kings of the east against the kings of the west.

It is not difficult to see that the western nations are now expending their power and weakening themselves and becoming ready subjects for the kings of the east to do the very work predicted, when the time comes that all things are ready, then the hooks will be placed in the jaws of Russia and she will then fill the prophecy in the fullest sense. She will then accomplish on Christendom what is told in the 38th chapter of Ezekiel's prophecy. Then we shall also look for another turning back prior to the battle of Armageddon which is the battle of the great day of God almighty when all the remaining nations left will federate to destroy the true Remnant. Psalms 83. See our last issue of the paper on Armageddon. This time the hooks in Russia she is brought fourth to be a defeated nation with all associated with her, to fall on the mountains Ezekial 39. The fragments still left then of Israel. will meet the Lord at his coming and be cast into the lake of fire and be destroyed by the brightness of his

coming. This is one of the short cuts to the culmination of the future which now confronts the world.

We will take our chances in the trenches of the Lord's army under the shadow of his wings and covered by a cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night. The second coming forth God will fight as in the days of battle. In the first, nations will destroy each other. In the second coming forth not a soul of the Remnant will be hurt. GET YOUR EYES OPEN AND KEEP THEM OPEN.

The man who cannot now see where we live in the world's history and see the fulfillment of prophecy around him is surely in the dark and to be pitied. The god of this world has closed his eyes lest he should see the Gospel and be saved. Many a person is blind with the god of this world, some through pride, some through covetousness, some through cares of this life, some through creeds, some through selfishness, and many are in such blindness they have become so used to it they don't know they are in such a condition.
