#### "THE SIGN OF THE SON OF MAN"

"The Sign of the Son of Man" is the Rain Bow. In Gen. 31:15, God made a govenant with the human race. He agreed to give them some one that should bruise the serpents head.

# SOCIAL PURITY THE BASIC PRINCIPLE OF A NEW GENESIS, AS SEEN IN PART WITH A MESSAGE

#### The Cloudless Sky of the Scripture or the Messenger

In the first century the Lord called a convention to which half the world responded. Then Eve responded in the audience or gave ear to the devil's "Thou shalt not surely die." Then she slipped off into God's apple orchard and pulled and ate half an apple, and the devil seemed to see it and made her a delegate to Adam, the other half of the world, and she found that Adam liked an apple as well as herself, soon thereafter seeing their mistake, they begin to sew fig leaves together, but God seeing their condition, soon supplied a remedy, a sacrificial remedy,—that of a slain lamb the skin covering of the lamb being a substitute for fig leaves for he is always equal to the emergencies. O read with me Jer. 1st to 51st chapters, where he declares through this minor prophet what he can and will do for man in this life. Then turn with me to Isaiah the greater prophet, and read what God has done, for sometimes we find that God duplicates himself as it were, in order that his disciples may find shorter roads to scriptural truth, viz. Genesis No. 1 of creation and Exodus is No. 2 of God's dealings with men. But we must go back to Isaiah before we overlook it and read the following verses, Isa. 11:6. The wolf shall also dwell with the kid and the calf and the young lion and the fatling together, and a little child shall lead them, and the cow and the bear shall feed: their young ones shall lie down together, and the lion shall eat straw like the ox. And the sucking child shall play on the hole of the asp, and the weaned child shall put his hand on the cockatrice den.

They shall not hurt or destroy in all my holy mountain, for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord as the waters covers the see, "and it shall come to pass in the days the Lord shall set his hand again the second time, to recover the remnant of his people which shall be left" etc. (part of the eleventh verse). Well the last verse quoted belongs to Exodus and that above belongs to Genesis. Whoever heard of "Lost Dominion" people performing feats attributed to these children? So we can readily see that God's account here refers to Genesis where man was given dominion over everything. We will see, presently how the 144,000 of Rev. and the translation of Enoch and family are similar (in scripture the head of the familv stands for the whole family.) See: Noah stands for "translation" of whole family over the flood.

## The REMNANT OF ISRAEL

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Bharosa Ghar Mission Bhagalpur, Gorakhpur Dist. U. P. India Dec. 22,1925.

Dear Ones at Home.

Greetings from us all in Bhagalpur, sire at the close of a year of testings, trials and victories to express our love and gratitude to one and all who have stood by us so faithfully with their prayers and gifts. While our testings have been fierce at times, yet we never forgot that our enemies were heathen and we were trying to win them to Christ. Our worst enemy is a man that I believe will face death for what he believes is right. This character is scarce in India; just think what it would mean to win him to Christ. He gave up idol worship years ago and turned to the Aryas and is a leader here for them. He has faith in us and sends for us to come and pray when any of his family are sick, but is against our turning the people to the "western religion."

We have been going out by turns, camping in the little area we have mapped out to evangelize. (about 1000 villages in a twelve mile circuit) Our first stop was at Lar. Here we met quite a bit of The Brahman suffered quite a bit of persecution. One old man was sent, supposed to be his father, saying he had come to take his son home, that he had been taken to a mission school when young but now he should return to home and Hinduism. As it happened, the Brahman knew he was not his father and saw their scheme.

of arguing, he said, "You must be tired and hungry after so long a journey. I will fix you a little food." While he went inside, the make-believe father disappeared. The Aryas are trying hard but he tells them if they can find a better Guru than the one he is serving, who blesses His disciples and saves them from their sins, he will think about making a change. His wife also stands true. We had some good meetings at nights.

Our next camp was at Bhatpar Hani, our new station. On our way there we came to a river. It reminded us of American pioneer days and was a funny sight to see the oxen swimming with very little but their noses above water, dragging the champany after them, we and the bedding following in a little row-boat. We visited the bazars (market places) in a number of villages in the day and had good crowds and attention, but again proved that the night is the best time to hold meetings in the farming district. So many comes from surrounding villages. Here we had no enemies at night meetings. One man was healed and the next bazar day stood with the preacher and told the people about it, then shouted, "Yishu Masih ki jai. (Glory to Jesus.) Here We stayed two weeks.

We again forded that wonderful river on our way to Majhaule where we had good meetings. One man came to break up the meeting. He told the people that our Guru (teacher) taught us to steal. (He used Matt. 21 2, 3) But the preachers explained it to the people and when they looked for the man he was seen taking long steps down the road.

Our next stop was at Parasia where we went by invitation of a wealthy Brahman land-owner. He searched the country to find something extra for us to eat. We stayed three days, had big crowds at night and good attention. Most of those to whom we are preaching this season have never heard the gospel. Before leaving, this zuminder called his family on the veranda and asked to have prayer. When he said, "Salam", he left three rupees (about one dollar) in our hands, something very unusual in this country.

Our next move was to Sohnag, the place where the King of the lousy sadhus holds his yearly melas and feeds hundreds of these lazy fellows. Most of them are just good-for-nothing fellows, altho there are a few who are honest, seeking after God, but, like our Sadhu, when they have made the rounds and have seen the vile things done in the name of religion, they give up all hope, go into sin of the lowest description, and become leaches among the people. They make them believe they can bring any misfortune upon them if they do not yield to their

request. It was at this place that our Sadhu was arrested, (as mentioned in the tract.) Here we had good crowds and attention. One night over three hundred were listening very attentively when several men jumped up, yelling, "Hurry away, people, it is a sin for us to listen to their religion," At the first call the crowd jumped up in alarm, but when they heard them thru, the crowd yelled back "You go if you wish, we are not following you." Only four left and the crowd gladly sat down again to listen.

After three days there, we returned home to get ready for our special meetings here. We have called all the preachers and their families home for a week or more of prayer as the Lord leads. Several are hungry for baptism, and we are praying and believing that the Lord will meet us at this time. Continue to hold us up in prayer for much depends on you.

## CLIPPINGS CONCERNING THE YELLOW PERIL True Significance of Ruuso-German Treaty

David Lloyd George in Chicago Herald-Examiner, May 9, 1926

LONDON, May 8—The Russo-Germanic treaty is causing much fluster and not a little alarm among the Locarnist nations.

There is no use disguising the fact that it is a formidable document. Its actual phrasing is more ominous than the various disarming communiques, issuing from Berlin before its publication, would have led us to expect.

For instance, there is a sentence at the beginning which dominates the agreement and indicates its spirit. It is the preamble, which declares that the parties are inspired "by the conviction that the interest of the German people and of the people of the Union of Socialist Soviet Republics demands that the co-operation between them shall be continuous and mutually trusting."

This is repeated and emphasized in Article 1 by the agreement to "remain in friendly touch with one another in order to promote an understanding," etc. The words are startling in their significance. No wonder that eyebrows are lifted pretty high and that shoulders are being jerked up violently.

"Germany Turned East"

The foolish maneuvers which brought the league of nations into such contempt at the last meeting of the assembly are directly responsible for the conclusion of this momentous treaty. The negotiations had been dawdling along in leisurely fashion for many months between Moscow and Berlin. But the more eager the former were for the arrangements the more apathetic and indifferent became the latter.

Locarno turned the face of Germany toward the west. Geneva swung it around sharply to the east.

Tchitcherin (Russian minister of foreign affairs) is an able diplomat of the old school. What his views may be on economic questions I cannot tell. He never discusses them. Presumably he is a revolutionary. But on foreign affairs he is a product of the old czarist regime.

He has not only the training, the skill and the subtlety of the old Russian diplomacy, but he has also its traditions. He was not the man to miss the opportunity opened by the follies of Geneva to inflict a diplomatic defeat on the enemies of the soviet government in central and western Europe.

When Germany was naturally sore with the insulting treatment accorded her by the allied powers, Mr. Tchitcherin revived the languishing treaty negotiations and he has scored a great triumph at a time when both Russia and Germany stood sadly in need of it—Russia for economic and Germany for diplomatic reasons.

The official attitude of the great powers toward this new pact is one of studied unconcern.

It is true that "bustling little M. Bones of Czecho-Slovakia," as "the New Statesman" happily calls him, fussed around as usual—this time with an elaborate questionaire which Germany rightly treated as an impertinence. But the foreign ministers of Britain France and Italy have not, in public, so far displayed any undue excitement over this treaty.

There were private explanations given by and perhaps asked of German ambassadors. But they were couched in the tone of the friendly inquirer rather than in that of the anxious party whose interests were deeply affected.

All the same, the European press reveals a deep sense of anxiety, mounting up to alarm, as you reach the countries bordering on Russia.

What accounts for the electric wave of apprehension that passed over Europe when it became known that Russia and Germany were negotiating a fresh treaty? What would be less harmful—nay, what could be more beneficient than this agreement?

#### Europe's Distrust

It is concluded between two powers who were drawn into a terrible war that lasted for years by a quarrel between two other powers in the merits of which they were not directly concerned.

These two powers have now entered into an agreement that henceforth they will preserve complete neutrality if one of them is unfortunately drawn into conflict with a third power.

On the face of it, the agreement is a fresh guarantee of peace. That is the very reason why Europe distrusts it. All these pacts which have in the past provoked war ostentatiously proclaimed that their main purpose was to insure peace among the nations.

The Belgian treaty and the Franco-Russian alliance, the triple alliance between Germany, Austria and Italy and the Anglo-French entente were all declared, at the time, to be so many devices to insure the permanence and security of European peace.

Assurances to that effect were always given to the other nations, but, nevertheless, between them they landed the world in the bloodiest war that ever stained its surface. Hence the disquiet shown throughout Europe over this apparently innocuous transaction concluded at Berlin last Sunday.

The French view is given by M. Gauvain, the well informed writer of the Journal des Debats:

"The soviets are striving to insure the neutrality, if not the effective support, of Germany in the event of war with one of their neighbors.

#### The Soviet Game

"Moreover, they are working to draw the Baltic states out of the sphere of the league of nations and to absorb them into a vast Russo-Germanic group. Such a group would be incompatible with the Locarno pact.

"The soviet is playing its game, but it is for the states menaced by them to guard against their machinations.

"As to Germany, she cannot at the same time enter the league of nations and the Lacarno system and contract with Russia undertakings contrary to the covenant and to the arbitration treaties signed in London on 1st December, 1925.

"She is authorized to promise Moscow her neutrality in case of the aggression of a third party against Russia; she would exclude herself from the league of nations and the Locarno system by reserving for herself judgment as to who would be the aggressor and in trying to depart from the application of the fixed rules of the pact."

Then follow some cryptic sentences threatening to "bring into vigor" a counter alliance against the Russo-German entente.

All this kind of comment has an entertaining side to a cynical observer who is not worried about the consequences to the next generation. France has laboriously organized a group of mutual defense against Germany and Russia.

She has advanced huge sums of money to equip the armies of this alliance. She has quite recently entered into a treaty of neutrality with Turkey just after that provocative power had defied the league of nations.

Poland and Roumania have signed a treaty of mutual defense against Russia. Czecho-Slovakia, Poland, Jugo-Slavia and Roumania have an entente for mutual assistance against Russia and Germany.

Czecho-Slovakia has even reinsured by entering into a pact of neutrality with Russia.

The Polish-Roumanian treaty is stated publicly by its author to have been concluded in order to provide against the contingency "of the league of nations not doing its duty."

#### Troubles and Perils

But when Russia and Germany presume to follow the example of those devotees of the league they are admonished for their transgression against the covenant.

Already there are as many qualifications, reservations and loopholes in and about the sacred clauses 16 and 18 of the covenant as there are around articles 6 and 8 of the ten commandments.

This is no reflection on draughtsmanship of President Wilson. Moses was no more successful. The barbed wire of rules and precepts has never permanently kept the erring human cattle from wandering into forbidden ground. But the rovers ought to deal charitably with those who are tempted by their impunity to follow their example.

The real official view of the British foreign office is given by a well informed diplomatic correspondent who is constantly in touch with that office:

"That however legitimate the text of the agreement, it my lead to severe trouble and perils at a later date.

This is sound enough, but British diplomacy ought to have thought of that before it committed itself to the Franco-Polish intrigue against Germany before and at the Geneva assembly.

The analogy with the Franco-Russian alliances of 1894 is much too close for European statesmanship to see comfortable about the incident.

France had been beaten to the ground by German armies and she was at the mercy of the ruthless legions of the victor. Any disposition on her part to assert her national independence brought upon her, for over twenty years, the threat of renewed invasion.

Then came the alliance with Russia and the whole situation changed. Russia was in need of cash. France stood in need of a powerful friend. Russia was an autocracy, based on the divine right of an emperor. France was a republic, based on universal suffrage.

It was an incongruous partnership, but it was nevertheless real and effective. French republicans cheered frantically in the streets of Paris the despot who shot Russian republicans down in the streets of St. Petersburg. National security was more precious than liberty. Twenty years later Russian imperalist and French Republicans marched together a comrades into the great war. The French premier who negotiated the treaty was also in office during the war which resulted from his diplomatic triumph in 1894.

The treaty with communist Russia is hailed with joy by both the parties of the old German aristocracy and the Communist party. On the other hand, it is distrusted by the German Socialists.

The conservatives and the communists alike are in agreement. The former see in it the opportunity for national revenge; the latter see in it the prospect of future trouble, but the Socialists see in it a fresh danger to human peace. How incalculable and confused are the forces that move nations to their destiny.

The situation can be retrieved at Geneva next September if the Locarnist powers realize the dangers and have the courage to repair their mistakes at the March assembly. Will they do so?

M. Briand has vision and courage. But will he be there? His successor would not have the same personal interest in saving Locarno.

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
