THE ANNIVERSARY OF A GREAT EVENT

Consider again the world of slaves awaiting execution. Instead of carrying out the death sentence and putting the world to death. God placed the world's transgressions on His Son, and His Son died in the place of the world. He gladly took the world's sins and willingly died. "that the world through Him might be saved." John 3:17. Here is the proof that all this has been done; proof taken from the proclamation of liberty.

"Who gave Himself for our sins?" Gal. 1:4. "He hath made Him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him." 2 Cor. 5:21. "Who His own self bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we being dead to sin, should live unto righteousness; by whose stripes ye are healed." 1 Pet. 2:24.

And now that all may realize that Christ bore the sins of the *whole world*, notice these scriptures. "He is the propitiation for our sins; and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the *whole world*. I John 2:2. "Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the *world*." John 1:29. "God was in Christ, reconciling the *world* unto Himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them." 2 Cor. 5:19. "We see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death . . . that He by the grace of God should taste death for *every* man." Heb. 2:9.

And now since God imputed the sins of the whole world to His Son, and His Son bore the sins of the whole world in His own body on the tree, and since He died as a substitute for the whole sinning world it follows that when Christ died the whole sinning world died. And this is what made the Apostle Paul so enthusiastic in proclaiming the Gospel, and this is what he meant when he said: "The love of Christ constraineth us because we thus judge that one died for all, therefore all died." 2 Cor. 5:21 Revised Version.

Now appears the cause for the great rejoicing. Since all the world has died, all the world is freed from sin. "For he that is dead is freed from sin." Rom. 6:7.

Reader does this paragraph from the emancipation proclamation make you glad? That we may appreciate this triumphant truth in greater fullness, let us go to Calvary.

Who is that man staggering beneath that heavy cross? He is the Christ, the only begotten of the Father. Little does He look like the Son of God. His face is so marred. He looks more like a sin-burdened, grief-striken, sorrowing son of man. And this He is. He is wounded for our transgressions; He is bruised for our iniquities; His Father has laid on Him the iniquities of the whole world. Is He, therefore, the substitute for the whole sinning world?

Yes, God is dealing with Him, not as a sinless Son, but as a substitute for a whole sinning world. Let us linger here and watch this terrible transaction. Now they have spiked Him to the cross; the whole world being crucified. Listen: "My God, my God why hast thou forsaken me?"

Why has God forsaken Him? Why has His Father turned His face from Him in this awful hour? Because He is cursed with the sins of an accursed world, and God cannot look with favor on the sins of the world.

Darkness gathers God seems angry. O how terrible sin must be! He is dying; the whole world is dying. Listen: "It is finished." The whole world is dead. One died for all, therefore all died. "He that is dead is freed from sin.

This is the Gospel. This is the glad tidings that is proclaimed by God's emancipation proclamation. It is with this truth that men pass to Pentecost for *power* to proclaim liberty.

The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me; because the Lord hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; . . . to proclaim liberty to the captives." Isa. 61:1.

From the foregoing we learn how the predictions in the Old Testament, that through that "Seed" all nations of the earth should be blessed, were fulfilled in the great blood atonement of the Son of God.

The salvation and the time of which the prophet inqired and searched diligently were being fulfilled. The Baffling Problem of China

(Taken from the Daily Oklahoman)

Behind the drop-curtain of diplomacy the great powers are discussing with ill-concealed anxiety what, on a long view of affairs, is the most grave and thorny question in the field of international relations—what are we going to do about China?

Out of every five persons now living on this planet, one is a Chinaman. This great race—which in intelligence industry, and physical vigor is almost without a rival—presents a spectacle for which history presents no parallel. Potentially the most powerful of all nations, China has become through her actual weakness a greater danger to the world's peace than she would have been if she had been militarist instead of pacifist, aristocratic instead of democratic nationalist instead of localist; if in a word, her deelopment had not, through out the ages, been out of step with that of other nations.

The extreme difficulty of dealing with the China of today is well illustrated by the perplexities which will arise as soon as the proposed conference in Chinese affairs has decided what is to be done about increasing the Chinese import duties, and about abrogating the treaties under which certain foreigners in China are answerable only to their own consular courts.

Neither of these matters involves any problem which will, of necessity, deadlock the conference. As to the former, every argument that can be drawn either from justice or from experience supports the view that an increase is essential. As to the latter, it is clear to everyone who thinks in terms of decades and not in months, that it is only a question of time until consular jurisdiction in China will be relinquished, as it was in Japan in 1899.

The serious trouble will not lie in reaching an agreement. It will begin when the conference is over and the members report to their governments. Whatever agreement is finally adopted, it will have to be embodied in treaties with the powers. Who will sign these treaties on behalf of China, who will be responsible on the part of China for the performance of whatever obligations China assumes?

To these questions it is impossible to find a satisfactory answer, because there is in China no government capable of enforcing its own laws over any considerable portion of the country. We may assume that

the conference will reach a settlement of the points at issue and that some authority in China will sign the treaties in which it is embodied. What we cannot assume is that the treaties will be effective unless their terms are enforced by foreign control.

But any increase of foreign control in China is certain to aggravate the prevailing anti-foreign agitation; and thus the whole situation takes on the form of a vicious circle, which can be broken only by dangerously drastic action, either from within or from without.

THE INSTITUTE OF PACIFIC RELATIONS

The Institute of Pacific Relations, as it was called, assembled in Honolulu for its opening meeting after extensive preparation that had been carried on for two years previous, under the guidance of a Central Preparation Committee in Hawaii, and similar committees in each of the countries bordering upon the Pacific Ocean.

The ultimate object of the institute, stated in a few words, is to keep the Pacific Ocean pacific, in short to avoid armed conflict among the nations of the Pacific; and the leaders of the movement felt that the only way to accomplish this end was to bring together representive men of the Pacific nations, in an unofficial way, to discuss in a frank way from the view point of each national group the problems that are causing conflict of interests. Then, with these statements of facts before them, they hoped that first steps toward ultimate solutions might be agreed upon, which in turn might properly be welcomed as a basis for official action.

The Purview of the Institute

Dr. Ray Lyman Wilbur, President of Leland Stafford Jr. University, was chosen chairman of the Institute. In describing its purview he said, "The genius of this Conference has been conceived not as a diplomatic negotiation, nor as bargaining based on national or group asperations or advantage. It is conceived as a process of thinking and studying together by experts from each nation upon the problems of greatest mutual interest and concern, which arise from the increasing intercourse of the peoples involved."

While all the delegates took an active interest in all the discussions, yet each national group had their particular subjects, which they declared were inseparably connected with their vital existance. Thus the interest of the Japanese group centered around race

MONDAY SABBATH

Bro. George Faucher attempts to prove by a 364 days in a year calendar that Monday is the Sabbath of Jehovah; now this is as impossible as the 365 day, (Roman time) because you may read from Genesis to Rev. as many times as you may and you can only find 12 months in every Bible year, both in the Old, and the new scriptures. equality and immigration. The Chinese group emphasized the importance of a speedy readjustment of violations of Chinese sovereignty, such as extraterritoriality tariff supervisions, etc. The Koreans pleaded for the right of national self-determination, the Philippines for independence, and so on through the groups.

Accomplishments

The meeting adjourned at noon, July 15, and among its accomplishments announced on the closing day were the following:

- 1. It had brought together leaders of nine countries for discussion of some of the most vexing questions in these countries, and had carried on its deliberations in harmory.
- 2. It had outlined the plan for a permanent organization of these, and possibly other sections of the Pacific area, for a continuous interchange of facts and opinions of Pacific countries.
- 3. It had provided for another meeting, probably in 1927, which will be another large gathering of representatives of Pacific countries.
- 4. It had opened the way for the members of the institute present at this first meeting to carry on in their own countries a helpful campaign toward better understanding between the nations of the Pacific.
- 5. It had completed the organization of a permanent institute, the central headquarters of which will remain at Honolulu, as an exchange of information between Pacific countries, and especially between members of the first institute and those who will hereafter be selected.

Now follow the wailing, cursing crowd to Calvary's cross, and see the spiking and the bleeding, the mangling and moaning, the groaning and the weeping.

Wait through the hours that lengthen like ages. Wait till the shadow of death drapes with its sable mantle the soul-piercing scene. Wait till out from the depths of the deepening darkness there comes that startling, piercing, freezing cry from the heart of the dying Redeemer. "My God, my God, why hast Thou forsaken me?"

Wait, sinner, wait for the closing, crowning cry, "It is finished." Behold the clashing clouds, the reeling earth, the rifting rocks, the rending veil, and the bursting graves—and—the bleeding, broken heart.

Thus ended the greatest drama recorded in the histor of the universe. A great God condescended to work as a common laborer in foreign lands and to lay down His life for His enemies, that it might be well with them.

CONCLUSION

Anything that deserves honor ought by all means be respected and honored. If, God, for the great atonement which in our behalf He made at such a cost, deserves any honor, would it not be fitting for us to show God and His Son in every possible way our love and highest respect? Would it not be fair on our part, who at such a cost are redeemed from the bitter bondage of Sin, to honor God by observing the anniversary of that great event?

If we professed Christians do not see this important truth, let us go to the children of this world. From them we can learn many great lessons which we professed Christians ought to take home to our hearts. Look at the Swiss people. With what enthusiasm and zeal they observe the anniversary of their becoming an independent nation. Watch the Americans. What honor and respect they pay to the Fourth of July. These children of the world are always glad when the time of these anniversaries is nearing. Nobody needs to urge them to observe and celebrate. They do that with all their heart. So Christ says: "The children of this world are wiser in their generations than the children of light."

Yet how little and beggarly are the things which the children of this world celebrate in contrast with the grand and universe-stirring events which the professed people of God ought to observe. How little enthusiasm they show for the great acts of God which were done for them upon that memorable Passover day. How unwilling they are even to listen to what one has to say about those great acts. Does not this fact betray a fearful lack of spiritual insight and knowledge and of respect for God and His works?

But I hear some one say that this is all Jewish and passed away with the ceremonial law. Not so fast my friends. The Passover is not a ceremony but a memorial. We can find nothing to indicate that the Lord abolished the memorials of His great and wonderful works. But He commands that His works are to be remembered eternally. We have clear scriptural evidence that the creation Sabbath, the new moon and the Passover will be celebrated by those who enter the new earth throughout the eternal ages. The Gentile Christians who were harboring ungodliness among themselves, were admonished by the Apostle Paul concerning the observance of the Passover as follows: "Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us. Therefore let us keep the feast (holy day, margin) not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth." 1 Cor. 5:7-8.

History proves that the early church observed that solemn day for centuries after Christ, until Rome by law prohibited celebration of the Passover and enforced celebration of Elaster Sunday instead. The same wicked thing was done to the creation Sabbath, and all the world was forced to keep Sunday in the place of God's holy day.

Before the people of God had a temple, God commanded them that every family should observe the Passover in its home. After Christ, it was again observed in every home wherever there were any believers. Christ himslf gave the example; see Luke 22:7-13. As the bread and wine are the emblems representing the body and blood of our Passover, the Lord instituted the use of them upon the original feast day, the 14th day of the first month. Hence it becomes our privilege and duty to observe these ordinances of taking the bread and wine as the Passover, which such ordinance truly is, and not as the Lord's Supper, which it is not; and upon the time which the Lord commands us to keep it, by His word and example, and not at just any time, or as oft as we please. But, "As oft as ye do this, do it in remembrance of Me." And that cannot possibly be oftener than once a year.

Today the world is observing Easter Sunday, thinking that it is the day upon which Christ redeemed the world. But they are deceived. It is not the Passover upon which Christ died. Satan, who was defeated upon that day and lost heaven, does not want anybody to celebrate it.

Now the Roman empire, which ruled the world for many centuries, is noted in the Bible as a power through which the whole world was to be deceived by Satan. Centuries before Rome came into existance the prophet Daniel, in Chapter 7 of his book, gives a description of this power as follows: "Then I would know the truth of the fourth beast, which was diverse from all others, exceeding dreadful, whose teeth were of iron, and his tail of brass; which devoured, broke in pieces, and stamped the residue with his feet." . . . Thus, he said, "the fourth beast shall be the the fourth kingdom upon earth. . . . and shall devour the whole earth, and shall tread it down, and break it in pieces. And the ten horns out of the kingdom are ten kings that shall arise; and another shall rise after them; and he shall be diverse from the first, and he shall subdue three kings. And he shall speak great words against the Most High, and shall wear out the saints of the Most High, and shall think to change times and laws." Dan. 7:19-23-25.

The foregoing is a true picture of the character and work of Rome. She spoke great words against the Most High. During the dark ages she wore out by putting to death over fifty millions of God's people. She ventured to change times and laws of the Most High. German translation. "And shall devour the whole earth, and shall tread it down and deceive it."

Christ says, speaking of the law of God and the prophets: "Think not that I am come to destroy the law and the prophets." Matthew 5:17-19. But Rome said: "I will change it." and did. Rome abolished by law the true Passover, and instituted Easter Sunday in its place, and deceived the world. Up to the sixteenth century the new year was observed at the spring equinox, which time of observance is according to God's word. Then the time was changed to the first day of January. So we see Rome changed God's time and law, and all the world obeys her instead of God.

The true new year begins with the spring equinox, which always fall upon the 21st day of March. Also the beginning of the true month begins with each new moon, according to the time of the Most High. Therefore the first new moon after the spring equinox marks the beginning of the first month of the year.
