Why The Vail of The Temple Was "Rent In Twain"

To be in The Presence of God is the Best Thing in the world. YES, More, it is the Most Exalted Thing in the Universe. Also, to be Cast Out from The Presence of God is the most humiliating thing, and to deliberately leave The Presence of God (as Satan did and as Cain did, and as all do who reject God) is the most wicked thing in the universe. Gen. 4:16. We can't understand it, yet, maybe, but that is how it is.

And, the promise, that "we shall see His Face" (Rev. 22:4) is a thing of Very Great Value. So, we can see that Jesus lost a whole lot when He was cast out from The Presence of God. And the prayer He made concerning it (Jn. 17:5) shows that He realized it, and looked longingly forward to getting it back.

Now, how came it, that Jesus ever got cast out from The Presence of God? He Who (Personally) did nor knew no sin? Well, it was this way. When man sinned, God either had to impute his sin directly to him (which meant death) or else inpute it to someone else. Which also meant death (to that "some one else") but would (thereby) free the man. That "Some one Else", as we all understand, was Jesus. So Jesus had the sins of man imputed to Him. And having sins on Him, necessarily had to leave God's Presence. Whether, or not it is because God, The Father, has such a bitter feeling of hatred against any thing wrong that He will not tolerate it just because He has the power to not do so, which I very much doubt, but it is a fact that sin and righteousness, simply, cannot exist together. Right and wrong cannot exist together. Can you do right and wrong both? You can do some right and you can do some wrong. But can you do absolutely right in all things and do any wrong? At all? How could you? Neither can God. And as "God is a Consuming Fire" (Deut. 4:24) it is plain to be seen that anything, contrary to His Absolute Righteousness, would be entirely Consumed. So, it was that Jesus had to leave. Leave "The Bosom of The Father" where He had dwelt since "before the world was". Jn. 1:18 and 17:5.

Jesus understood this, of course, as it was agreed upon between Him and His Father, as we all have, long ago learned, and also, all the angels, knew of and witnessed it. And, at once a Cordon of angels was thrown between the Throne of God and His Cast out Son. Not that we are to understand that Jesus would try to get back, and that physical force would have to be resorted to, to keep Him away, but rather, that the matter was to be witnessed, by angels, when Jesus left, and witnessed by them all through the period that He was cast out, and finally witnessed by them, with rejoicing, too, as it was in Ps. 24:7-9, predicted, and finally carried out, as told in Eph. 4:8, at its close. For, you know that God never leaves Himself "without a witness." (Act. 14:17).

Now, all this Separation Experience of Jesus, is told us by the type of the actual things in the sanctuary in Heaven, as recorded in The Old Testament.

In Ex. 25:8 and 9, it says "Let them make Me a Sanctuary * * * according to all that I shew thee." "After the Pattern of the Tabernacle", etc. So, the tabernacle here, was made in imitation of The One actually in Heaven. And things done here in imita-

tion of things actually done in Heaven. So as the tabernacle, here, had a separating vail of living angels represented to us by the cherubim wrought in the curtain. Now, what was the Separating Vail in The Tabernacle in Heaven for? Ans. To separate the High Priest, Jesus, from God's immediate presence, there, same as the separating vail, here, separated the priest from the immediate presence of the shekinah of God's glory. For, although Jesus was cast out from God's Immediate Presence, He was not cast off, forever, was not cast far away. He was not separated FAR away, but was separated "Between" so that He could, like the high priest, here, "come near." Jesus was not separated from the Holy Apartment of the Heavenly Sanctuary, but only from the Most Holy. From God's Immediate Pres-The First apartment of The Heavenly Sanence. ctuary was a Holy Place and Jesus, as High Priest and representing man as He bore the sins of man, could remain in and Officiate in, this first apartment and could "come near" to God. But not into God's presence, immediate, during His work of the first apartment, while it lasted. The work in the first apartment here, lasted every day in the year, except the one day of atonement, when Aaron went into the second apartment. So the Work of Jesus as High Priest in The First Apartment of The Sanctuary in Heaven lasted from the time He took it up, at the fall of man, till He came and died on the Cross. Then, when He ascended to Heaven and entered The Most Holy Place, the Second Apartment, "Sat at the Right Hand of God," (Heb. 1:3), was when His work in The First Apartment ended and when His Work of Atonement began in The Second Apartment of The Heav-enly Sanctuary. Then is when "The Vail of the Temple" was "Rent in twain from the top to the bot-Then is when God, the Father, waved aside tom. the Cordon of angels that had, for 4000 years stood as a vail between His Cast-Out Son and Him. Then, was when The Great and Holy Father's Face was wreathed in smiles, in joyful anticipation, of, again, receiving back His Son to His side and bosom. He Who had not only been gone 4000 years but had been to a bad place. Thru a bad Experience. Thru an experience that is not at all due to them that have Life in them selves. Is there joyful preparation? Is there happy anticipation? Are there many, many loving manifestations as The Cast Out and longgone son returns? There was when the prodigal son returned. Look at your own case. Oh! Jimmie is coming home. Oh! Charlie is coming back. Things are done, because of joy. Things here are faint. But THERE, The Living Gates were commanded to "Lift up your heads ye everlasting Doors that the King of GLORY may come in." (Ps. 24:7).

So, that is why The Vail of The Temple was rent in twain, from the top to the bottom. To show that The Cordon of living angels, had stepped aside from around The Throne of God and The Long Cast-Out Son was to find an Open Pathway to "The RIGHT HAND of God." To show that His Humiliating, Painful but Triumphant Ordeal was Accepted of The Father and from that on, He was to be no more castout nor cast down nor humiliated. But Loved and Honored, as was His due.

The type, here, showed a vail, inwrought with figures of angels. The Tabernacle, There, had a

Vail, of living angels, lined up around The Throne of God.

The type here, showed a first apartment, with an officiating High Priest who on the typical day of atonement, entered the second apartment. The tabernacle there had a First Apartment, with The High Priest, Jesus, Who, on The Anti-typical Day of Atonement, at His ascention, entered The Second Apartment of The Heavenly Sanctuary, ("THE RIGHT HAND OF GOD"). When He died, the cordon of holy angels was removed from between Him and God, the Father, and, at that same instant "The vail of the temple", here, "was rent from top to bottom."

Done because the type, here, must correspond, in every particular, to The Heavenly (the antitype), there. Also done that we might see, that the long pictured day of atonement, here, had met its antitype and that The Real life-giving, great, antitypical Day of Atonement, there, had begun. To show, to us, that The Great and Genuine Baptizer, (that John the Baptist told us was to come) (Mat. 3:14) had come and that from then on we might expect that He would "Shed forth this" (as Peter expressed it on the day of Pentecost).

Yes, Jesus endured separation, from a loved one for 4000 years. Some of us think it is severe if we have to endure separation from a loved one for any length of time. I would not speak lightly of this, either. This is a God-given trait, and it is pure and holy. But, brethren, if it really is a God-given thing then it shows that God Himself has the same trait, and can feel it too. And of course much more keen-ly than man is capable of. But Jesus was faithful and bore it without murmuring. He had work to do, and attended to it faithfully. He was not an outcast from heaven. No, He was still the Son of God and was still beloved of God and of the holy angels. These angels knew that He was consenting to this outcast ordeal. They knew that He had voluntarily offered Himself for man's redemption, and while He had to stay away from the Great and Holy Father while He bore the sins of man, still, He could "come near", had His appointed work to do and His place in heaven. He was Michael The Archangel, and as such was commissioned to go and resurrect the body of Moses. He was HIGH PRIEST in the first apart-ment of the Heavenly Sanctuary, "after the Order of Melchizedek." The order of Melchizedek, is the Order of The Heavenly High Priesthood. As the hea-venly sanctuary itself, is a more exalted place than the Mosaic, (being the temple that God pitched and not man). So, The Heavenly High Priesthood is a much more exalted position than the Aaronic.

The Order of Melchizedek, required for its High Priesthood, some one whose length of life is not reckoned by "days". "The evening and the morning was the first day." Some one far more superior than any human. The reckoning of length of Life by "days" refers to man. To the human race. The one required (Jesus) is the only one who ever was a High Priest, whose length of life is not reckoned by "days". There never has been but ONE High Priest connected with the Heavenly Sanctuary in any way. And That is Jesus. A priest is a mediator. And there is, (and never has been) but "one Mediator, between God and men, the man Christ Jesus." (1 Tim. 2:5). As soon as man fell, the mediatorial work of Jesus began. Angels did the work of the common priesthood, and Jesus as High Priest awaited His time to officiate in the Second Apartment, but was High Priest "after The Order of Melchizedek", all along thru the 4000 years. And He had it made permanent when He proved successful at the Cross and sat down at the Right Hand of God." He had to wait 4000 years that the "Due Time", should come. "In Due Time Christ died for the ungodly." Rem. 5:6.

Time Christ died for the ungodly." Rem. 5:6. That He was High Priest, after "The Order of Melchizedek", we know by the fact that He, alone, can answer the description of Melchizedek, which is given in the 7th Chapter of Hebrews. Jesus as The Son of God, is without "Beginning of days" ("even-ings and mornings") and He is, (and always was) "without end of Life." Jesus, as men reckon, from the stand point of the human race, is "without father or mother. Did not come from a married couple of the human race. Jesus, as men reckon "descent", was "without descent." (Some translators say "pedi-gree, some say genealogy.) That is, could not trace His human descent from any married father and mother, and also did not have any children of His own, according to the flesh. Again, Jesus is the only "King of Righteousness," that ever was or ever will king of Righteousness, that ever was of ever wind be. No human can claim that title nor an angel. Jesus is The only "King of Peace." Called "King of Salem" at that time. Jesus demonstrated that. By a Living Experience, to be "The King of Peace, or, as we lovingly know Him nowadays, "PRINCE of Peace. Jesus, during the waiting time of the 4000 years, from the fall to the Grees was High Prisest. And the Order the fall to the Cross, was High Priest. And the Order was "the Order of Melchizedek." So it was entirely proper for Him to meet Abraham, returning, and we see that Abraham recognized Him as "The Priest of the Most High God." And, there being, at that time no Mosaical tabernacle service, nor Levitical priesthood to collect it, Abraham showed that he was posted, and was faithful and did the proper thing and gave to God His rightfully reserved part, the tenth.

So we can see that this mysterious sounding explanation and description in Heb. 7 is all as plain as day, that it was Jesus Who, being the One Mediator, the only Antitypical High Priest, could and did act under the name of Melchizedek, to meet Abraham, when occasion made it proper to do so. He acted as one of three angels when He came to Abraham, at the time Sodom was burned. He acted as Michael when He came to resurrect Moses. He acted as "Captain of the Lord's Hosts" when He appeared before Joshua. (Josh. 5:14). And He acted as Melchizedeck, Priest of the Most High God when He met Abraham. (Gen. 14:18).

When the word, "Melchizedek", is said to mean "King of Peace", it means that Jesus, at the fall, started out on a God-given plan to bring about Peace. "Peace" is what there was before Adam sinned. And "Peace" must be restored. Either that or the whole scheme of creation was a failure and entirely lost.

It took 4000 years to do it, for the reason that man must have a chance to see what he had done, must be taught, have a chance to choose and so on.

But "Peace" was what Jesus started out to restore. That is why He was called, right in the start, "King of Peace". Or in the word, then used "Melchizedek."

The opposite of the word peace is enmity. So, this thought is exactly what God had in mind (in Gen. 3:15) when He said to the serpent, I will put enmity between thee and "My people" (the woman). As much as to say to satan, you think you have won. You have succeeded in starting the opposite of peace, some, among the human race. But I am going to send My Son. I am going to call Him "King of Peace", Melchizedek, at the very start. You can be the prince of evil and enmity and war and trouble, if you want to. But I am going to send My "King of Peace", and the enmity that you have started, will be turned against you. "I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed (all that choose to do so as you have done) and the woman's seed, (those who choose to believe and follow Me). And I am going to do it by My "Melchizedek", My "King of Peace." I will admit that you will succeed in "bruising His heel", but the out come of it will be that He "will bruise thy head."

That is the substance of that precious prophesy there in Gen. 3:15. So from all this, we can see, what a mighty and blessed work Jesus, right at once, started out on and why He was called "Melchizedek". And great and mighty praises be to God Most High, He succeeded. And won His title "Priest forever, after the order of King of Peace." And thruout eternity we, who are saved will know Him as He, who was the one by whom all who are saved did come to the Father and by whom all will always be kept in a world without end. Which means the New Earth.

Here in this world we are invited to "Consider how great this man was to whom even the patriarch, Abraham, gave the tenth of the spoils. (Heb. 7:4). That is a verse in the Bible that draws a comparison between the "great man" of Paul, and also all the rest of the Jews, and some one else that Paul acknowledges was far greater than Abraham. Abraham would not have been led nor allowed by the Lord to have given up any of those spoils to any man. There was no Levitical arrangements then, and so it was the same heavenly visiting arrangement that Abraham was accustomed to and informed about and ready always to recognize, namely a visit from the Lord, in the person of His Son, then "Melchizedek, the Priest of the Most High God." So, we are invited to "consider how great this man was", this man Jesus. All right, let us do that. Now Lord, how great a man was this man? And the Lord's answer, in the 6th verse and onward, is, this Man did not and does not reckon His descent from man. Well Lord, if He does not count His descent from man, what does that mean? How does that show that He was great? And again the Lord's answer is that it shows that He must have been My Son. For, you know that there is no other way to get men only by the begetting of men or the "Only Begotten Son of God."

So we can see that any verse or any view we take we are brought to the sound, inevitable, fair and honest conclusion that "Melchizedek" was Jesus. Before the coming of the Cross. And that since then, that He is "Melchizedek" still. Or to put it in other words, He is Jesus made a High Priest FOREVER, after the same order He was in when He was only "Melchizedek".

And we know that that Title He will always bear. Then in the 7th verse it tells us that Abraham (the less) was "blessed of the better", (meaning Jesus). For there was at that time no greater man, in God's sight, than Abraham. God having given him to be the "Heir of the world" (Rom. 4:13) and the father

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of all them that believe. (Rom. 4:11). So, you see, as I do, that The One that Abraham met and payed tithes to was The Son of God, Jesus, Whom Abraham knew and recognized as the collector of tithes in his day.

Zionist Move is Failure, Says Paper.

LONDON-The Daily Express, avowedly hostile to British commitments to zionism in Palestine, featured Friday what it represented to be a complete failure of the zionist movement. The paper said, "What may be the final scenes

in the tragedy of a still-born nation now are being enacted.'

It cites figures from the Palestine administration report for the three months ending September 30 and other data intended to show that there is general commercial and financial stagnation, widespread unemployment, falling revenue and internal strife.

Among other things the paper said: "Perhaps the darkest fact of the situation is the virtual cessa-tion of financial relief from zionist sources outside of Palestine. The main stream from the United States appears to have dried up and it is reported that failure of remittances from that quarter has been so complete that the zionist organization found itself compelled at the end of November to cease the weekly doles which it had been paying to unem-ployed. Unless immediate aid is forthcoming a large section of the Palestine Jews will be on the verge of starvation."

When to Keep the Passover

March 20, 1928, 3:45 P. M., (Eastern Standard Time), is the Spring Equinox. The next day, March 21, 3:29 P. M., is the New Moon. This new moon is the Beginning of the year to God's people. (All those who obey God and keep His Commandments, His Statutes and His Laws). This is the "First month of the year to us." (Ex. 12:2). On the FOURTEENTH Day of the First Month, is when they killed their passover, and that same night ate the passover. So Jesus was killed on The Fourteenth Day of the First Month. For the Antitype, AL-WAYS, fulfills, in perfect detail, the type that is given. So, the fourteenth day of this first month is when we are to eat the passover. "At even," (which is, (Bible Time) the beginning of the 15th). For in partaking of the (Bread and Wine), "Lord's Supper". (I Cor. 11:20), we are keeping The Ordinance of the passover." Ex. 12:14). We cannot, now kill a lamb, because "The Lamb of God" has been killed, for us. "Christ our passover is sacrificed for us," (I Cor. 5:7). But we are required to observe the Ordinance, just as truly.

Jesus did not eat the passover with the disciples. He COULD NOT. For The Passover was not to be eaten until after it was killed. In Lu. 22:15 it does not teach that He WAS EATING it with them. It only expresses that He had a hearty desire to do so, but (next verse), says that He WOULD NOT ANY MORE DO SO "till the Kingdom of God" gets here. (Which will be in the coming "Wilderness" experience). But Jesus, "on the night that He was betrayed," (I Cor. 11:23). "Took Bread," etc. and ate supper with them and instituted "The Lord's Supper," which was to serve as the memorial of The Passover in place of killing a lamb. But it is to be eaten as The Passover Ordinance, in Remembrance of Him. And, as the Passover was eaten on the night following the killing on the fourteenth, (really the beginning of the fifteenth began), (Bible Time). We are to eat "The Lord's Supper," (of Bread and Wine), AFTER SUNDOWN on the night of Tuesday, April 3, 1928. Which, (Bible Time), is the beginning of the fifteenth day of the first month.

Which Shall Be Stronger? Love For God, or Love For "Loved Ones?"

There are a lot of good things that can be said on this interesting and serious subject. One thing, it is certainly Sweet and Blessed when we do have loved ones (sisters, brothers, children, wife or parents) to see that they too are giving their hearts daily to Jesus and are being led By The Lord. And too it does not follow that because any of them (or all) do not, that we are to entertain any feeling of bitterness or strife or accusation concerning them. No they are all souls for whom Jesus died and like it says (in I Cor. 7:16), "For what knoweth thou * * * Whether thou shalt save them."

So even if we see and decide that we love God way, way better, and deeper and more tenderly than we do them, yet we are to do as Jesus has done for all, do for them, and leave results with God.

You know that there are two kinds, or degrees or phases of Love. Not as I know how to name them but as The Bible tells it. "God is Love." But His Love is expressed (or named) in two different ways. 1st "God SO loved the World" that He died for them (by His Son Jesus), and 2nd "This is my WELL BE-LOVED SON." So there are two kinds of Love, as expressed by The Lord Himself, and of course for us, "SO" Beloved, and "WELL Beloved."

And it is plainly evident, when we stop to consider that God Himself cannot love a persistent sinner and unbeliver like He can (and does) a believing and penitent sinner (No matter how great his sins). God cannot have a tender affection for the one like He can for the second. Neither ought WE. And if we do let ourselves continue to entertain such in our hearts and minds, saying (as people have said) "if my beloved ones cannot be there I do not want to be there Myself," or even if we do not constantly remember and cultivate the thought that GOD is "The One Altogether Lovely." (God and Jesus), and our associates here (while we love them) ARE NOT. We simply sin that's all and will be seen to have made a CHOICE. A choice which is REALLY AGAINST GOD, and which, of course, will (in the end), cast us out.

So I can see that there is a feature of danger in this setting our hearts on loved ones here below. And a strong necessity to cultivate against it. Or to put it this way, Cultivate tender love for God which of itself will enable us to distinguish and admire the Beautiful strength of difference between the two.

Naturally, you know, (in this life) we don't love God. It is a plant that has to be SET OUT (planted) in our heart garden by the Great Gardener, Himself (Jesus). And, also, has to be cultivated By Him, as well.

And, you see, (let us be here reminded) a gardner cannot cultivate a garden unless he be let in to the garden). Or (to put it plainly and practically), Jesus cannot set out the Plant of love for Him in our hearts unless He is let in to our hearts to start with, (That's conversion, which all understand about). Also He cannot daily water and cultivate

that Very Valuable Plant unless He is daily let in to our heart.

WE OWN our heart. The possession of it is fully given to us. To choose freely what shall be done with it and what shall occupy it. Whether it shall be over-run with weeds, or be a beautiful ornament to the landscape. And to get the latter effect we must have the Competent, Skilled Gardener (Jesus).

That is why it is so imperative that every morning (on waking) every single and consecutive morn-ing of our lives the first thing when we wake, we "Hear the Voice" of this Gardener, and "open the door" of the garden.

I remember, distinctly when over 30 years ago I made up my mind I would not only profess christ-ianity but would actually live it, I realized right away that I did not love God. I feared and wanted to serve Him, but that I did not actually love Him. That my whole tendency was to love other things. And I came to the point where I told Him I did not love Him. Then I began to pray "Give me to love Thee so I will want to serve Thee. Of course He answered it. That is the kind of prayer He is look-ing for to answer. And at first I, (not knowing about "Hearing His Voice," every morning I would see a strong tendency every day to not want to let myself love Him. But when I did see that and began to prac-tice it, (Namely "Hear His Voice" every morning on waking and open my heart to Him anew, (get con-verted anew you see). I found that He was actually present in my heart, and being present all the "strong tendency" (above mentioned) lost its strength and the strength of my love for Him grew and grew and grew. "Grew in Grace," you see, "and in the knowl-edge of My Lord and Savior Jesus Christ." (II Pet. 3:18)

Oh! To Love God, is a Tip Top Thing. It is the only way we can acceptably serve Him, or become steadfast in serving Him and "endure to the end" and be saved at last. And the way to get to love Him is to daily have Him dwelling in our herats "By Faith." Then we will indeed "Be ROOTED and GROUNDED in LOVE." (Eph. 3:17).
