To be notified ahead of a coming event is a thing value. Aviation is glad and is benefited if the bad eather ahead is predicted for them.

Navigation is helped and saved from danger, if told of icebergs or violent storms in the way.

Men develop systems to provide for these very hings. And the plan and wisdom is of God. It is it's way, and Loving Kindness so to do. "Surely ord God will do nothing but He revealeth His into His servants the prophets." (Amos 3:7).

but the prediction can aliways be appreciated and it gives confidence and a feeling of safety and of respect if we know we have a reliable and faithful predictor.

Now to find out that God is that very kind is worth everything to us. God wants us to know that He is. He doesn't want us to drift along with no idea, thought, nor knowledge that He is so faithful to and careful of His people, that He will not let events of importance nor danger nor love come upon them without notifying them ahead.

The system of blowing of trumpets in the days of the Kingdom of and the encampments of Israel was a repeated demonstration of God's disposition in this matter. Some occasions stirring and some ordinary. But all showing, conclusively, that God always NO-TIFIES.

If the leaders were to be gathered together, then a certain trumpet was blown. If the whole congregation, another certain trumpet If the camp was move forward a trumpet was blown. If they were go to war, a trumpet. All moves and concerted a ions and interests were given due notice.

"Is the Lord's Hand shortened that it cannot (or will not) save?" Or, "Is His ear heavy that He cannot (or will not) hear?" (Is. 59:1). Do not His eyes still "Run to and fro through-out the whole earth to show Himself strong in the behalf of them whose heart is perfect toward Him?

Is He not "the same, yesterday, today and tomorrow?" Surely all this can be said of Him. Therefore we can confidently and gladly look forward to be NOTIFIED of all coming, important events.

The practical, physical system of the blowing of the trumpets, having (for whatever reason) ceased is no sign that God has ceased to notify. We are a scattered people. But God still notifies through "His servants, the prophets. (Amos 3:7). If we do not look these notifications up and thereby be notified, it is our own fault. For all these things are written for our admonition upon whom the ends of the world are come." (I Cor. 10:11).

So we can see that God is a faithful NOTIFIER. And He wants us to remember this.

The only way that the human race (changing generation as it constantly does) can be made to remember a thing is to establish a memorial. Very likely the Independence days of a nation here earth would have (by this time) been (longotten if there had not been estable) days (4th of July, and the likely).

The creation of long, long establi

extends even to giving due notice of all coming important events, (The Second Appearing of Jesus and all), He has given us a certain Sabbath to observe.

A holy Sabbath Day in which we are to lay aside our work and our play (pleasure) and remember the Blowing of Trumpets (in the past) and contemplate

all notifications of Coming events as well.

And so He lovingly says in Numbers (10 Chap. 9th verse) "If ye go to war," blow an alarm with trumpets and ye shall be remembered before the

Lord your God and ye shall be saved from your enemies." And (10th verse) "In the day of your gladness" ye shall blow with trumpets that they may be for a memorial before your God."

And in Leviticus (23:24) is the Lord's plain com-

mand to keep this Memorial-Day Sabbath.

"In the seventh month in the first Day of the Month shall ye have a Sabbath." "A memorial of blowing of trumpets." "An Holy convocation." "Ye shall do no servile work therein." (Lev. 23:24-25).

## The Day of Atonement

(LEV. 23:27-32) COMING THIS YEAR, OCTOBER 11, 1929. BEGINNING AT SUNDOWN, THURSDAY NIGHT, AND LASTING ALL DAY FRIDAY, OCTOBER 11, 1929

"Atonement" (as probably all understand) means At-One-Ment. At one with some other, with whom we may have been differing. Especially (as is the lamentable case with all the human race) out and separated from God, the Good Creator.

But there is another (or extended) meaning. The suffix "ment" stands for mind. "The word "Mental" means of or pertaining to the mind. So we can see

that "At-One-Ment" can mean at-one-mind.
And this is truly, indeed, the meaning and value of the Atonement that Jesus (the Saviour) has made for man. Made possible for all (and glad salvation for all who accept it). At-One-Mind with God (The Father) with Whom (at birth) we naturally are

found to be at outs. Of an entirely contrary MIND.

"To be carnally (fleshly) MINDED is death,"
"but to have the mind of God is Life." Rom. 8:6)

Two minds, we see, but separated.

So we are invited and exhorted to "Let this mind be in us which was also in Christ Jesus." (Phil. 2:5). That of course, was God's mind. So that invitation is to be of One-Mind with God. At-One-Mind (At-One-Ment) or Atonement.

Again God says (in Rom 12:2) "Be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind." That is, get your MIND changed, so that it will think and desire like God's mind thinks and desire and then, surely, we will be At-One-Mind with God. At-One-Ment, or as the word we use "Atonement."

Now, Jesus is the blessed Volunteer that undertook to bring this Atonement about. He was Eminently successful, but the steps taken were, First to make it possible for the change in man's MIND to be made.

Being that man's (carnal) mind meant death to the man, provision must be made whereby the creaould be justified in letting a breaker of His Holy reator can be so justified, provided He, to die in the transgressor's place. in the transgressor's place...

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think the matter all over and accept or reject as He might choose.

This Atonement (now begun) was for all and made things possible for all. But cannot (of course) function where it is rejected. So those who do reject it, will have to bear their iniquity and die in their sins, (being a matter of their own free choice).

But (Glad to proclaim the Blessed News!) those who do not reject it, but with a glad and willing heart accept it, now come under the loving and mighty power that can and will and does take their naturally carnal mind and actually CHANGE it. Actually and positively RENEW it. So that it actually ally ceases to do, speak or think as it did (carnally and begins to do, speak and think as God's mind do Do, Speak, and Think. Or in the words of our su ject becomes At-One-Mind with God. An At-One Ment brought about. (The Atonement).

Blessed Work! Praise God, the Lord! Now the One Who did this (made this Atonement) as already noted, is Jesus. First step, made it possible (by His Death) second step (man's part) to accept it, and third (and continuous) step, to have it kept up to final salvation. Jesus has done the first step, the sands take the second step (accept it) but many t sands fail on the third step (the continuous ste because they attempt to take this daily (this step) themselves, instead of letting Jesus carry them. "He shall feed His flock herd and shall carry the lambs in His Bosom. (Is. 40:11).

There are two phases to the Christian life. First, get converted (which can be instantaneous) and second, keep it up (which is a life-long, drawn-out affair).

The Bible says we are "Saved BY HIS LIFE" (Rom. 5:10). "We are Reconciled" (Atonement made, you see) "by His death". And that is dearly and beautifully true. His death made the Atonement possible (reconciled us). But that only starts the matter. And where men fail is that they attempt to keep the good work up to final salvation of themselves. But that is literally, physically, spiritually and in every way ABSOLUTELY IMPOS-SIBLE. Man NEVER in this life, nor eternity, can do right, and finally be saved, by trying. We are VED by His LIFE, not by ours, nor by anything can do in this life of ours.

Now if we are to experience (successfully, to

final salvation) this continuous, third step, it must be done by His Life. And His life must be, not His life that we read he lived, even as our example, 1900 years ago. No. But it must be His Life that He lives IN US today.

"Nevertheless I live, yet Not I, but Christ that liveth in me." (Gal. 2:20). Jesus has got to live IN US. Got to "Dwell in our hearts (By Faith) (Eph.

3:17).

And that has to be done by "Hearing His Voice" at the beginning of each new day and "opening the door" of our hearts to Him for that day. "Behold, I stand" (every morning) "at the door and knock," "If any man hear my voice and open the door I will come in." (Rev. 3:20).

This way and this way only, can we have Jesus live in us. Have His Life IN US. "Be saved by His Have this continuous third step of the Atone-

ment deal carried out to final salvation.

This way, and this way only will men cease to fail in keeping up, unabated and unbroken, the Christian life, and be saved in the Kingdom of God at last even though Atonement is made for them and even though they do with all their intentions accept this Atonement.

So these two phases of the Christian life (how different they are! as we stop to contemplate them!) are with u and both must be experienced. Both are of equal value. But one seems so much more easy than the other. Accepting the Atonement (becoming reconciled) by His death (all done so quickly) seems easy as compared with the life-long struggle that follows in keeping it up.

But dear and struggling soul, it NEED NOT be a struggle at all if by "Hearing" every morning the voice of Jesus and "opening the door" we have "His

Life" in us.

That makes one phase, although longer drawn out, as easy as the other. Jesus in both cases doing the work Himself. Not we. Dying in our stead to make the atonement possible, and living in our hearts "by Faith" to keep the work of the atonement up to the final salvation in the Kingdom of God. Which will surely be done if man will only quit trying to do right himself and daily let Jesus into his heart to live in and do the right in him.

Now this wonderful and blessed work started and going on. Started and made possible and daily kept up by Jesus, the Saviour, this At-One-Ment is a thing of very great, precious and inestimable value to man. Without it we are lost. With it functioning, with all its love and power, we become sharers in Eternal Life and all the blessed things "eye hath not

seen" prepared for them who love Him.

It is a thing that never, never should be forgot-God wants it that way. God wants men to remember the precious, life-giving thing, He has given us in this Atonement work.

But men cannot (some will not) remember it. God knows this and kindly and lovingly has established for us a memorial day, that by keeping which

we may remember what He has done for us.

He says (in Lev. 23:27-32) "On the 10th day of the 7th-month" (Beginning sundown, Thursday night October 10, 1929 and lasting all day Friday, October 11, 1929, this year) "There shall be a day of Atonement." He says further, it is to be "A Holy convention." We are to do no work duirng it. We are

afflict our souls, for it is a day of Atonement. "To make an atonement for us before the Lord, our God.'

Now about the "afflicting of our souls." This is imperative from God (the Father) who gave His Son in this work for us.

It is indeed imperative and carries a plain warning. A warning that no one who loves and looks forward with desire to the things ahead can afford to and will not ignore. Namely "whatsoever soul it be that shall not be afflicted in that same day, shall be cut off, from among his people." (Le. 23:29). That is serious, so let us remember and observe it.

Now what it is to afflict and why we should afflict are necessary questions to come up and be in-

telligently answered, in this connection.

Heathen people and some benighted Christian professors (who do penance) seem to have caught the idea and developed some strong methods of do-ing some afflicting. For instance in India, a man will sit for weeks on a pole (uncomfortable, tiresome, a strain. A real physical affliction we can see). Another will lay on a bed of spikes. Another will lie down and roll over for miles until he reaches the Ganges River. They do all those things to punish, (afflict) themselves for being sinful, and to appease their God who, they conclude, is angry at them for

But all that is not why God asks us to afflict our souls on this Day of Atonement, which we will direct-

ly see.

But "afflicting" is something that hurts. Either, physically or mentally or the love of the heart.

This can be as the Lord shall lead each individual at the time. But should, of course, be some af-fliction as taught in the Scriptures, rather than some glaring and public thing as above illustrated.

The Scriptures do not directly state (along with the commandment itself) what "afflicting" is to be. But cases shown in the Bible where people of God in times of distress and impending danger did things to humble and belittle themselves before God. Take the case of Nineveh, which city Jonan was sent to warn. What did they do? First they believed God's warning. Then the King, himself, descended from his throne, laid his kingly robe from him, covered himself with sack cloth and sat in ashes. And so did the people. A fast was proclaimed for all the people and all the beasts as well.

In the time of Queen Esther, when the Jews were about to be slain, she had her people, herself and her servants all fast. and humble themselves in other ways. These things are Bible examples and were accepted and can be accepted of God. But we should not conjure up some wierd, fantastic or freak thing to attract public attention. For all these things, that are acceptable unto God, are done, as much as possible, in secret before God alone. Especially did sus give instances to His disciples, that fasted they should avoid all they

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But the reasons why we should afflict our souls on this Atonement Day as God commands are very plain and evident. And if I were to express a personal opinion I should say that I think it would be a shame. A very Burning Shame, and entirely due the man to be "cut off from among God's people," who would pass along through life, knowing that Jesus of Nazareth afflicted His Holy Soul (even unto death) for Him, and then ignore God's reasonable and kindly request that, at least, one day in each year he consent to do something to afflict his own soul. While Jesus of Nazareth was the Son of God, He was also a man like us. Capable, of like passions, desires, and sensations same as we are. A thing that hurts us, also hurt Him. Mentally, spirit-ually, physically or however. And, for my part, I think if He did all His sacrificing and afflicting for me (which He certainly did) it is asking little enough of me if I do all that God, the Holy Loving Father, asks of the human race as a recognition of what His inoffensive and Well-Beloved Son has done for us.

So come on. Let us be fair and square and obey God in this matter. It will show that we recognize a favor and are willing to give every man a square deal. Even the man Christ Jesus.

The Lord says (Mal. 4:4) "Remember ve the Law of Moses, My servant, which I commanded unto him in Horeb, for all Israel, with the Statutes and Judgments." The laws of God (all of them) are to be observed.

These memorial Sabbaths (Blowing of Trumpets" "Day of Atonement" "Feast of Tabernacles" and all) are stated to be Statutes." And we are commanded to "remember His Statutes." Lev. 23:4-44 wes a list including those taking place in the spring.

### The Book of the Law

(Continued)

HEBREWS SEVENTH CHAPTER

We give below a synopsis of this chapter that the reader may better see when the law was changed spoken of by Paul.

Verse 1: Melchisedec blessed Abraham.

Verse 2: Abraham pays a tenth of the spoil to Melchisedec as Priest.

Verse 3: Melchisedec is like unto the Son of God Verse 4: The greatness of Melchisedec so that

even Abraham honored him.

Verse 5: Those who are the sons of Levi who received the office of the priesthood are commanded to take tithe of the people according to the law.

Verse 6: But Melchisedec received tithe from Abraham and blessed Abraham who had the promise. Verse 7: Hence the less Abraham is blessed of

the greater.

Verse 8: Here men who die receive tithe but there he receiveth them from Abraham and never

Verse 9: I may so say that Levi also who ceived tithe Paid tithe in Abraham.

Verse 10: For Levi was Yet in the loins of Abra-

Verse 11: If therefore perfection was in the Levitical Priesthood, for under it the people received the law, what further need was there of another Priesthood after the order of Melchisedec and not be called after the order of Aaron?

This verse reveals the trouble. First the opposers of Paul looked for perfection and all that was necessary through the Levitical Priesthood, and yet, they admitted there should be another of whom the Levitical was but representative. So Paul sifts their

argument.

Verse 12: The Priesthood being changed there was made of necessity a change also of the law.

Question: When was the priesthood changed and to whom? We reply when the Aaronic Priest-hood was introduced at Sinai. Tithe was from that on paid to the Leivtical and not direct to the lelchisedec.

There was no change of Priesthood when Christ

came for the Melchisedec had always existed, and always will, as long as there is need of Christ being priest. What law was changed to effect the payment of tithe? We reply that Abraham kept God's commandment and laws. Gen. 26:5 and at the time the law governing Abraham required the tithe to be paid direct to Melchisedec. But when the Aronic Priesthood was instituted then that law was changed and tithe paid to Levitical Priesthood. Having no reference to any change of law or Priesthood when Christ was here.

Verses 18 and 19: The conclusion of the argument is reached thus: There is verily a disannuling of the commandment going before for the weakness and unprofitableness thereof. For the law given at Sinai made nothing perfect as they supposed it did point to the true Priesthood which had always existed and thus brought in a better hope. It was good for that, but perfection was not to be obtained thru the Levitical Priesthood. Paul continues in verses following showing that the Melchisedec Priesthood was based on the oath of God and the Aronic was made without an oath. This oath was in the Abrahamic covenant which was confirmed before of God in Christ. Gal. 3:17. Verse 28 says the oath of God is still good since the law was given at Sinai. And we say it is good yet.

Thus this chapter which is so much relied on to teach that the law was changed when Christ came, teaches no such doctrine but directly to the opposite. When will men cease accepting things from others without careful thought for themselves.

We again say there is not one text when carefully examined teaches that any part of the law written by Moses was changed or abolished when Christ came and we challenge any man to take the scriptures we have used and show that our teaching of the same is not the truth.

#### "THE LAW AND THE PROPHETS WERE UNTIL JOHN'

Said Christ, "From the days of John the Baptist until now the Kingdom of Heaven suffereth vio-lence and the violent take it by force." "For all the Prophets and the law prophecied until John, and if ye will receive it, this is Elias which was to come." Matt. 11:12-14.

Luke says, as he records the words of Christ, "the law and the Prophets were until John, since that time the Kingdom of God is preached anl all men press-eth in to it," "and it is easier for Heaven and earth to pass than for one tittle of the law to fail." Luke 16:16-17.

What are the facts taught by the above scripture? We reply that the law and the prophets were taught until John, since when and especially, during the Ministry of Christ, the personal Christ was preached. John was a fore-runner of Christ, and then Christ appeared personally, and that was the Theme and he being the King of Heaven that preaching of the personal Christ was the preaching of the Kingdom of Heaven of which the law and the prophets bore testimony. Third this preaching aroused the people and Jesus suffered violence and the violent took him by force and crucified him. Following this Christ said it was easier for heaven and earth to fail than for one tittle of the law to fail." Why did he say this? We reply it was to emphasize the

law in its proper place. Adam had violated the law of God and hence death passed upon all men. This caused the death of the Son of God. So he said it was easier to give up heaven and earth or anything in it rather than remove the obligation of the law. This we hold to be the true idea of the texa so in the place of it releasing any being from the obligation of the law it ought to teach us the truth, namely that it is easier for heaven and earth to fail even to the giving of the Son of God for our sins than to remove any obligation of the law upon any being. The Law and the Prophets are still to be preached.

All this must cease before ever Jesus can change us to immortality ready for the New Earth, promised land. We must be purged. We must be "purified". We must be "made white." The way all this is done is 40 years under the leading, and teaching and cleansing of Jesus in the Kingdom of God, entirely separated from association with the world and its ways. Come! Let's go! Satan knows all about the teaching of the

scriptures concerning how Jesus is to gather His people together and "set up" His Kingdom on this earth in these last days. Indeed he does, and many are the snares he sets to get us going wrong. The 40 years of the Kingdom, comes, is "set up" God's elect "gathered," "purified," "resurrected," "changed" to immortality and "translated" to Heaven all by the end of the 6000 years. So that the 7th 1000 year period is a rest for them (of a 1000 years) in Heaven. The wicked all slain and dead (till their resurrection at the close of the 7th 1000 year period).

So in this 7th 1000 years it is impossible to have that period serve as a bright condition of things. With Jesus spending His time here purifying His people and getting them ready to be translated to Heaven. Which (like the type back there) is to be

done in 40 years instead of 1000.

And this 40 years experience all has to take place inside the 6000 years. For the reason that the 7th 1000 years is the Day of the Lord. And is an entirely separate affair from the 6000 years. The 6000 years is the great antitype WEEK OF GOD. (For His salvation work you see). And when that 6000 years week of salvation is done, God ceases to work at salvation any longer (all who will, having consented and been gathered in) (promptly on time too at the close of HIS WEEK) and then His great, antitypical Sabbath begins. (1000 years long, same as any of the

individual days of His 6000 year week).

So this 7th 1000 year (Day of the Lord) is an entirely separate and separated period from any of the six 1000 year Days. Therefore this gathering and building up His Kingdom (of Dan. 2:44) (for 40 years) has all got to be and is done inside the last 1000 year days of the 6000.

So the chronology (as given in the Bible) is a very useful and God-given thing to us. And that chronology shows that from 1928 to the end of the 6000 years (when Jesus finally takes His people, His "established", "built up", "purified", "resurrected" and "changed" (to immortality) Kingdom (His Church) to Heaven to stay during that 7th 1000 year period of DARKNESS and GLOOMINESS and DESOLATION of this earth) is yet 68 years.

So we see that we (yet) have the sufficient time (of 40 years) for the "establishing" "building up" and going to perfection of this predicted and promised KINGDOM OF GOD. We have it and 28 years over, to boot.

And we know that the people are constructing highways through desert places. Whether or not this "highway" will be one constructed by the worldly people or whether God's people, themselves, will construct it after they get there, is not revealed. But there will be a highway there. A traveled road. An open and free entrance for God's people. It will not remain a chaotic place for God is going to "PLANT" all of His people this time. (Jer. 24:6). To plant a thing means to select a location and put that thing right there with the expectation that thing will stay right there in that location and GROW.

That is exactly what is going to be done with the "Remnant of Israel." They are going to be set by themselves, apart from the world, be planted and grow. (Jer. 31:28). and it will be in "their own land" too, that they will be planted. This earth never did belong to the wicked. This earth has been given to Abraham (Gen. 15:7, 18) and to his seed. And especially since God's people (for these hundreds of years) have been scattered, the nations have secured (what they think is) a rightful hold. A God-given right. But they will be usurped. For the day of surprise is coming.

But (as already said) the wilderness will not stay in its wild state. For when God "plants" His people there they will "grow". (Hos. 14:5-7). Not only will them, themselves, plant and build, cultivate and develop things around them but God, Himself promises to do so, too. The desert they will be in will have impassable places in it. Equal to v "Death Valley" has been, and maybe is yet. But Lord says that He will "open rivers in high plac and "make the wilderness a pool of water, and t dry land springs of water". He says He will forest

the desert. Will plant in the wilderness the cedar, the myrtle, and the oil tree." "I will set in the desert, the fir tree, the pine and the box tree together." (Is. 41:18-21). So we can see that the wilderness will indeed "blossom as the rose, will be forested, built up and occupied by a planted growing people that are the real, true owners of the land. And their highway will belong to them, whether the world has already built it or they, themselves, have built it, it will be their exclusive property. None of the world will drive over that. "The unclean shall not pass over it." (Is. 35). The world will have to make a detour when they come to this highway. Not that there will be stationed any customs officers, nor toll collectors nor any officers of men's laws to intercept them. Nothing of that kind. For the Remnant of Israel bear no sword. But this highway is "the Way of Holiness." So it is Jesus, Himself, that keeps that highway. (The margin says "He shall be with them" (Is. 35:8). One of the "Four sore judgments that the Lord sends (at this time) on the wicked world is "noisome", ravenous "beasts," (Ezk. 14:21). But nothing of the kind will be there. "No lion shall be there. Nor any ravenous beast shall be found there. (Is. 35:9) "But the redeemed shall walk there." What a blessed beginning of eternity for God's true people. Who will believe God and humble themselves before Him now. Complete protection from dethe wicked world and complete protection from destructive beasts. Only a few days ago, a mother in Lithuania (N. E. Europe) coming from town only a little ways out from home was attacked by wolves. The horse ran as hard as he could to almost home and stumbled and fell. And before help could get there the wolves ate the baby up and almost killed the mother. "No ravenous beast shall go up there on." (Is. 35:9). What blessed promises, all these are! What cause for songs! And that is exactly what will take place. "The ransomed of the Lord shall return." (from being scattered). "And come to ZION" (this built up wilderness) "with SONGS." "And EVERLASTING JOY." This "joy" will be everlasting" because this gathering "return" is a permanent move.

In the wilderness of Sinai, and the typical promised land of Palestine, things failed. (Because of sin). Here it will not fail. Because only the RAN-SOMED of the Lord "shall return." God, Himself, does the gathering and He will not gather any one exxcept those, He knows, positively, to be His people. All that back there "happened unto them" for a sample of this move. (1 Cor. 10:11).

The unbelievers back there never reached the

The unbelievers back there never reached the typical promised land. But died off before they reached it. Here no unbeliever, no unforgiven sin ner will ever reach this antitypical promised land.

This earth (even in its unrenewed st will finally be renewed) is the 't' raham and His seed. Lord take possess' next ahead people, b' sight a thousand years. And although during that time their property (this old earth) lies waste (because of other required uses during that time) yet it is finally cleansed (like they, themselves, have been) and becomes their eternal home. Praise the Lord!

But all this gathering work is going to be done right here in this sin-filled, uncleansed earth for 40 years, before Jesus comes the "second time." God scattered His people all over the earth hundreds of years ago because of their rebellion and sins against Him. And has let them remain that way because they have continued to be a sinful, rebellious people. But before Jesus comes and as probation draws to a close, He knows that He has called out enough who have accepted Him (in their hearts) to make it safe for the required number to make up His nation. So now at this wilderness time shortly adead He GATH-ERS them.

Hear Him tell it in His own words.

Then shall they know that I am the Lord their Gcd which caused them to be led into captivity among the heathen but I have gathered them into their own land, and have left none of them any more there.
