Dear Mr Kubik

I noted with interest your recent article on your visit to the Sabbath keepers of the Ukraine. You mentioned their need for literature and contacts with people in the West. In 1984 I had a book published on the history of Sabbath Keeping. As the people that you visit have probably been isolated from the outside world due to Communism and other factors they may be unaware of many aspects of church history.

If you wish to translate any of my church history book into the local languages it might be educational or even inspiring to the Ukrainians. I have only sent a portion of the book as I suspect that your resources are limited. It was published in 1984 by Triumph Publishing of Alhambra, California. It became 'out of print' in about 1990 due to having sold out all 3000 copies. Under the terms of my contract all copyright rights of the publisher revert to the author six months after the book becomes 'out of print'. There should be no legal problems in publishing this material.

The photocopies that I have sent to you were taken from a computer disc format of the book produced by Richard Nickels of 'Giving and Sharing', a publishing organization based in Neck City, Missouri, U.S.A. If you need any additional sections of the book you might wish to contact Mr Nickels who would send you the computer disc of the entire text.

I attend U.C.G. services in Bristol and assist Mr John Meakin, our local minister, with his writing and editorial duties. I had an article published in a UCG magazine in 1995.

I hope that this material is of interest.
