Hundreds of members will visit the Pocono Wild Animal Farm and the Pennsylvania Dutch Farm as they have done throughout the festival week.

Memorytown U.S.A., a regular year-around attraction because of its old-fashioned specialty shops, wax museum and many other interesting features, expects a large turnout of visitors from the Worldwide Church of God.

Bowling lanes will be open

to those who want to spend some of their free time bowling.

Pocono-Ice-A-Rama had many spend some of their time ice skating and will do so again this year.

Mrs. Charlotte Lane of the Holly Ross Pottery Shop in South Sterling expects to have many members visit the shop as they have done during other festivals.

Chair lifts at Camelback and Big Boulder are expected to be in operation so that members can enjoy the spectacular view of the Poconos.

Large family groups are expected to visit other scenic attractions.
