As World War II was ending, Armstrong saw a need to establish a four-year liberal arts college to supply a vital dimension missing in many institutions of higher learning.

In 1947, property was purchased in Pasadena, Calif., and Ambassador College was opened in October of 1947. A second Ambassador campus was established in 1960 in Bricket Wood, near London, England. And the third Ambassador campus opened in East Texas in 1964.

"The World Tomorrow" radio broadcast now sponsored by the college, steadily increased in scope and power and is currently one of the largest single purchasers of radio time worldwide. It reaches in excess of 50 million people per week.

Garner Ted Armstrong, son of Herbert W. Armstrong, is the speaker on the daily radio broadcast. He also prepares a daily color telecast aired on

numerous stations in the United States and Canada.

The Worldwide Church of God teaches Christianity as a "way of life as well as a faith." Through a literal interpretation of the Bible, it feels members are finding the way that makes life truly meaningful, rewarding and abundant.

According to church spokesmen, the church is a nondenominational, non-proselyting organization founded on and in accordance with biblical principles.

The beliefs of the Worldwide Church of God are fundamental, explain church

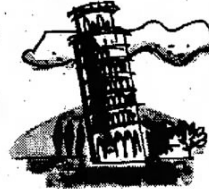
