### Modern college no mystery

MOUNT POCONO — There seems to be a lot of mystery and confusion connected with the functioning procedure of the World Wide Church of God.

A great deal of the mysterious air is even generated when the faith's institutions of higher learning are brought up in a conversation.

A great many people are puzzled and perplexed at just the thought of Ambassador College in Pasadena, Calif., housing 700 students who have a \$2.5 million computer at their disposal, as well as a modern television studio, larger and better equipped than most television stations.

A major printing plant and an annual employee payroll in excess of \$6 million is also a question connected with the World Wide Church of God's institutions.

The reason for the fantastic facilities at the faith's institutions is that the World Wide Church of God officials feel their educational facilities are piecemeal in providing that missing dimension in modern education.

There are three colleges, all named Ambassador College, in Pasadena, Calif., Big Sandy, Tex., and St. Albans, England.

In addition to the facilities at the colleges, the schools are graced with beautiful gardens, fountains, streams and pools which enhance the structural beauty of the combined classical and modern edifices for learning.

The reason for the impressive facilities at the schools is the belief by the leaders of the World Wide Church of God that education should recapture the true values of learning.

Since the inception of Ambassador College of Pasadena in 1947, the move by the World Wide Church of God members has been to apply that missing dimension in the spheres of needed education, and at the same time retain all that has proved sound and good in educational experience.

The World Wide Church of God statement of policy on education believes the number one problem before the world today, is the question of survival.

It also has noted that modern education has been training students merely to earn a living, rather than how to live.

Education, according to the World Wide Church's policy, has neglected not only the spiritual and moral values on campus, but also in the home. Absence of putting this dimension into practice in the home has been leading to the breakdown of the family structure.

All these points and beliefs of the World Wide Church of God administrators are a big factor in the reason why the faith goes to such degrees in its college environment and education.
