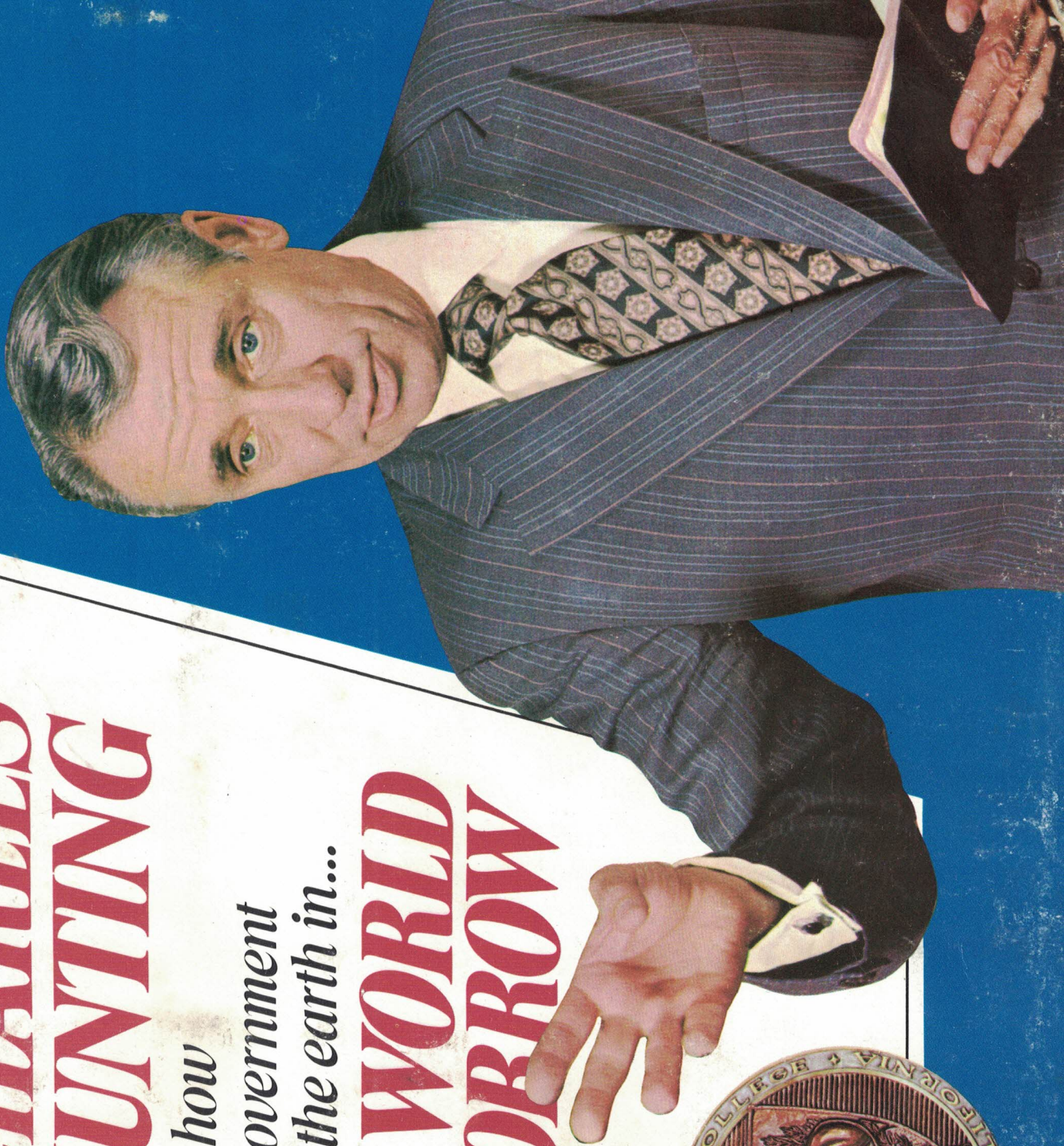

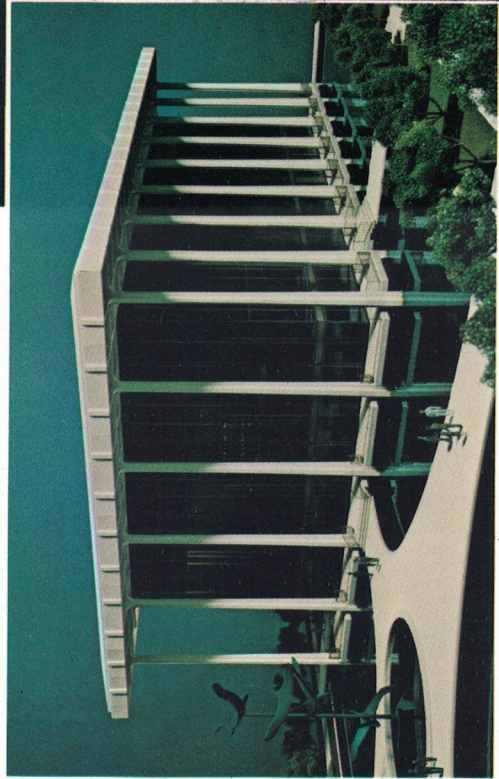
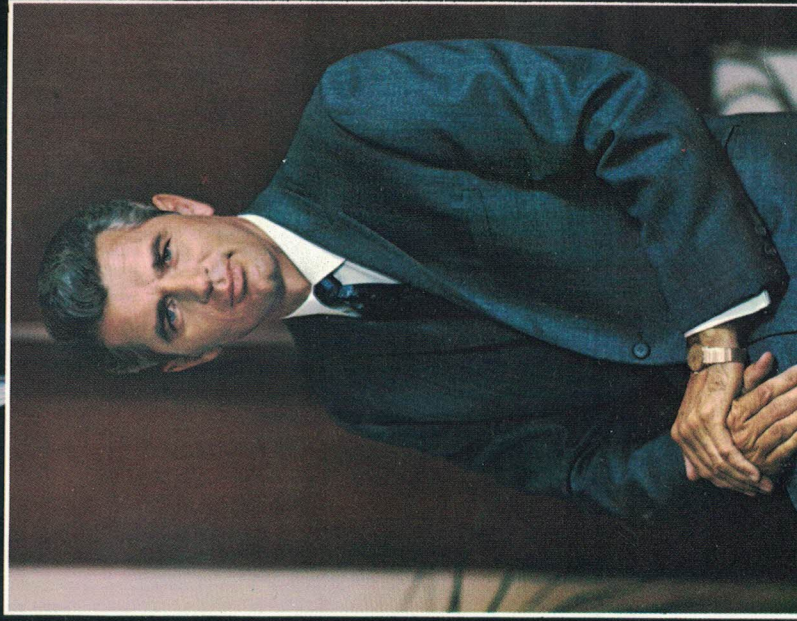
THE WORLDWIDE CHURCH OF GOD

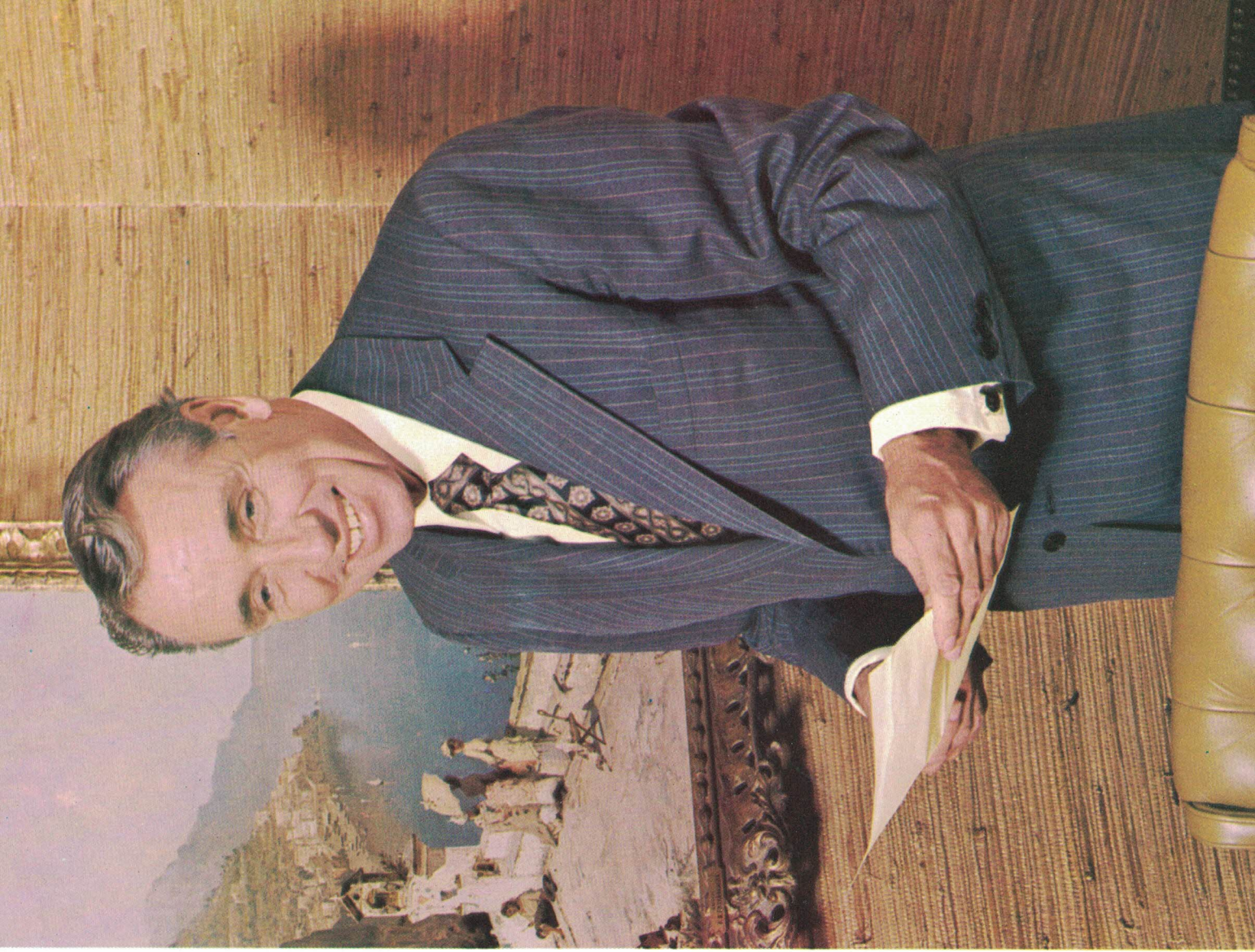
Charles F. Hunting has been associated with Ambassador College and the Worldwide Church of God for nearly 20 years.

His various duties have provided him with the opportunity for extensive travel throughout the world. For the past several years, he has served as Vice President of Financial Affairs and Planning for Ambassador College's facilities in Europe and the Middle East. He is a lecturer in Public Speaking, Theology, and International Relations at our campus in Bricklet Wood, England, located just outside of London.

Previously, Mr. Hunting attended UCLA, after which he joined the Navy and served as an Allied fighter pilot in the Pacific during World War II. Ironically, he was once mistakenly shot down by his own side. Following the war, he developed a business in heavy electrical machinery, which he sold prior to coming to Ambassador College in the late fifties. He was president of the student body at the Pasadena campus and graduated in 1961. Since that time, he has been at the English campus. At 54 years of age, he still plays a vigorous game for the faculty basketball team.

He has also written many articles for Ambassador College publications and has spoken out on today's chaotic world conditions—and their meaning—to large audiences all over the world. He's a dynamic speaker who has solutions to the problems that threaten humanity and knows *the way* to personal peace and happiness. 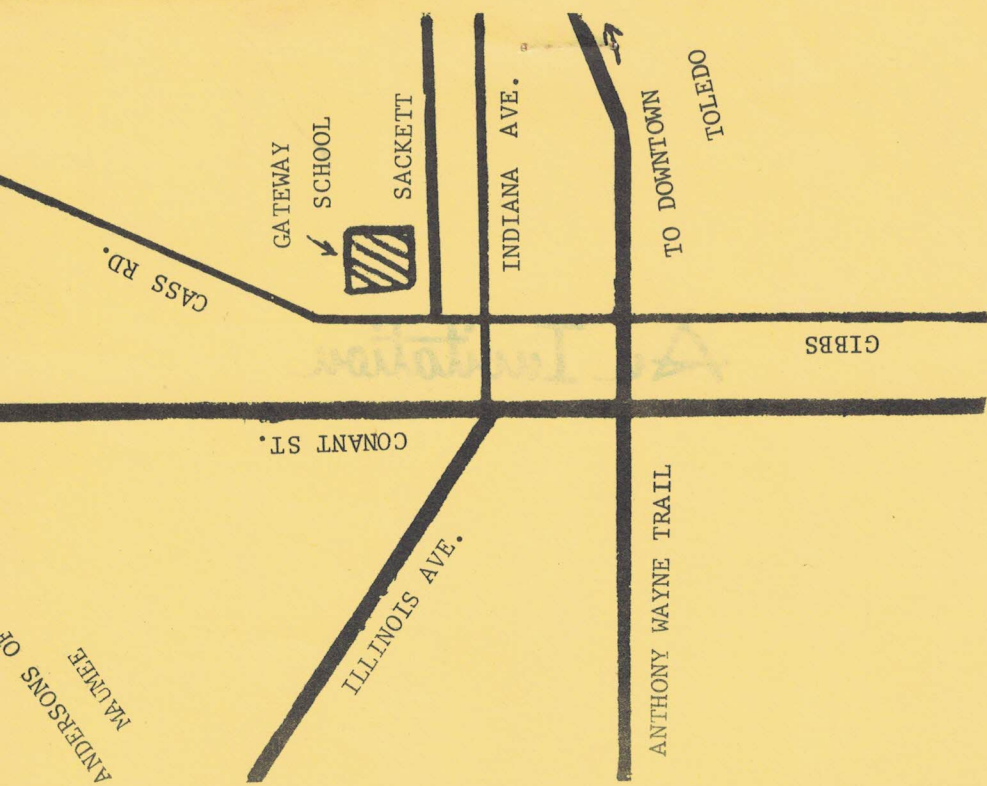
