You have requested that I red pencil the main areas or sections of the S. T. P. (Systematic Theology Project), and then go over this material with you -- so that you can see for yourself what alterations need to be made in the STP.

I have previously stated on several occasions that most of the material in the STP is, I feel, sound. Most of the ministers to whom I have spoken also feel the same way. Major "surgery" will not be needed, in my view, on the majority of the doctrinal "overviews" as given in the STP.
