IN THIS SPECIAL SUPPLEMENT of The Worldwide News are the photographs of 209 ministers who serve in the United States field ministry as area coordinators, senior pastors and church pastors. Almost all of the pictures are current, taken only weeks ago, during the May ministerial conference in Pasadena.

The area coordinators and senior pastors were appointed only in recent months as part of a program instituted by Garner Ted Armstrong to structure the field ministry. In March Mr. Armstrong named Ronald Dart (right) as vice president for pastoral administration, and during April and May Mr. Dart, working directly with Mr. Armstrong, coordinated the appointment of 11 area coordinators, 37 senior pastors and seven senior pastors-atlarge.

The lists used to compile this directory were the latest available from Mr. Dart's office, though we realize there may be ministerial transfers or other changes between our printing deadline and the time you receive the directory.

Some of the church areas indicated as pastorates for the men pictured are new pastorates resulting from transfers that have been announced but have not yet occurred, some of which may not take place until August.

Under some men's pictures is the word sabbatical. These men are now church pastors who will spend the 1976-77


