



נֵרָה nérəh, ney-ray'; from a prim. root [see 5214; 5133] prop. mean. to glister; a lamp (i.e. the burner) or light (lit. or fig.):—candle, lamp, light.


4168. מָהָקֶד māwqēd, mo-kad'; from 3344; a fire or fuel; abstr. a conflagration:—burning, bairn.

4501. מְנוֹרָה menōrāh, men-o-ray'; or

32. ἄγγελος aggéloς, ang'-el-os; from ἀγγέλλω aggéllō (prob. der. from 77; comp. 34) (to bring tidings); a messenger; esp. an "angel"; by impl. a pastor:—angel, messenger.
