- Ammisaduqa (21) 1539-1519/18 ← Venus cycle permits year 1 of Ammisaduqa to be "1538" or "1539 B.C."
- Samsuditana (26) 1518-1493/2 ← In this reckoning there are only 26 years assigned to Samsuditana, at the end of which Babylon fell to a Hittite attack.
