I gave several sermons or Bible studies in the early 80's about the Day of the Lord. I had covered the subject earlier in the Big Sandy A.C. course titled Biblical Prophecy. I believe that the Mail Processing center wrote up what you have from one of those sermons. They did that for some sermons and made them available to deaf people, if I remember correctly. The sermons were given before I began using a computer. I do have an outline in my archives, but it is only about 1,000 words.

I have many sermons, Bible Studies and Lectures that I gave in the years following my use of computers starting in the mid 1980's. Most of these were almost word for word including exact Bible text used.

Would you have interest in this type of material? If so, what type of subject? They are all in WordPerfect format. If you want any, what format do you prefer?

I would review any that you might be interested in and make some editing changes for a more general audience.

You asked about Gene Hogberg. Quite some time ago you referred to him about something but I have forgotten what. We talk to him or his wife every couple weeks or so.
