A growth of 30% for 35 yrs - no parallel in history. Most businesses don't double in size every 2 2/3 yrs. Growth of 8x every 8 yrs.

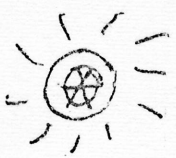
Over 160 prestige colleges have contr. students to A.C. Have come to "Recapture true values" - to learn the Missing Dimension.

One phase of God's Work now is God's using Mr. A. to contact some of the World's leaders.

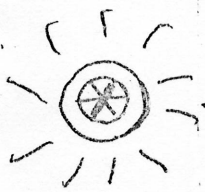
Mr. A. has recently contacted

leaders.

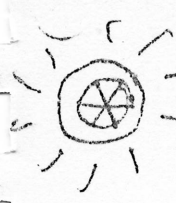

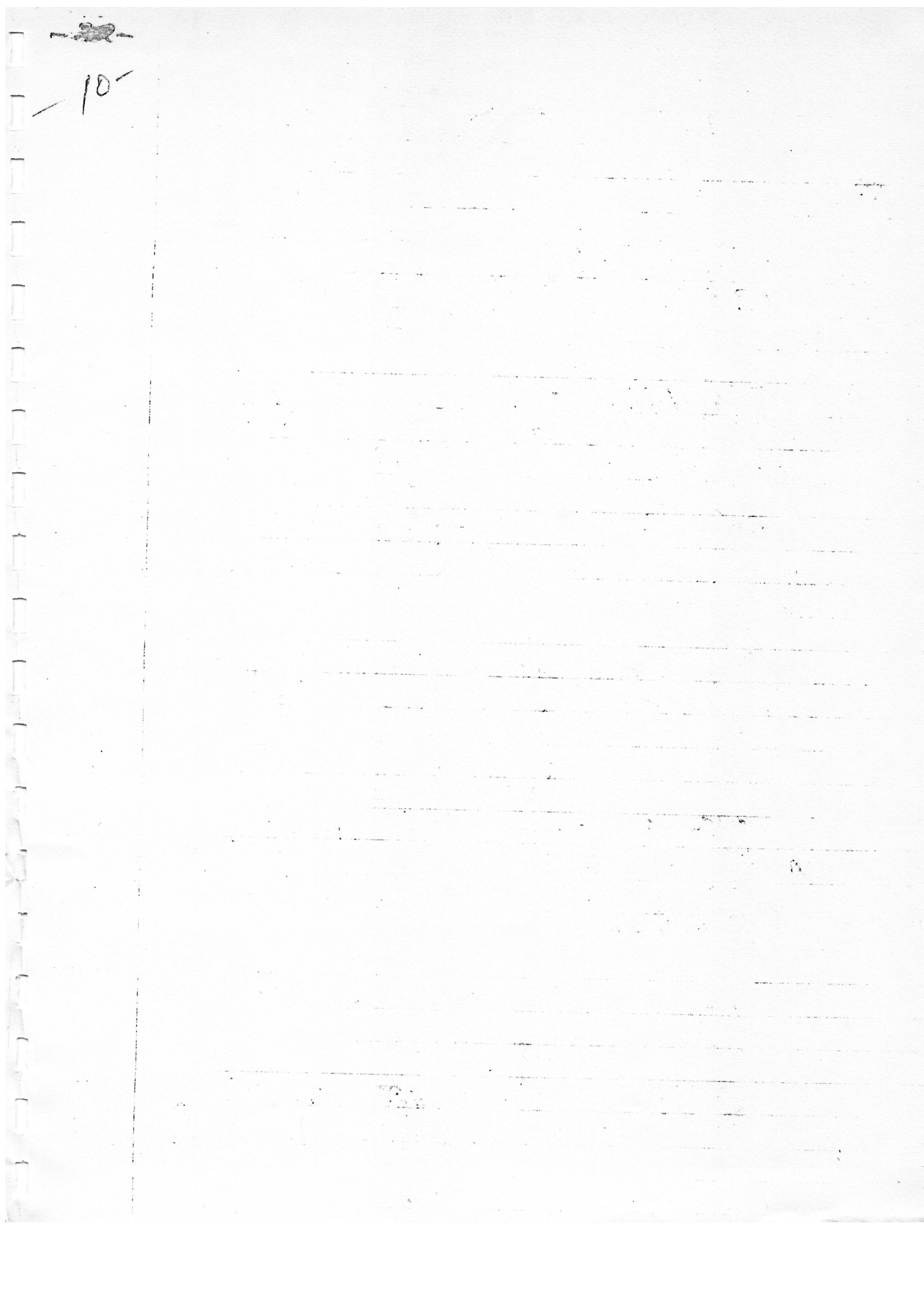

G.T.A. Though Imperial School is now accredited, it now looks as though it will be impossible to get accreditation for the College.

\* The Committee don't like our College (~~Accreditation~~) authoritarian government.

Originally, we were led to believe we would get accreditation - if we (could) would line up to our high ideals. The Committee admitted we are more than living up to our standards. They say we are out of the mainstream of education.

\* Mr. G.T.A. reiterated that we are not dis-credited, because we are not accredited.

\* \* \* \* \* Curriculum. Mr. G.T.A. again mentioned that just because one isn't in the ministry, it doesn't mean they aren't very valuable!

Mr. G.T.A. said we need to have more thorough training in journalism or writing.

It now takes many ~~months~~ months to produce a booklet!

\* A man who is a writer is very important.

We have written on most subjects and it is now more dif. to find new subjects for articles or booklets.

This Church has no authoritative handbook that lays before the world our beliefs, doctrines etc. precisely what we believe.

Our booklets and reprint articles have been our "authoritative" voice before the world.

We need to do a rewrite on the Communism booklet which we have never as yet published.

\* Mr. G. J. A. said Mr. Hill badly needs more articles for Tomorrow's World magazine.

NEED ARTICLES!

He said we in the 3 Colleges need to develop as many writers as possible.

We are not absorbing our graduates as we should. "We can't hire writers for the P.J. or J.W."

We have dropped all graduate schools.  
Does this mean no more MA's etc.?



G.T.A. Mr. G.T.A. said we need to follow the Bible principle of coming to Headquarters for instruction, correction etc.

We need to have a feeling of togetherness. Need to be careful not to handle any student problems which come up relative to differences.

Mr. G.T.A. said we should have gone to Mr. Plache with any student differences - moral differences.

The Student curfews, Mr. G.T.A. said he went to Mr. Hild. re men students being required to have to a curfew.

A reporter told Mr. G.T.A. that guards carry guns at the Bob Jones College.

The Michael Rohan incident caused us a state of persecution. We had stated in the P.J. that the Temple must be built in Jerusalem.

? — Kenneth Rich came out to a.c. and criticized the College. Mr. G.T.A. said at that time the Handbook was taken out of use - because of our fear of persecution by reporters.

\* Mr. G.T.A. said he feels there have been misunderstandings and a lack of communication between the 3 Colleges. He said any report re the Colleges etc. should have included other facets etc.

UNITY OF 3 CAMPUSES - Cont'd.

Mr. G. J. A. said he is highly pleased with the appointment of Mr. David Antion as ~~Acting~~ Deputy Chancellor of A. C. at Pasadena.

We have one College and three campuses - and we will have more consultation in the future along lines that will give us greater unity.

Mr. HWA said we were getting dif. schools: Theology, education.

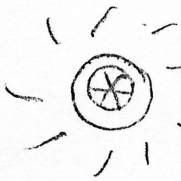

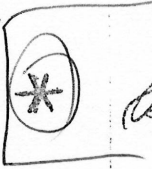

"I want you to stand in awe of the position God has put me in."

But he said he did not want us to stand in awe of him personally.

Mr. A. said some felt some of the people might fall away - if the date Jan. 7, 1972 didn't end our work.

Mr. A. mentioned a critical letter of Mr. \_\_\_\_\_ - ridiculing us for our date not being fulfilled.

"I have never found... that we should observe "new moons." but he said God set the heavenly bodies in orbit to mark time - years, months, days etc.

Mr. A. still feels there was a 19-yr. time cycle from 31 A.D. to 50 A.D. It seems that this pattern has been repeated - from Jan. 7, 1934 - to Jan. 1953 when Gospel first went to Europe. It looked like we would have 2 19-yr. T.C.'s in which to do our work.

\* "I don't think it is wrong to make a wild guess, if we know it is [a guess]." Said he feels we might have about 1 year - as a guess.

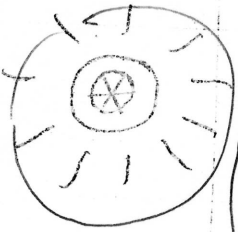
\* We need to study prophecy and world events.

## DIVORCE & REMARRIAGE

A. Each case must be judged individually.

If it is not clear if they are free to marry, they should remain single.

Follow basic guidelines

→ Once bound - always bound.

→ Real Div. & Rem. is always forbidden.

→ But if fraud ("deliberate deception") is involved - marriage is not bound.

I. Sexual Fraud - or fornication - ("intere. bef. marriage").

- 3 Questions:

\* (a) How much was made of this point before marriage?  
"How import. an issue was made of this before marriage?"

Did it come up? Did he or she ask? Ask (mate) girl or boy - "Are you a virgin?"  
Did you make a point of it.

\* (b) What action was taken at time knowledge of fornication came to light.

If one knows about this and accepts him or her - it is bound.

\* (c) How long did the marriage last?

HWA.

One case. A woman put great emphasis on husb. (to be) virginity. He lied. She later came to see he had lied to her. But she later married 4 other men.

Ms. A. said she was bound to him - bec. they lived together for quite some time - and (appx.) came to knowledge and still lived with him. Marriage was bound.

Another case. Couple lived together 5 yrs. then disc. fornication. But Ms. A. said they are still bound.

## II A SERIOUS CHARACTER DEFECT

\* A serious sexual perversion (a continuing perversion - not just an isolated instance) constitutes a fraud.

Permanent perversion is legitimate cause of fraud.

\* A transvestite is so perverted as to ~~render~~ render the marriage fraudulent?

Woman finally returned to her transvestite husband and is working with her weak husband - to help him overcome the problem.

Alcoholism. Does alcoholism constitute such a serious character ~~fault~~ fault as to be a fraud.

HWA.

"You can be cured of alcoholism!"

One can. Man lived with his wife for 6 months before he learned his wife was an alcoholic.

Alcoholics Anonymous often help people overcome alcoholism.

Mr. A. said this man put away (div.) his wife - and he was not sure he should have. Perhaps he should have separated and helped her overcome then return to each other.

### III RELIGIOUS FRAUD.

(?) A serious religious difference.

(?) If the separate upon learning of a serious religious difference, and work out their difference, then return.

If they return they can never divorce.

### IV MARRIAGE CEREMONY

A person should be formally married before a Min. J. P. etc.

What about common law marriages? We cannot be put in the light of recognizing a commonlaw marriage.

But if a couple live for many years as commonlaw partners?

A man who (automatically) continues living with a woman - if then his wife dies - he then becomes bound after his wife dies - and...

Must he have a religious ceremony before one of God's ministers - if he wishes to have God's blessing and His approval?

ATTITUDE AT MARRIAGE

If a couple accept each other they are bound - if they are free.

Marriage of a 11- or 12 yr. old - are they still bound? In India a 12 yr. old girl might be married at her parents insistence.

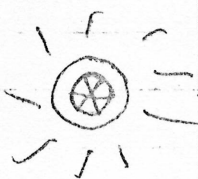

For some time, Mr. Hwa didn't even have a car - then for years only had used cars. But the Work was accomplished.

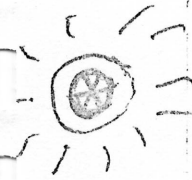

A minister should be an example in serving, love, dress - in every-thing. He should lead not drive.

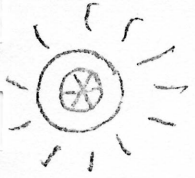

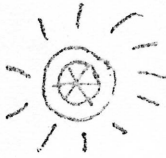

PREACHING

G.T.A. Mr. L.J.A. said many sermons are poorly researched.

On drug-abuse, many ministers don't have that much personal experience thru counselling with those who are drug-addicts, hippies.

55% - 60% of girls non-virgins acc. to estimates!

75% or so of men are non-v.

\* Avoid giving the impression of being against the teenagers - not denying the real facts of what is going on.

G.T.A.

Teen agers do live in a different world.

Where to go for info on drugs?  
Our booklets, newspapers etc.

If you give a false impression of effects of drugs - the teenagers will disbelieve you in other areas.

Drug-use is like alcoholic-use. Some readily get "high" - have hallucinations etc. Others are affected little by it.

### "WILD" MUSIC

Must know what you are talking about. We don't want to encourage any "wild" music.

But it isn't always easy to know where to draw the line on music.

Too loud music - out  
"yah, yah, yah, repetitious music  
(can be) is bad.

Show them that some of the Beatles music is O.K. Don't just harangue against teenage music.

TEEN-AGE PROBLEMS

T.A.

With young children it is easy for you to be at hard-liner in approach toward teenagers.

But when you actually get teenagers, you'll begin to look at things differently - have a more balanced view toward teenagers.

We must understand, get thru to and help teenagers. If we are overly harsh, will put a gulf between them & us.

Learn to listen to teenagers - if you can get them to talk to you.

Remember, remember how you felt as a teenager, how you acted.

PRINCIPLES RE TITHING

It is imp. that we "all speak the same thing." But not like Digger - speaking what he spoke regardless.

Need standardization of general principles.

\*

All who have an increase must tithe. God's law applies to everyone!

What is an increase?

H.W.A. Are widows on 3rd L. or welfare required to tithe? Not on welfare (gov't) or 3rd tithe.

\* (Social Security) Retired people on S.S. No, not if it has been tithed on during period of contributions

However those who wish to may. We only give widows assistance comparable to their living wage - after tithes are taken - there is not tithable.

\* Old Age pensions? If pensions and/or <sup>union funds</sup> company benefits (P) are paid to one after retirement - this is tithable.

Mr. A. \* mentioned \* Mr. Ettinger - how we gave him a generous retirement program of continuing payments. Mr. A. said we were not obligated to do so. - appr about 60% of his salary.

We are setting up a retirement program for the employees of God's Work - appr not as generous as 60%

\* \* \* \*

If it comes as a gov't check for what you would have - after tithing. It is not

Unemployment + Disability payments tithable? No. not if

Veteran benefits? No.

Child support? No, she is merely admin. funds for her husband.

Is there such a thing as a tithe-free gift? Yes. FREE W/ W OFF?

The wage-earning, tithe-paying head of family is responsible to pay tithes!

Is it additional increase, or is it to replace the net income of one (a widow) who has been given a wage (pension) only equal to what she would have received had she (or he) would have (got) had left after tithing.

\* Father should tithe for the family. But it is not required that the child tithe.

Tithe-free gift? Yes in some cases. Grocery money, gifts to children etc.

H.W.A.

Sometimes a gift is tithable.

Do we have to tithe for a non-Christian? Is it increase? i.e. any money received?

\* Mr. A. said he felt it was tithable!

Suppose someone gives you a very rare (valuable gift - perh. \$5,000) gift. Do you need to tithe this.

\* Mr. A. said No. [But one could give an offering - R.F.M.C.]

\* If the giver insists you not tithe on a gift he gives you - then you are not required to do so i.e. a Father making such a demand of his son.

Is a Disability Settlement tithable? If it is punitive - yes. If compensation - no.

Is an Inheritance tithable?

If property is inherited - it is not tithable - till sold. But any increase (grain, cattle, goods) must be tithed in the usual manner.

- That is a moot question!

Mr. A. then said he felt it was tithable.



H.W.A.

A gift that has no "monetary intention" is not tithable.

Inheritances. If and when an inheritance is tithed - it is not necessary to pay 2nd & 3rd T.

\$100,000 inher. & govt takes \$25,000 in taxes - he tithes on the net - on \$75,000. You pay tithes on your increase.

Must 2nd or 3rd T. be paid on inheritances? No.

But if inheritance has been tithed (by father) then tithe is not required?

Should a ~~husb~~ wife tithe against her husband's will? No. But if she objects, she is not required.



Who is required to pay 2nd (& 3rd) tithe? All ordained men are exempt from paying 2nd & 3rd T. The minister is worthy of spec. (double) remuneration!

If Levites faithfully received 1/10 of Isr. income & they would have ~~received~~ 3 or 3 1/2 times as much as the other Israelites. Mr. A. has calculated this, but he forgets the exact figures.

The ministers should be honored & respected - but we should also highly respect & honor others who are not in a ministerial office. "Guard against that!" - attitude.

All ordained men should be doing some type or amount of spiritual work ~~above~~ above his normal secular job. They may preach, advise, counsel, visit some, entertain etc. and may have special or additional expenses.

If they are employed outside - these ordained men should pay 2 & 3rd tithe. They do not pay 2nd or 3rd tithe on that part of their income which they receive from us - as a ministerial wage.

FIRSTLINGS

Firstlings can (pay) give the firstlings as a part of 2nd tithe or can just pay a 2ND TITHE right straight across the board, and not worry about giving the firstlings.

If you aren't warm and friendly, sincere etc. - then why? Lack of prayer? Study?

We are entirely too rank-conscious.

Stereotyped sermons will never really benefit the church all that much!

ADMINISTRATION

\* A Meaningful Program for Young People. But these should not be unsupervised.

\* When Mr. Hwa said it was O.K. to have shorter skirt lengths on the cheer girls - this was not communicated to the churches and appo. to B. W. as soon as it should.

Now Mr. G.T.A. said, these things can be communicated to all the Colleges and churches.

GARY ANTION Gary said if the minister himself goes out with the young people - this often helps.

Let us remember we are not policemen. Some try to legislate rules to prevent sin. Laws don't prevent sin. Gravity (law of) does prevent a fall.

G.T.A.

Said we need to avoid the two extremes of over- or under-policing. Don't feel that you have to police the Church people's children. [Let them do this, but we have to exercise the right kind of oversight and supervision.]

"The generation gap." In some (places) instances we have neglected the teen-agers parents. Some children have told their parents what the minister said - new or uncontradictory to what the parents had told them.

\* Carl O'Brien & John Judy are "trying to harvest our cast offs" They have opposed us. He (Mr. O.B.) wrote a highly critical letter - trying to condemn and ridicule us.

Mr. A. said if he were on the outside looking in - he would avoid the cast offs like a plague.

\* We need to be alert to these people trying to harvest our people - esp. weak or disfellowshipped ones.

In early years, Mr. A. said he noticed the ~~strong~~ weak members would contact the weak members.

They can't hurt us - they are fighting God Almighty. Even Satan hasn't yet learned not to fight God.

Hold up the Big Picture - keep them from being led astray if at all possible.

INTEGRATED ACTIVITIES

HWA.

Certain Spokesman Club and other activities can be integrated.

God does not discriminate. Blacks & Whites should not dance together - since this is a semi-romantic semi-dating situation.

It is certainly O.K. for white & negro families to fellowship. But if teen age children of the opposite sex are involved, then we must be careful, and not have too much fellowshiping under these circumstances.

In the past there have been different practices in different church areas.

In some states (or countries - i. e. S. Afr.) the law of the land forbids integration.

Mr. Jackson mentioned that the Negroes used to have ~~the~~ get spec. guide books for Negro restaurants, Service Stations.

In the South you might find it necessary to have segregated seating at the services. But this should not be done - unless absolutely necessary.

"This is modern Israel." We do not know of any Bib. example where Blacks were put over Whites - over Israel.

Israel was to have a King of their own people.

In U.S. Negroes are the best-off financially of any Blacks of the world.

In U.S. we pay lip-service to integration but...

\* If we have Black pastors over predominately white churches, and if interested people came to Church and saw a Black man in the pulpit - this would cause many to stumble.

\* But the time has not come to have Negro Pastors over pred. white churches - or to have Negro Superintendants over white ministers.

Brood M. said the Gentile ethnic groups in Chicago, N. Y. etc. (Poles, Italians, etc.) are more hostile toward integration than are the Anglo-Saxons.

\* In the big U. S. cities - we plan to have one large colored church in a central location - so they can have their own socials etc.

{ But we will have peripheral, integrated churches so those who are nearer and want to attend an integrated church - if they wish to.

Some black ministers will pastor all-black churches.



Some will be used as teachers, writers etc.

White ministers may be under a Negro or black pastor in an all-black nation in Africa.

MR. JACKSON

Mr. J. said the negro ministers in the field wonder what their future is. Until Headquarters sets the policy there will be frustrations and disappointments.

23 Black ministers - 1 Pastor, P. E. L. Es.

Will there be more elevated to Pastor rank (coloreds) later.

Mr. Atlas felt some of the colored ministers have felt neglected or out of the picture. They would like to be included in social things with the rest of the ministers.

MR. BROWN

The Blacks of the South suffer from a "rejection complex". They feel or sense some of this same feeling in the Church. They are very sensitive, - esp. to "Nigger jokes". He said Blacks in the south are hypersensitive about these things.

ROD M. said not all of the "progress" toward integration is not really progress.

"You negroes tend to be lazy... dirty" etc. statements can be bad.

If you are more concerned with your own spiritual growth and welfare than with the work - you won't grow as you should.

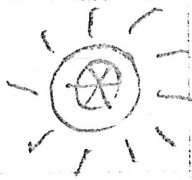

Now Rod M. says "this mid-afternoon" habit of prayer & study works marvellously for him.

Many field ministers can take the time to get their prayer & study in in the morning - before they leave for their visiting work.

We need to exhort one another. In N.T. Ch. the disciples prayed together - and the place was shaken.

[Have monthly prayer meetings with the ministers in Eng. - so we can keep close to God.]

EASTING

We need to fast more - several times during the year - besides the Day of Atonement.

If you can FAST - the day of fasting in study, prayer and meditation - spend 1/3 in these ways. If we fast, study, pray etc we will have no dif. in sermon preparation.

R.O.D. M.

If we fast & pray our lives will be filled with God's Spirit and power - new life.

\* Can fast a 2-3 day fast by fasting on Fri. & Sat. or Sat. & Sun. - or Fri. Sat and Sun.

(The Sabbath)

Sat. is not the best fast day generally, but it is not wrong to fast on sabbath - if this will cause us to draw closer to God Almighty.

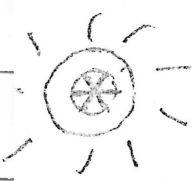
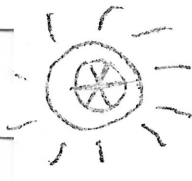
FAMILY PRAYER & B. STUDY

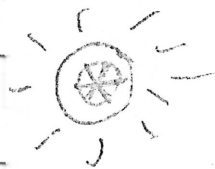
Mr. Portune said he hoped all of us here this afternoon realized just how important these points covered here really are.

Satan has been and is striking at this work. He will try to get Sat all of us - if we give him a chance.

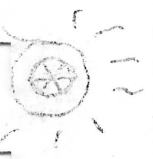
Mr. HWA. said too many have been letting wrong feelings, attitudes etc grip us. He worked all of us not to let such attitudes take us.

Mr. A. said he didn't need to elucidate here - you know if this applies to you.

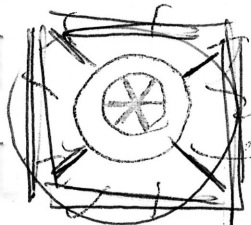

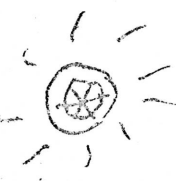

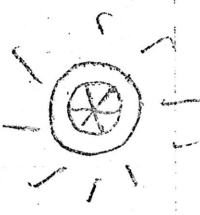
