



#### Dr. Roderick C. Meredith

Dr. Roderick C. Meredith was well-known around the world for his tireless evangelism, preaching the gospel of the Kingdom of God. He was one of the first evangelists ordained in 1952 by Mr. Herbert W. Armstrong and spent 64 years in the Work that Jesus Christ raised up through Mr. Armstrong. He was active in the Work until recent months and was near the

completion of his 87<sup>th</sup> year of a long and productive life. As Presiding Evangelist of the Living Church of God, over 350 congregations were established in 55 countries worldwide. He will be greatly missed by many people around the world.

After he graduated from Ambassador College, Dr. Meredith labored his entire adult life in God's Work, and his greatest wish was for that Work to go forward in power and unity under Jesus Christ.
