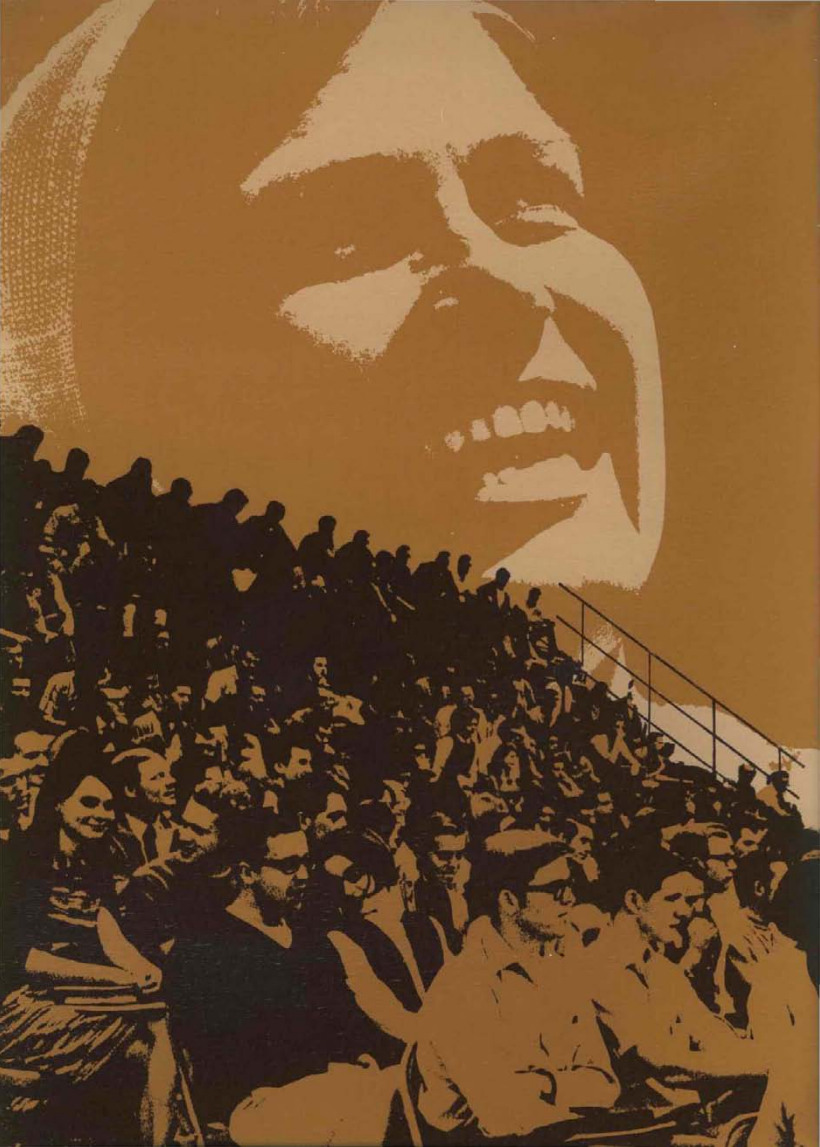

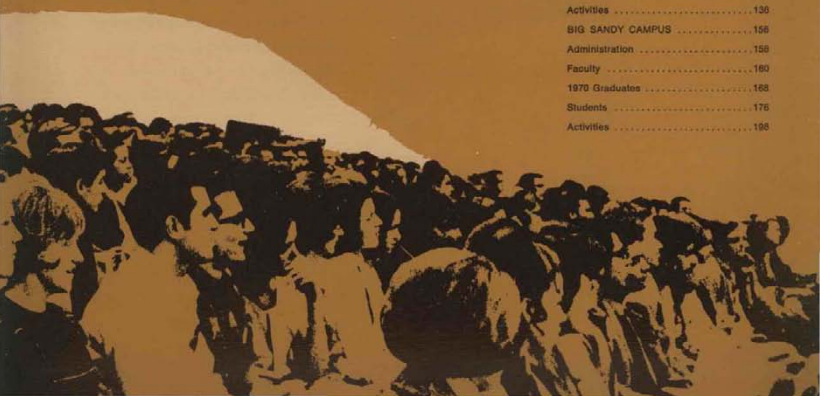

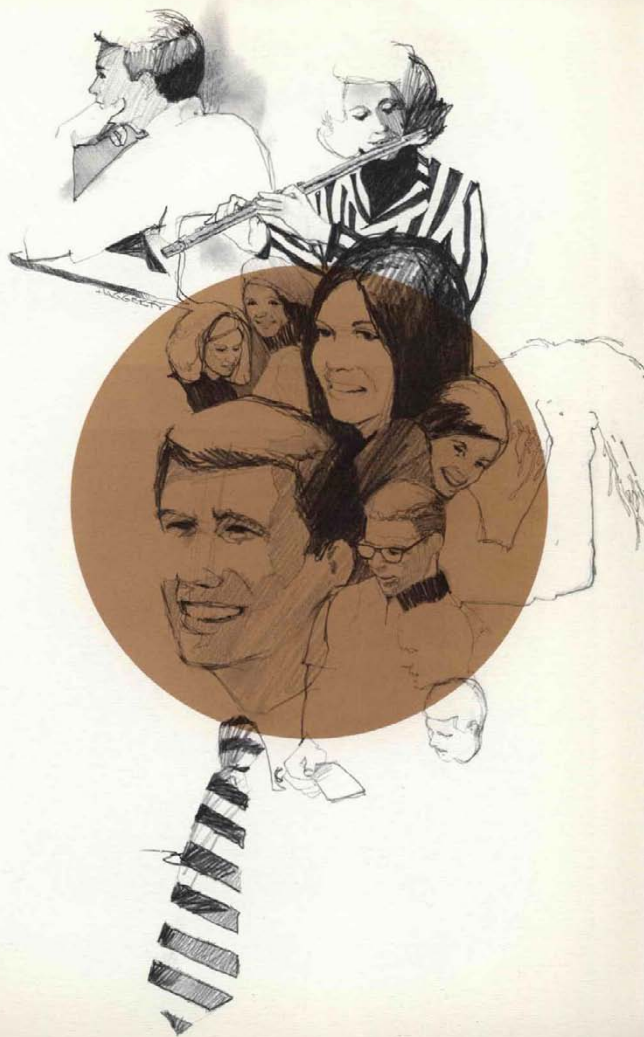


Introduction

Ambassador College, Pasadena, occupies 45 acres in the heart of the Rose Bowl City's finest residential district, adjacent to famous Orange Grove Boulevard. The college first opened its doors on October 8, 1947. The then recently acquired two-and-a-half acre Fowler estate became "campus" for the eight faculty members and four students that first autumn! The campus grounds and facilities have expanded rapidly year by year with the increased student body. With the completion of a new library building and the 75-foot-high, 1250-seat auditorium in 1972—both presently in the design stage—the Master Plan for the campus will be complete. In and near Pasadena are to be found all the supplementary educational, recreational, and inspirational advantages a college could desire—two world-famous astronomical observatories, famous galleries and museums, great libraries, technical institutions of highest rank, nearby mountain hiking, skiing, ocean beaches. The cultural atmosphere of the physical surroundings and the advantages of its geographical location combine uniquely to make this campus an ideal setting for the pursuit of Total Education.

Field Trips

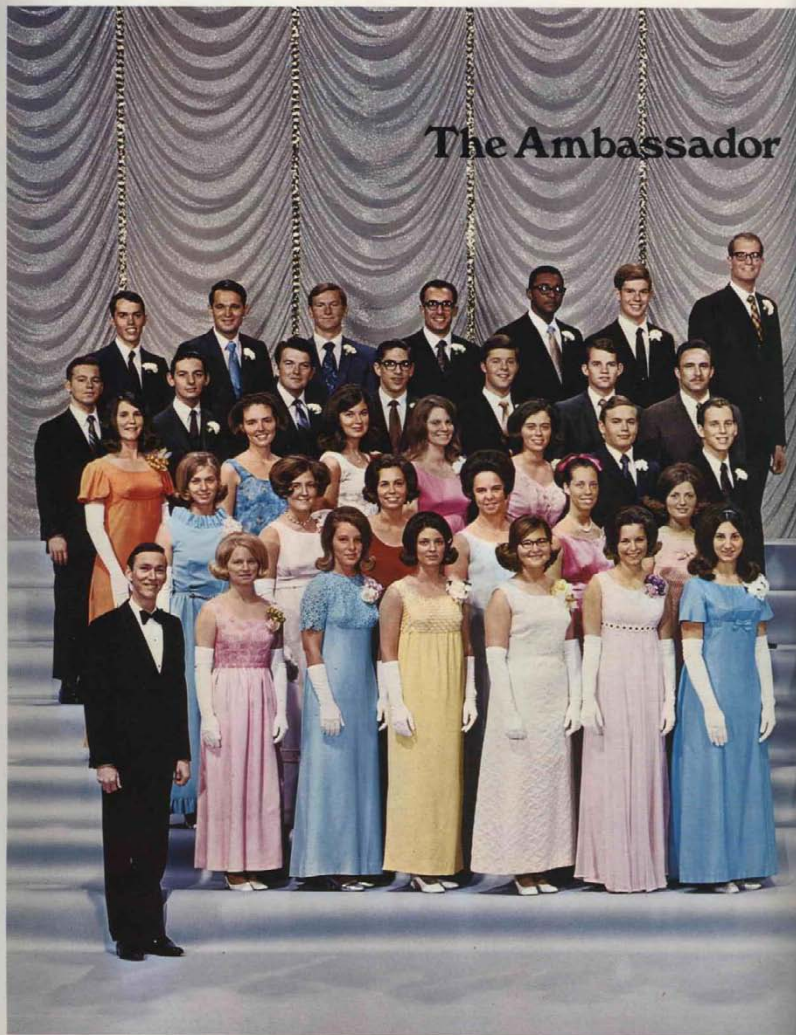

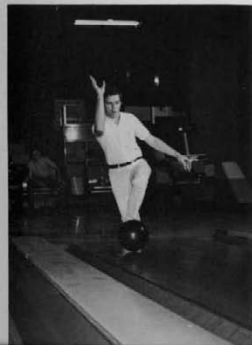

Forums and Assemblies

Forums and Assemblies carry on a tradition established by Mr. Herbert W. Armstrong in the early years of the college. They afford opportunity for the entire student body and faculty to meet together twice weekly. The Tuesday afternoon Forum enables the administration

to discuss current campus matters with students. In addition, "open Forum" is often held giving students the chance to participate in college-wide discussions. The Thursday afternoon Assemblies present educational material by the faculty which is of interest to the entire student body. Often guest

Clubs

The most popular of extracurricular activities are the various clubs. Men can participate in Ambassador Clubs which were patterned originally after the Toastmasters' International. Each is a formal dinner club with about 25 members and meets weekly. Here the goal is developing effective speaking with emphasis on personality, leadership, wisdom, and an understanding of current events. Speech topics cover the entire gamut of experience. Students learn to think on their feet and to express themselves with discernment and conviction under a wide variety of conditions.

In much the same way, Women's Clubs are designed to develop poise, wholesome charm and feminine leadership in Ambassador women. Topics discussed may range all the way from comments on

civil rights to selecting children's toys. In a busy club life, be it men's or women's, priceless lessons of sacrifice, service, and comradeship are learned. Language clubs too furnish valuable experience in the use of foreign tongues — French, German, Hebrew, Italian, Japanese, and Spanish. Each club meets once a month with menu, decorations, songs, and entertainment depicting the native lands of that particular language. All speaking must be done in the foreign tongue.

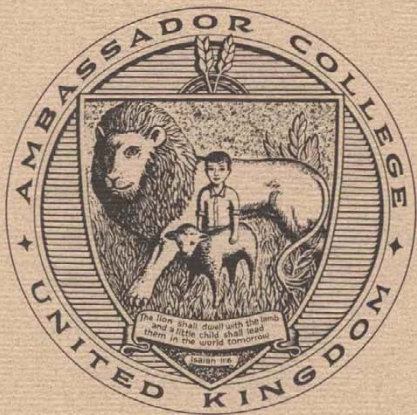


Graduation Day - 1970

Ambassador College became an international institution during the fall of 1960 when a second campus—Ambassador U.K.—opened its doors. It is located in the outskirts of a small, quiet English village called Bricket Wood, on a private estate built in the early part of this century by Sir David Yule of East India Company fame. New college buildings now include the Gymnasium Complex which was chosen by the British Olympics Committee to represent the nation's sports facilities in a photographic display in the 1968 Olympic Games in Mexico City. Its 200 acres are situated in the "green belt" surrounding historic London. The M. 1 motorway, passing nearby, gives easy access to the cultural advantages available in London and Britain's other principal cities as well as providing the link for a quick hop to any of the key cities on the continent. A student body representing up to thirty different nations helps create a close-knit family atmosphere with a distinct international flavor.

England has romantically been called the "Garden Island." Throughout its rapidly-changing seasons it displays a floral variety of spectacular depth and beauty. Here, you see only one of many garden areas which attests to the fact that Ambassador U.K. is actively maintaining its part of an important cultural tradition.

The third Ambassador College campus located at Big Sandy is nestled in the idyllic East Texas countryside—100 miles from Dallas. Unfettered by city sprawl, the rustic 4000-acre complex is able to implement a program of agricultural research including experiments in soil development and crop and livestock improvement. This campus was established in September, 1964, with 108 pioneering students. The completion of the Master Plan will provide the capacity for 550 students. Here, just as at the Pasadena and Bricket Wood campuses, the same goals of character and culture are carefully pursued. Visitors are greeted at the college entrance by five sculptured bronze "Swans in Flight" which gracefully rise out of a 120-foot mirror pool. The building program has provided new dormitories, classrooms, an ultra-modern dining hall, and a field house—with more structures on the drawing boards. Natural springs and streams, in addition to beautiful Lake Loma—teeming with largemouth black bass, crappie and bream—lend a sparkling and refreshing touch of outdoors to our newest campus.

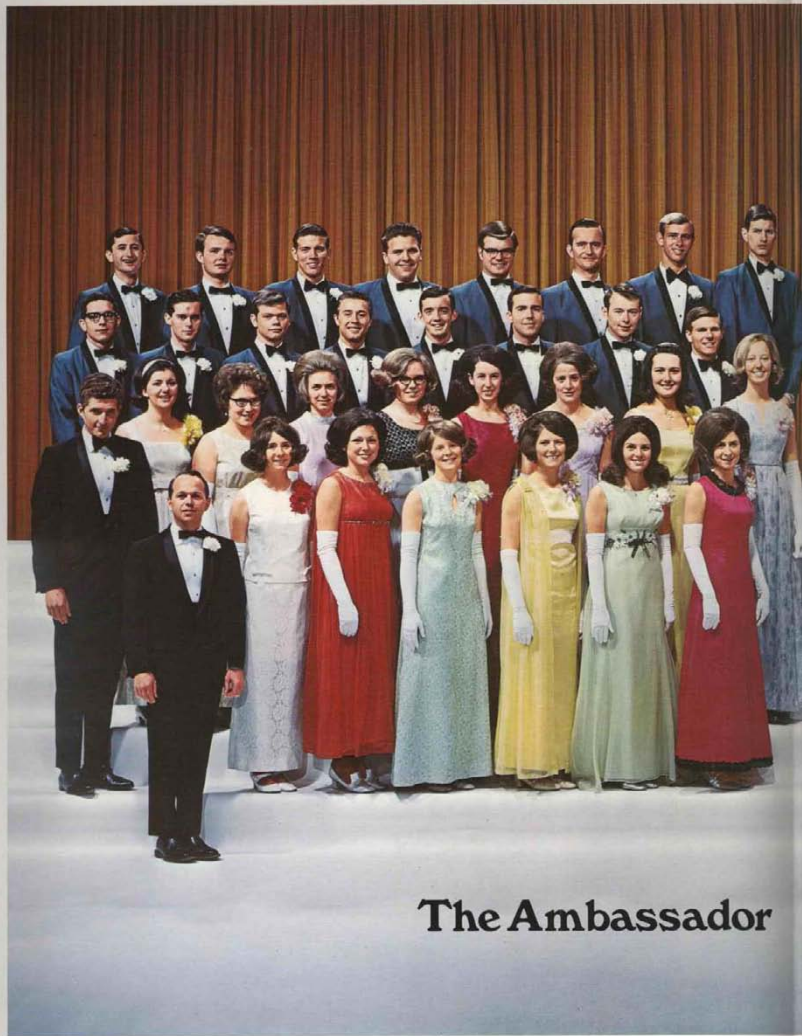

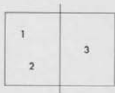

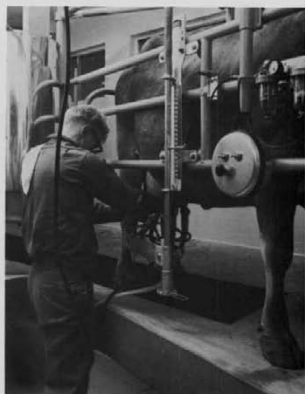
Agricultural Research Department

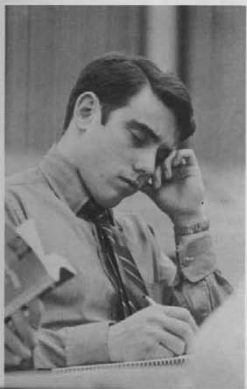
