4. Habsburg Dynasty	None	Hapsburg’s territories in the east formed the Eastern leg (Austria, Bohemia, Hungary etc)		Habsburg/HRE wars against the Ottomans (1500s-1700s) Thirty Years War (1618-48) begun by Emperor Ferdinand II – Protestant vs RCC and centered mainly around German states. France joined against the Habsburgs. In essence it was a European Civil War. 8 million died. The Ottoman Empire and Russia sided with the anti-Habsburg coalition. Seven Years War (1756-1763) spanning Europe, Americas, West Africa, India, Philippines. It involved UK & allies vs France and Holy Roman Empire. (NB 100 years war England vs France 1337-1453AD.)
5. Napoleon	Non-German. Did not gain the Imperial regalia. Turned on the RCC. Was a deist	Included a north-western zone called ‘Confederation of the Rhine’. Austria remained separate	Politically ‘wounded’ in 1814 and revived his chances in 1815.	Invaded Egypt (1798-1801) and Russia (1812) with a large no. of German troops. Attempts at revival (1815). His wars spilled over into North America, South America and Egypt.

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6. Bismarck and Germany up to WW1	Did not have a concordat with the RCC (unlike all the others). Bismarck Protestant, not Catholic. Prussian, Protestant north dominated the Empire, not the RCC Catholic south/Bavaria	Cooperation of Germany and Austro-Hungarian Empire		Bismarck undertook several wars to unify Germany, viz Danish War (1864) inc Franco War (1866); Austro War (1870). This period until 1945 is sometimes labelled 'the modern 100 years war.' In WW1 Russia invaded (particularly Ukraine). Planned to invade India and to expand presence in the Middle East. Assisted the Turks in the Middle East.
6. Mussolini	Italy/Rome subservient to Hitler. He was an athiest	Second of 3 blocs working with Hitler (3 rd comprised eastern European nations)	He was an athiest but signed a concordat with Vatican.	Invaded North Africa to revive the Roman Empire. Later assisted by Germany.
6. Hitler and Germany up to WW2	Planned to emasculate the RCC. A deist, but signed a concordat in Rome in 1933	Cooperation from fascist dictators in the east. Absorbed Austria	Militarily 'wounded' in war but revives his chances in Battle of the Bulge and smaller victories in the east. Literally wounded by a bomb and survives the assassination attempt.	Invaded North Africa. Invades Russia and plans to invade India with Japan (NB: Vichy France initially controlled most of West Africa, Syria and Lebanon plus other territories around the world). Hitler literally wounded by a bomb. [NB WW1 & WW2 are sometimes regarded as two parts to the same war. Some even label it 'the second Thirty Years War.']
7. Final Beast dictator	Turns on the RCC, destroying it. Does the False Prophet switch from being head of RCC to promoting Emperor worship?	Will be comprised 5 nations or groups of nations in each Western and Eastern Europe. Plus allies around the world	Probably invade Russia and Middle East and also India. Full circle back to Roman Emperor worship and conflict with 'Christianity'. Probably be 'wounded' in some way.	Will attack and destroy the Anglo-Keltic nations
Satan			Uses same ongoing system, but prefers to be worshipped through a man. Is placed into the pit but released after 1,000 years. Similar to Napoleon's and Hitler's political wounds and revivals.	

NB: was the One Hundred Years War the real first major war or the Crusades were, the Thirty Years War a world war, the Seven Years War the third major or world war; the Napoleonic wars the fourth world war; the Great War (World War One) the fifth world war; and World War Two actually the sixth world war? So, there is one more to go?

Here is one possibility for seven global wars:

1. Habsburg wars culminating in Thirty Years War.
2. Wars of Louis XIV: nine years war/ war of Spanish succession.
3. Wars of Louis XV: Austrian succession and Seven Years' War.
4. American revolution: which became a world war.
5. French revolutionary/Napoleonic wars.
6. World War I/World War II: both started by German Reich and seen by some historians as a single conflict.
7. World War III precipitated by German/Austrian led final revival of the Holy Roman Empire.

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
