INTRODUCTION

Those conversant with the theological climate in America are aware of the great renewal of interest in the study of Biblical Law. This interest is not only in the Law itself, but in its application to the solution of our national and international problems. This is not only evident among Anglo-Israel Believers, who have taught the need of a return to Biblical Law, but other groups among evangelical Christians and Christian Legal Societies are adding their voice to the ever increasing demand to return to the administration of Divine Law for national righteousness.

Because of this renewed interest in this subject, I saw the need of a Concordance on the subject to guide students in their studies. At first, I proposed to write one myself. But the press of business made this difficult. So I finally asked, then assigned the job to Joyce and Warren Fennell. They have done a splendid job far above my expectations. The work will certainly prove most timely and helpful to all research students.

However, it must be remembered this does not give the philosophical, rational, nor scientific reasons for the superiority of Divine Law over all other systems. This could be done, but this is a Concordance, not a Commentary. Because of this you will not find any explanation of that part of the Ritual of the law which was superseded by Christ at Calvary.

Since we are told in Scripture that in the New Order Divine Law will become the law of the land, we need a working acquaintance with the Commandments, Statutes and Judgements of the Lord. This work, representing many, many hours of labor, will prove most helpful to the student in the study of this great subject. We commend it to all in their study of the Scriptures and ask God's special blessing on it as it is released to the public.
